Guests hit comfort jackpot with Bok Homa's renovations

Guests of the Bok Homa Casino near Sandersville will notice a few updates and renovations on their next visit to the property. Jason York, who was named executive director of Development and Operations for Bok Homa in February, explained that guest comfort was a leading factor in making these improvements.

"New carpet with additional padding, new slot machine bases complete with foot rests and wider pathways between machines, were all done to enhance our guests' experience and comfort," York explained. "We completed the renovations at the end of June."

York added that with the property being over five years old now, a little TLC with fresh paint and some general maintenance was needed to keep the casino in top shape. With the updates came a few more games. "We already had about 720 slot machines, and now we have added roulette and dice tables in addition to our eight Black Jack tables, a Three Card Poker table and a Mississippi Stud table," he said.

Putting in new table games, York said Bok Homa would create approximately 25 new dealer jobs, bringing their total employment to around 250. They will host a dealer school near the end of July and those interested in taking the class and applying for a position should call 866-447-3275.



Looking for a quick treat while on the gaming floor? Lucky's, Bok Homa's snack bar, has expanded their menu as well, adding quesadillas, meatball subs and the "Bok Homa Dog."

"The 'Bok Homa Dog' is a bacon wrapped, deep fried hotdog," York explained.

Bok Homa Casino is part of the Pearl River Resort, a multi-million dollar, luxury resort owned and operated by the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians.

JCJC offers CPR, first aid and automated external defibrillator (AED) class

Jones County Junior College will be offering several CPR, first aid and automated external defibrillator (AED) classes at the Whitehead Advanced Technology Center in Ellisville. The morning class will meet on Thursday from 8 a.m. until 1 p.m. on several dates: August 18, October 13, December 15, February 16, April 13 and June 15. The afternoon class will meet on Thursdays from 1 p.m. until 6 p.m. over the year during several sessions: July 14, September 15, November 17, January 19, March 23, and May 18.

The Heartsaver First Aid, CPR, AED is a one-day, five-hour classroom, video-based, instructor-led course that teaches students critical skills needed to respond to and manage a first aid, choking or sudden cardiac arrest emergency in the first few minutes until emergency medical services (EMS) arrives.

In this course, students will learn skills such as how to treat bleeding, sprains, broken bones, shock and other first aid emergencies. This course also teaches CPR and AED (automated external defibrillator) use.

This course is for anyone with limited or no medical training who needs a course completion card in first aid, CPR and AED use to meet job, regulatory or other requirements. Upon successful completion of the course students receive a Heartsaver First Aid, CPR, AED course completion card by mail, which is valid for 2 years. The cost for this course is \$15. To register and to pay for the class come to the Advanced Technology Center at 72 Technology Blvd, Ellisville, or call Carmen Sumrall at (601) 477-4105 to register and to pay for the class. A CPR Card will be mailed to successful participants one week after the class.

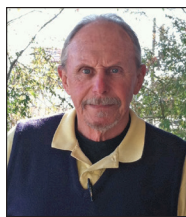

Jason Helveston, author of "Tell me Everything – How Jesus Told me His Story," was in Laurel recently at The Shop Around the Corner booth inside Southern Antiques for a signing of his first book. Helveston is the son of John and Lucy Helveston, who recently returned to Laurel after living in California for 25 years. Jason now lives in Chicago, Illinois, with his wife, Laura, and three children: Glori, Jedidiah and Micah.

"Laurel is the foundation to my character, faith and story," explained Helveston.

His mom said that although they lived in California for 25 years, their children always looked forward to and valued deeply the three weeks spent in the summer in Laurel every year. Jason's father is a member of the band Jagged EDJ (that was formed during his father's junior high years), which has a Summer Jam reunion each year on the third weekend in July. His dad is also a retired minister who now serves as an interim pastor where needed both locally and overseas.

Helveston and his wife live in a west side neighborhood of Chicago, where they oversee a location of Park Community Church, which is one church in nine different neighborhoods in Chicago.

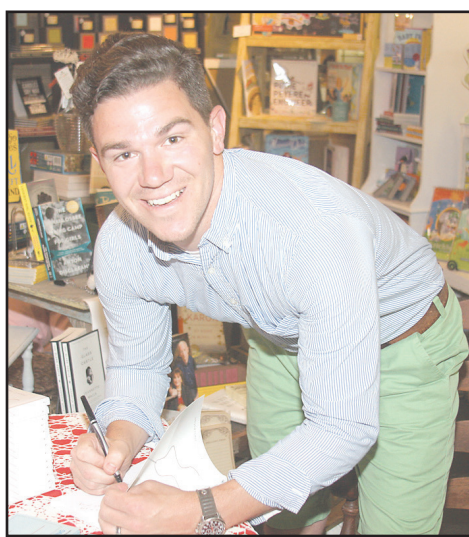
"It (Park Community Church) was planted about 27 years ago out of the historical Moody Church, which has been around for over 150 years," explained Helveston.

"The Southern culture is very rich in storytelling," said Helveston's mom, Lucy. "I think Jason learned that from his dad, who is a story teller in the pulpit. He weaves in God's plans through those stories."

