



# Back in the day:

# Experience life during Lincoln's visit here

JANESVILLE — In October 1859, Abraham Lincoln visited Beloit and Janesville, delivering speeches and remarks in preparation for his campaign for president. While in Janesville, he was a guest at the residence of William Morrison

More than 150 years later, Lincoln will return to Rock County to interact with a variety of audiences while reminding people of the events surrounding his visit and the issues that were confronting the United States at the time.

The Rock County Historical Society is inviting Lincoln back for a three-day weekend in Janesville called Lincoln on the Lawn. From Friday, Oct. 10, to Sunday, Oct. 12, Lincoln will be at several locations throughout Janesville, providing the people with an opportunity to learn more about local history and how his visit impacted the community.

"Lincoln on the Lawn will bring one of Janesville's most memorable historic events back to life," Michael Reuter, RCHS executive director, said in a news release. "More than simply having Mr. Lincoln come back and give a speech, our goal is to allow him to interact with a variety of audiences, making history more fun filled. With music, dancing, fine dining and even a car show, we hope this event will have a little bit of something for everyone."

### Domestic violence victim shares her story

JANESVILLE — While the National Football League's handling of domestic violence cases involving players has dominated headlines of late, the often untold story is how domestic abuse of women hits close to home and goes unreported to authorities.

This is, in part, the story of Teri Jendusa-Nicolai, who 10 years ago was left for dead after being beaten by her ex-husband with a baseball bat. Now, her ex-husband is serving a 35-year prison sentence and Jendusa-Nicolai speaks to her experiences then and now as she

addresses groups about what can be done about domestic abuse.

Jendusa-Nicolai, who lives in the Racine area, will make two stops at Blackhawk Technical College on Thursday, Oct. 9, to discuss her experiences. The first stop will be at noon on the BTC Central Campus North Commons. She will then travel to the Monroe Campus for a session that begins at 6:30 p.m.




