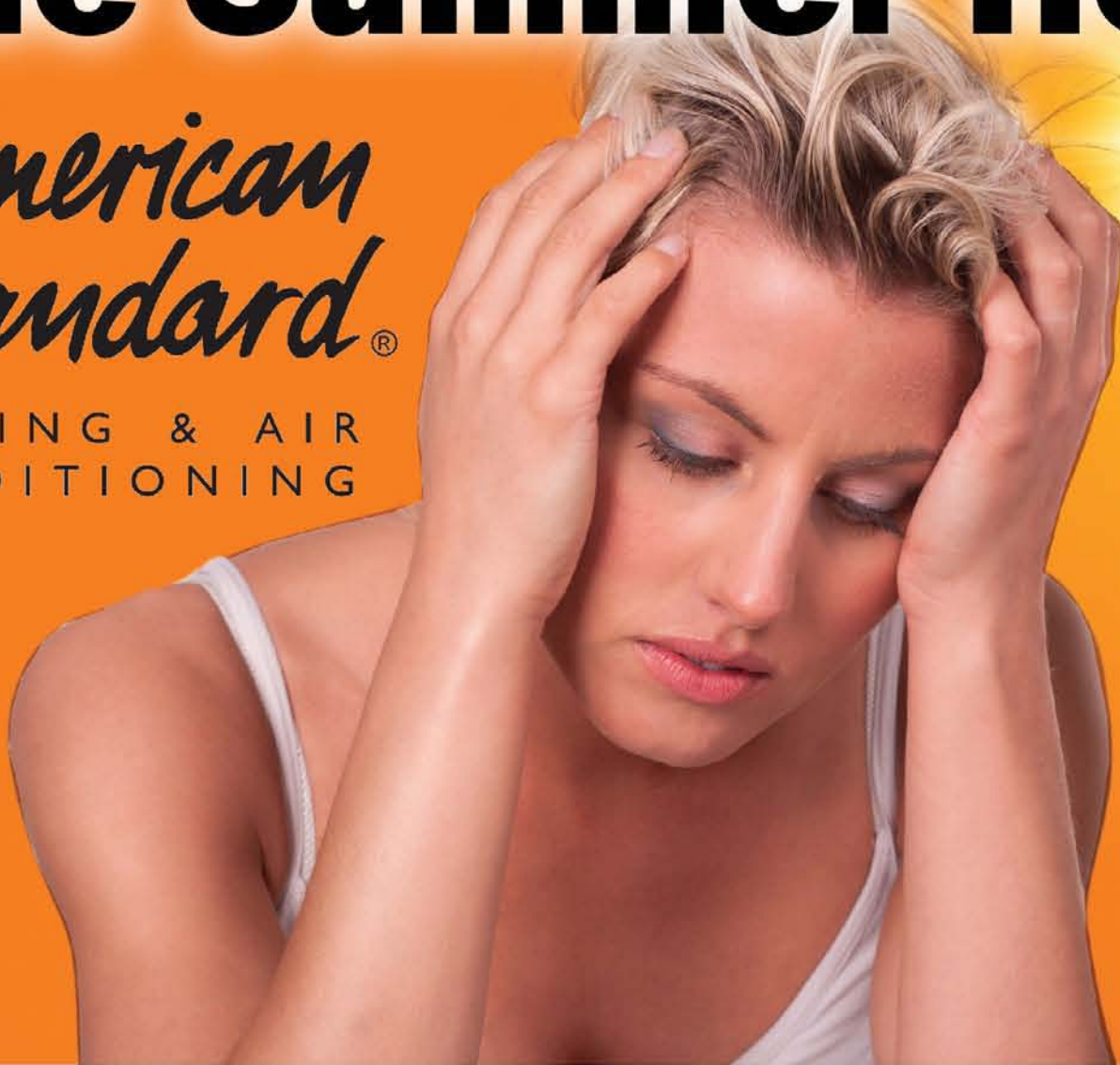

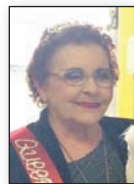

Yates, who is now 69, moved to Florence Nursing & Rehab Center about 18 months ago. She continues to attend Mass, volunteers at a local thrift store, and swims at the YMCA each week.

"I love that the nursing home is so encouraging of me remaining as active as I can with some of my previous activities," Yates said. "It is very important for me to be involved in my church activities. I enjoy being active both in the nursing home and out in the community."

