Joe Plut hugs 200 friends to celebrate his 80th birthday



By ANN SCHWARTZ Anyone who was a student at the Brainerd Community College (Central Lakes College) from 1965-2001 will remember his contagious laugh and booming voice.

Joe Plut, Crosby, put Brainerd on the map. As a college

professor, he adopted the "love doctrine" and hugged all his students daily and everyone he encountered at the college. This led to nationwide fame as the "Mad Hugger" with an appearance on the *Real People* popular network television show in the late 1970s, as well as a write-up in *People Magazine*.

In addition to being able to tick off the name of anyone he has ever met over the last 70s years or so, and who is related to whom, and who is a

former student or their relative, Plut has also written a book, edited another, traveled widely and acted in many plays on the college stage.

Prairie Bay Restaurant threw an 80th birthday bash for him on July 4 that 250 folks attended and 200 of them were featured in the group hug.

"I've had a great life -- a full life," said Plut in a recent interview. His faith is strong as he battles prostate cancer and knows that he'll be facing death sooner rather than later. But he has accepted his fate and his last goal is to build up his scholarship fund at Central Lakes College.

The scholarship fund was started 15 years ago with \$3,000 from Mildred Stave, a student in 1977. As of press time, it grew to \$55,760 and Joe would love to see \$80,000 in the bank for CLC students as a great big present for his 80th birthday.


aggressive inpatient chemo