Helveston said that the title, "Tell Me Everthing," comes out of the fact that when you meet Jesus, "like a friend returning from a vacation, you want to sit down with Him and have him tell you everything."

"I wanted to have a book signing here in Laurel because Laurel is a very special place to us," said Helveston. "The love of this town with its brick roads and sweet tea has always been compelling to me. It is very different from the concrete jungle of Chicago that I live in. Time slows down here in the best possible way. My family and I think and feel differently and are connected to our larger story when we are here. It's a special place to us."

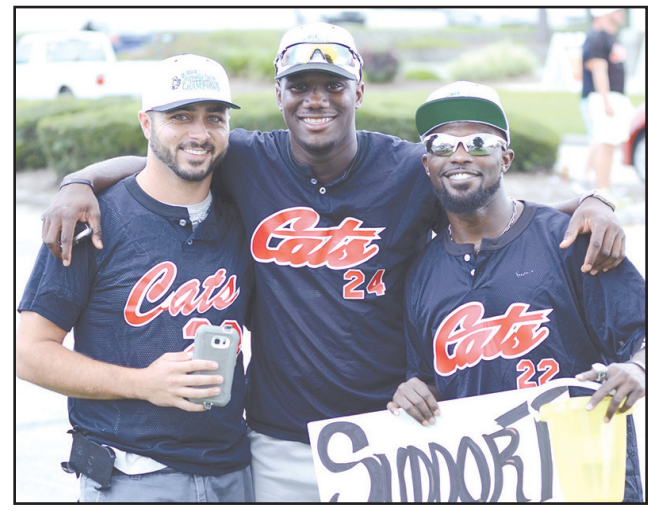
Babineaux took over the team back in 2010. In that span, the Black Cats have beaten teams from all across the Southeastern United States to the tune of 100 wins, a program record.

ing him the opportunity to have a “dream job of a lifetime,” but for continuing to be his friend and Friday night Laurel football companion. “As Mayor Magee said, this is one of the nicest facilities in the Southeast,” exclaimed Ulmer. “A local team went to San Diego, California, last week to participate in the Major League All Stars. I started getting phone calls from several of the kids saying ‘Mr. Ulmer, we really appreciate you. Our facilities are a whole lot nicer than what’s out here in San Diego, California.’”

The Laurel Susan Boone Vincent Sportsplex is a 145-acre complex consisting of eight lighted tennis courts, six regulation soccer fields, six baseball fields, walking and nature trails, tennis pro shop, concession stands, press boxes, a 1.5 acre lake for irrigation, and a natatorium with a 50-meter Olympic sized swimming pool, which Ulmer and his Park and Recreation team take care of year round.

“It was amazing to see the project come together,” exclaimed Mullins, who was city attorney during Vincent’s 12 years as mayor of Laurel, “beginning with her vision (in 1994) to its fruition with the first ball game being played here in March of 1999.”

Mullins outlined the steps that had to be taken to make Vincent’s “field of dreams” come true. “The first step was to convince the City Council that it was a project worth pursuing,” said Mullins. “The second step she took was to seek the assistance, guid-

ance and support of the county supervisors, which wasn’t necessary, but she sought that early on. We found out very soon that we had to have local and private legislation to allow this project to happen, which required one hundred percent of the legislators, both in the Senate and the House from this area, to be sponsors of that legislation. This failed in 1995, but in 1996 it was finally approved. The legislation not only authorized the project, but authorized it to be paid with revenue bonds issued by the city and to be paid for by a 2-cent food, beverage, and housing tax. During all this time the 145-acre parcel had to be put together, which was acquired ul-

timately by the city. We were required to get the approval of the United States Justice Department under the Voting Rights Act, and that was done. In 1997, the Mayor had to convince the citizens of Laurel to approve the new tax. Groundbreaking finally began in 1997 and in March of 1999 the first baseball game was played here. Without her vision, wisdom, leadership, integrity, and unyielding tenacity and salesmanship, it never would have happened.”

After the unveiling, Vincent thanked everyone for coming and recognized the council members of the 1996 Laurel Sportsplex Initiative – David Ratcliff, Jones Brogdon,

Manuel Jones, H. Gordon Myrick, Charles Bailey, Lula Cooley and Melvin Mack.

“I would like to thank Mayor Magee and the present City Council for enlarging our field of dreams,” exclaimed Vincent. “We’re going to have an eightplex softball complex here that will hopefully get started in a few months.”

Vincent concluded the ceremony by taking the time to recognize her visionary partner, Randy Meadors, who loved Laurel and the Sportsplex just about as much as Vincent, and who worked with Neel-Shaffer until his death.

The foundation of this family is built upon passionate people who have loved the university for decades. Roger Cameron is one of these important patriarchal members of the family who have sustained it for years. The key to the success of Southern Miss are people like Roger who came, invested, supported and continue to be involved.

Born in Quitman, Mississippi, Cameron was the son of a Methodist minister which meant that his family moved frequently during his childhood. Over the years, they lived in Leaksville, Laurel, Glendale, Pike County, Utica, Raleigh and Hazlehurst. It was in Hazlehurst where Roger finished high school and met his lovely wife, Patricia.