When Yates is not out and about you'll find her busy at the nursing home. She helped form the Actor's Club. Along with her fellow residents she has also written and performed plays for residents, staff, and visitors. She regularly assists with calling bingo games and helps other players read their cards. "It offers some comfort to know that you are cared for and also that you can be an encouragement to those less fortunate than yourself," she explained.

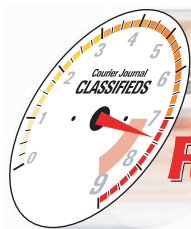

air flow, minimizing the chances of skin breakdown and bed sores. New birthing beds are tailor-made for the delivery room, providing the highest level of comfort and security for mother and newborn. The critical care beds have a built in music therapy system that can be used to block out the noises of the ICU, calming the patient.

The BackSmart design helps reduce the need for constant patient repositioning when the head of the bed is raised or lowered. These beds also have wireless capabilities.

Q How do I get a doctor in my on the job injury case when my employer denies that I even had an injury at work but I did.

Randy, Killen, AL

A For most of the 30 years that I've handled workers compensation cases representing injured workers, we could file a motion with the court to compel medical care.

However, the Court of Civil Appeals in 2007 in a case called Ex parte Publix Supermarkets 963 So.2d 654 completely changed the law in this area. By the way, the 963 is the book in the series Southern 2d which covers Alabama and a few nearby states and the 654 is the page the case is found. In this case, the trial court granted the injured worker's motion to compel medical treatment. I had filed these motions for years and absent some wildly unusual circumstance, they were always granted.

After 2007, the Court of Civil Appeals ruled that there was no such "motion to compel medical treatment" and required the injured worker to take a doctor's deposition to obtain medical evidence that the doctor believed the injury occurred on the job and any other evidence that had some bearing on the issue such as a first report or injury or a witness who saw the accident and try one half of the case to establish liability and then the court could and would order medical treatment.

As you can see, when there is a controversy regarding an employer's obligation to pay for medical treatment, you have to follow the court's holding in Ex Parte Publix Supermarkets and take a doctor's deposition, get your witnesses and ask for a "bifurcated hearing". This is not something that someone without a lawyer will be able to do.

Remember that legitimate workers compensation attorneys never ask for any money up front and pay all of the costs of obtaining the doctor's testimony and other items necessary for trying half the case. After that is done successfully and the injured person obtains medical treatment, you cannot resolve the case until the injured worker reaches what is known as "MMI". MMI is a term that means maximum medical improvement and is the point at which temporary total disability payments stop and no payment is made until the case is resolved. At the end of the case, the lawyer can recoup his expenses plus charge a 15% attorney's fee.

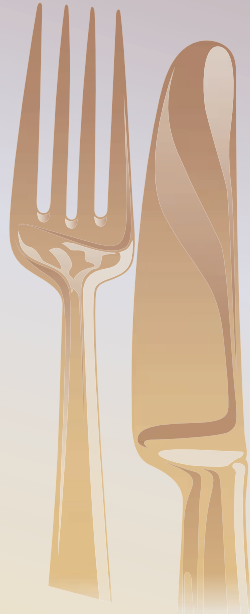

I get asked by clients all the time why they are now being sued for a debt they guaranteed or co-signed with another individual, usually a relative or close friend. They will say "I am just the co-signor. It is their debt.", or "They are the primary, I am just the secondary."

Unfortunately, whenever you sign your name on loan papers whether it is for your debt or someone else's, you are creating a binding legal relationship. The lender, also called the creditor be it a bank, credit union or credit card issuer has obtained in the fine print the right to sue you on your guaranty for the debt involved. In other words you and the person you are signing with are both equally 100% liable for the debt.

Hopefully, the person with whom you have co-signed will make every payment as they become due and you will never be confronted with this issue. But, if they ever default on payments, the creditor has the right to come after you and they almost always do so. The creditor does not even have to sue the primary with you on the lawsuit especially if they know you have the means to pay the debt and the primary does not. In reality that is the main reason you were asked to sign in the first place, because the creditor knew you could pay if the primary did not.

As you can see, co-signing or guaranteeing debts for others come with real financial exposure. If a creditor files a garnishment against you on a judgment they have obtained against you for a debt that is either solely yours or one that you co-signed for, please give us a call. We can help you!

I'VE WRITTEN ON THIS subject a few times but not a day goes by that someone-- usually a senior citizen -- calls to wonder if they just got scammed. My hope is that you will cut out this article and share it with an elderly person (or a young gullible person) and save them some heartache. Tech support scams are big business. They have victimized an estimated 3.3 million people and have raked in over \$1.5 billion last year. That equates to one victim every 10 seconds with an average loss of close to \$500 per victim.

