Tonight should see a full moon - "the Buck Moon," as July is usually the month when the new antlers of buck push out of their foreheads in coatings of velvety fur.


Wednesday is the 47th anniversary of the day Neil Armstrong walked on the moon.

gins back in June when DAR member Charlene Thomsen, Arnolds Park, noted that since it was the flag of that era, a 48 star flag would be needed for the 1936 Baker Township school house that the DAR is helping renovate in Sheldon.

Over a month later, on June 28th, local DAR and Quester Chapter members, along with others in northwest Iowa, were touring the historical homes and museums in Peterson, IA. As the group was headed for a "pioneer lunch," generously supplied by the Peterson Historical Foundation at the Shelter House, a man drove up in an ATV.

He said that DAR member Margaret McCombs, Emmetsburg, had stopped him en route to ask him for directions to the event. As they chatted, he told her that he had an old flag that was labeled "Sutherland DAR." McCombs suggested that he come to Peterson and talk to Colleen Lemkuil. He arrived at noon to tell how he had found the flag in a dumpster and had it cleaned. Since there is no longer a Sutherland DAR Chapter, Lemkuil told him that it could fly over the school house being restored in Sheldon. It is now being given a second cleaning.

"Charlene, who knows and loves history, put the idea in my head and it stayed there, then it just showed up. What a fortunate 'find'. A serendipitous event," says Colleen. She adds that "The gentleman who rescued the flag asked to remain anonymous, not wanting people to think of him as a 'dumpster diver'. He was so pleased to find a home for it and we are pleased to have a 5 by 7 foot flag that was owned by an earlier DAR chapter,"

According to Internet research, the 48 star flag came about on July 4th, 1912, when New Mexico and Arizona were added to our union. It flew for 47 years, the longest of any other flag. Arizona and Hawaii became states in 1959 to make the now 50 stars.

The Ladies of the Lake DAR and The Okoboji Queen Chapter of the International Questers, which also supports the renovation project, hope to see it flying when they gather at the Heritage Park, 1423 East Park Street, in Sheldon on August 23.

Area residents interested in local history are invited to join group there at 10:00am to tour the park which has three other restored school houses and an art gallery. Guests are also invited to be present at 1:00pm when Harold Tuttle, President of the Prairie Arts Council, will be given the National DAR Historical Preservation Award.



"The cost share program is a partnership between the District and local landowners to help get conservation practices on the land that prevent soil erosion and protect water quality. Now is the time for farmers to plan ahead," said Hoffman.

This year, the District will be encouraging cover crops in which IDALS will provide financial assistance to local SWCD offices to incentivize their use. Cover crops are extremely beneficial in reducing erosion, retaining nutrients, combating weeds, while at the same time improving water and soil quality. Related management practices such as no-till, strip till, and ridge till, are also being encouraged.

The cost-share rates are variable and depend on the practice used. Farmers should become familiar with the details by calling or visiting the district office.

Other conservation practices eligible for assistance through this program include grass waterways, grade control structures, wind breaks as well as several other practices.

The Dickinson Staff with IDALS and the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service assure the technical quality of the practices and further, help farmers develop conservation plans for their farms.

"These funds are a great investment by the state in an effort to reduce erosion, improve water quality. Since there are funds available, farmers are asked to contact our office to discuss various options for their farm," Hoffman further commented. 