After graduating high school, Roger studied at Copiah-Lincoln Community College from 1961-62. Originally, Southern Miss was not on his radar going into junior college. He knew he wanted to go into education and looked into the department at Mississippi State. However, some of his friends were going to USM and he agreed to visit campus. After visiting campus, Roger decided to join his friends in Hattiesburg to be closer to home. It was from that moment forward that his love for Southern Miss grew and he graduated from the university in 1965 with a bachelor’s degree in education before earning a master’s degree in 1967.

Throughout his life, Roger’s career has varied from sales to architecture to education. He taught at Prentiss High School for four years and later spent time working for the state. For much of his adult life, Roger lived in the Jackson area working in business-to-business sales including 23 years selling medical equipment to hospitals. During those years, he raised a family while ardently supporting the Golden Eagles. Each weekend he and his family drove

Roger commented on game days at The Rock by saying, “I enjoy seeing friends I haven’t seen in years. I enjoy seeing all the people getting out to support the team.”

Across five decades of Golden Eagle football, Roger has seen several of the greatest moments in Southern Miss history. He watched the team climb to new heights with Reggie Collier and Sammy Winder. He watched the meteoric rise of Brett Favre in the late 1980s. He enjoyed the consistency of the Bower era with the impressive bowl streak and watching his Golden Eagles become dangerous giant killers throughout the 1990s. Given all of the teams and players throughout the years, Roger could only narrow down his favorite games and players to series and lists. Some of his favorite players are Sammie Winder, Cedric Scott and Adalius Thomas. His favorite series against an opponent were the unforgettable Louisville games in the late ‘80s and ‘90s. But the game that stood out the most from Cameron’s 50 years of fandom was the Florida State game in 1989. With 20 seconds remaining in a tight game, Brett Favre added to his incredible legacy by throwing the game-winning touchdown pass that took down the Seminoles. Looking back, Roger commented on the ‘89 team saying, “We had two excellent running backs (Rickey Bradley and Tony Smith) that gave them trouble. We really had top quality players on the field.”

Throughout his lifetime, Roger has

been one of the most faithful fans for the Golden Eagles. He traveled from Jackson to home games for over 20 years and made his way to road games. To Roger, being at every game regardless of the opponent or season record is the essence of being a fan. He elaborated by adding, “It’s important to show support - we have excellent players, coaches, and staff, and it is important to support them. I can’t settle for just tailgating, and not actually attending the game.”

Roger is excited about the 2016 season. He knew Coach Jay Hopson from his previous stints at Southern Miss as an assistant and raves about his abilities. Roger reiterated the importance of supporting the team by saying, “We need people to get out and support us. We have a new coaching staff, but our system and personnel are pretty much the same. You never know what will happen, but we just have to play. You play who you play and you beat who you beat.”

Roger and his wife Patricia have two grown children, Daniel and Anne, who live in Hattiesburg with their families. Roger’s grandson Hayden Chapman is a senior at Southern Miss and a member of ROTC. Help plants survive sizzling summer heat

Many people consider summer the most enjoyable time of year, as the summer sun and warm breezes make the season perfect for rest and relaxation. But the months of June, July and August, which are often characterized by rising temperatures and stifling humidity, can be tough to endure as well.

When summer heat becomes especially uncomfortable, humans can simply head indoors and beat the heat in air conditioned buildings and homes. Plant life is not so lucky, and homeowners may need to take steps to help the plant life on their properties survive the summer heat.

- Monitor soil moisture. Soil moisture, or a lack thereof, can help homeowners determine if their plants are struggling to survive the heat. To check soil moisture levels, use a ruler or even your finger, sticking either two inches into the ground where you suspect the soil is drying out. If the soil is damp two inches below the surface, then your plants are likely retaining enough moisture to withstand the heat. If the soil is dry two inches below, then you may want to give the soil a deep soak.

- Keep an eye on container gardens. Containers may have an especially difficult time staying moist in the summer heat. That’s particularly true for containers that sit in direct sunlight. Water container gardens daily during summer heat waves, being sure to adhere to any local water restrictions.

- Lay down mulch. Mulch helps insulate and protect soil during summer, when soil can quickly dry out. When applied correctly (ideally before summer temperatures get too hot), mulch helps the soil conserve moisture and prevents weed growth. Weeds can rob soil of the water it needs to promote strong root systems, which can help plants get the nutrients they need to withstand summer heat. Mulched soils also do not experience the fluctuations in temperature that non-mulched soils can experience during summer heat waves, helping plants to grow evenly.

- Move plants when possible. Plant location can affect their chances of surviving summer heat. Driveways lined with flowers or other plants may look nice, but driveways exposed to the sun can radiate heat at temperatures that exceed the temperatures noted on the thermometer. If possible, move plants to locations on your property that are less exposed to the heat and/or less likely to be affected by the heat. Move container plants beneath trees on hot days, and consider summer heat waves before planting new flower beds.

Summer heat can be especially harmful to plant life. But homeowners can employ various strategies to protect the plant life on their properties when temperatures rise during the dog days of summer.
