Moving over for utility workers

MADISON — Wisconsin drivers will need to slow down or move over to protect the safety of utility workers who are on the job near busy roadways, thanks to legislation signed into law by Gov. Scott Walker recently.

"Thanks to Gov. Walker and a bipartisan group of legislators, Wisconsin utility workers will be offered the same protections as other emergency responders who are on the job," Bill Skewes, executive director of the Wisconsin Utility Association, was quoted as saying in a news release. "We all appreciate the job our utility workers do when they're out in dangerous conditions, day or night, working to restore power. It's important for drivers to respect the room utility workers need to perform their iob safely."

Assembly Bill 803, now officially 2013 Wisconsin Act 291, passed both houses of the Legislature with bipartisan, unanimous support, and was backed by both utilities and labor. Senators Paul Farrow, R-Pewaukee, and Dave Hansen, D-Green Bay, and Representatives Robb Kahl, D-Monona, and Mike Kuglitsch, R-New Berlin, were the lead authors of the legislation.

According to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation website, the "Move-Over Law" requires drivers to shift lanes or slow down in order to provide a "safety zone" for a squad car, ambulance, fire truck, tow truck or highway maintenance vehicle that is stopped on the side of a road with its warning lights flashing. Assembly Bill 803 extends the same protections to "any vehicle of a public utility, telecommunications carrier or cooperative association...displaying one or more flashing amber lamps..."

2013 Wisconsin Act 291 also extends drug-testing provisions to ensure contractors performing utility work are doing it as safely as possible.




