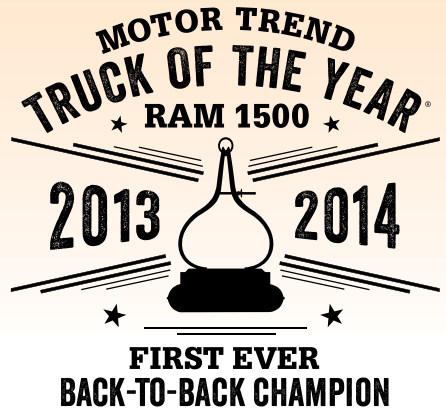

JPAC uses matching grant funds to offer classes

JANESVILLE — The Janesville Performing Arts Center recently received a matching grant of \$2,325 from the Wisconsin Arts Board. This grant was awarded through the Master Class Program and will support Adult Education classes at JPAC.

JPAC's Education and Outreach program will offer a series of new master classes and workshops for youth 14 years and older. These workshops are aimed at promoting continuing education in the arts and are co-presented with Bower City Theatre Company.

Theatrical Directing will be the first class offered at JPAC from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. Aug. 16-

17 at the Janesville Performing Arts Center, 408 S. Main St. The participation fee for the course is \$30. The weekend-long class is designed for theatre-lovers with past experience as actors, technicians, designers, or audience members who would like to explore their abilities as directors. Participants will develop and improve their theatrical directing skills in a hands-on, participatory way by reading, analyzing, staging and performing short plays. Through this process, participants will learn the basics of playscript analysis, concept development, communication, actor coaching and theatrical staging. This class will be

instructed by Ray Pritchard. The second course scheduled to be offered at JPAC is Live Sound and will take place from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. Nov. 8-9 at the Janesville Performing Arts Center. The participation fee for the course is \$30. The course is designed for people who want to work with live sound in a theatrical, church, concert or recording venue. Participants will become familiar with the basics science of live sound; how to set up and operate professional equipment used in theatre, concerts and recording; how to mix on a large-scale console with outboard gear; how to use effects and process dynamics.

Make eye exams part of your back-to-school routine

Reading the computer, chalkboard and books are critical elements of getting an education that can lead students to reaching their full potential and making their goals and dreams come true.

Surprisingly, vision disability is the single most prevalent disabling condition among children.

In fact, one in four students in kindergarten through sixth grade has an undetected vision problem that can interfere with their ability to read and learn, according to the American Optometric Association.

GMC Sierra: 2007-'13



HISTORY

Developed in concert with the Chevrolet Silverado, the Sierra is essentially the same truck, with the exception of the more luxurious Sierra Denali. Both the Silverado and the Sierra replaced the C/K 1500 (1/2-ton) series for the 1999 model year and continue to be General Motors' most popular vehicles. The Sierra was updated for 2003 and again in 2007 on an all-new chassis. Engine choices consisted of a 195-horsepower 4.3-liter V6 plus 295-, 315-, 367- and 403-horsepower V8s (the latter was standard for the Denali). For 2009, a gas-electric Hybrid made a combined 332 horsepower. A four-speed automatic was the sole transmission choice for V6, 4.8-, 5.3 and 6.0-liter V8 Sierras, but a six-speed automatic was included with 403-horse V8. An all-new Sierra lineup was introduced for the 2014 model year.



THE GOOD STUFF

Sierras from the 2007-'14 period represented a significant leap forward in pickup development, providing more hauling and towing power along with ride and handling improvements (due to a stiffer chassis) plus more car-like passenger compartments. The addition of a hybrid version also yielded decent fuel economy, especially in city driving. Sierras were available in a wide variety of body, bed and drivetrain configurations. Inside, buyers could also select from bare-bones basic to full-on, Cadillac-rivaling opulence (Denali). On the road, the Sierra was notable for its lack of both wind and engine noise, as well as its ability to traverse rough terrain in relative comfort.



HEADS UP!

Other than for toting light loads, it's probably a good idea to avoid pickups with the V6. The next-rung-up 4.8-liter V8 had more power and better fuel economy. Unless you're towing or hauling a heavy trailer, anything larger than the pickup's 5.3-liter V8 might not be necessary. The hybrid version will save fuel, but it's also more costly to purchase and is more complex to service. Due to the thousands of available combinations and permutations, it's easy for buyers to wind up with too much, or too little truck for the job. Shop carefully and spend wisely.

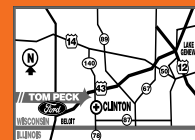
