Ingredients 8 SERVINGS 409 CALS 1 cup all-purpose flour 2 tablespoons cornstarch 1 teaspoon baking powder 1/2 teaspoon salt 1 egg 1 cup beer 1/2 cup plain yogurt 1/2 cup mayonnaise 1 lime, juiced 1 jalapeno pepper, minced **1** teaspoon minced capers 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano 1/2 teaspoon ground cumin 1/2 teaspoon dried dill weed 1 teaspoon ground cayenne pepper **1** quart oil for frying 1 pound cod fillets, cut into 2 to 3oz 1 (12 oz) package corn tortillas 1/2 medium head cabbage, shredded

Directions

PREP 40 M COOK 20 M READY IN 1 H

- To make beer batter: In a large bowl, combine flour, cornstarch, baking powder, and salt. Blend egg and beer, then quickly stir into the flour mixture (don't worry about a few lumps).
- 2. To make white sauce: In a medium bowl, mix together yogurt and mayonnaise. Gradually stir in fresh lime juice until consistency is slightly runny. Season with jalapeno, capers, oregano, cumin, dill, and cayenne.
- 3. Heat oil in deep-fryer to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).
- 4. Dust fish pieces lightly with flour. Dip into beer batter, and fry until crisp and golden brown. Drain on paper towels. Lightly fry tortillas; not too crisp.
- 5. To serve, place fried fish in a tortilla, top with shredded cabbage & white sauce.