There are two ways of perpetrating this scam: The first is a phone call from a

person (often with a thick Indian accent) posing as Microsoft, Comcast, Dell, McAfee, or Symantec who insists you have a virus on your computer. They will then walk the victim through installing some software that will allow the scammer to take remote control of the victim's computer. Once he has access, he will invariably find a "virus" and will go into great detail of how this virus steals your bank account information or puts illegal pornographic material on your computer.

The second way is a scary looking pop-up with big red letters that implores you to call an 800-number immediately. This notice often locks-up your computer. If you happen to run into this, simply shut down your computer by pressing and holding the power button for a few seconds. The vast majority of the time, you'll not see this message again. If you see the message after restarting your computer, you may have a bit of malware that will need some attention from a professional.

Many of my clients who call me about this scam stridently insist that the scammer actually showed them the virus infection. Whatever they said is a lie! Your computer does not have a virus. The scammers will often pester you with phone calls until you finally either give in or tell them to pee up a rope. My advice is to tell them to pee up a rope and stop answering the phone.

What these people are doing is beyond cruel. If you are a senior citizen (or gullible young person) and feel like you can't even answer your phone, your life can become very lonely inside your own home. So far, our government has essentially given these scammers a free ticket to scam you. You need to write your congressman. What if you did actually get scammed and did give them your money?

All is not lost! Credit card companies are very forgiving of these kinds of things. Simply call them, tell them what happened, and they will almost always give you your money back.

Again, please share this with your elderly loved ones. Let them know that Microsoft or Comcast (nor anyone else for that matter) will never ever call you about a virus on their computer.

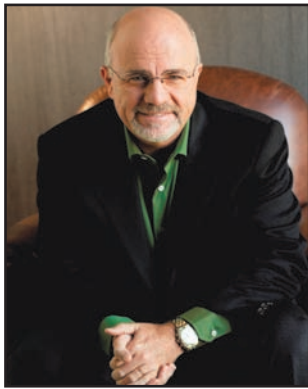

STAY THE COURSE



Dear Dave,
Our daughter is a special needs child, who doctors say will live about half as long as the average adult. There's also a good chance she will be under our care her entire life. We just finished Baby Step 3 of your plan, so we have all of our debt paid off except for the house, and we have an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses saved. We have health insurance, too. However, we were wondering how the situation with our little girl affects retirement planning and college funding?
Jonathan

Dear Jonathan,
I know this may sound strange, but the situation with your daughter really doesn't affect things all that much. The only real difference is that it sounds like you'll be responsible for your sweet daughter for the foreseeable future — not just until she's 18 or 21.

If you don't already have it, you and your wife should both buy 10 to 12 times your annual incomes in term life insurance. Make sure the money from the policies is set up to go into a special needs trust that would be managed for her care. That way, your baby will be taken care of in the event something unexpected happens to you.

Otherwise, just keep following my plan. Baby Step 4 means you start putting 15 percent of your income into pre-tax retirement plans, like Roth IRAs and mutual funds. Baby Step 5 is college funding, if that's a consideration for her, followed by paying off your home early. Then, of course, the last Baby Step is building wealth and giving.

Financially speaking, you're looking at filling a need in the event of your deaths. This should be covered by life insurance or investments. If you reach a point where your investments are substantial, and money from those things can adequately cover her needs and the needs of your family, then you can always drop the insurance policies.

TIME TO RAISE PRICES?

Dear Dave,
My husband has his own one-man painting business, and I help him with the books. We were wondering how you know when it's time to implement a price increase. Also, what should the increase be?
Lauren

Dear Lauren,
I grew up in the real estate business, so I'll use the apartment-complex model as my example. If your building is completely full, then it's time to raise prices a little bit until you have a vacancy. In this type of scenario, you want a healthy level of vacancy, meaning you're always going to be losing some customers as you go up in prices.

In your husband's case, if he's booked through the end of the month, he's way underpriced. Just keep on turning in your bids, and don't make a big deal about things. It isn't like a tenant, in your case, where you're going back time and time again except in rare cases. You might start with a 10 percent increase, and see what happens for a while. If that goes well, wait a bit and raise them another 10 percent.

There are only so many hours in a day this guy can work, so the only other option is to take on staff. But before I start staffing, I'm going to raise prices and cut the number of customers that way. In most cases with the construction business, if you show up when you say you will, complete the job when you say you will, and you do high quality work, there's almost no ceiling on what you can make!

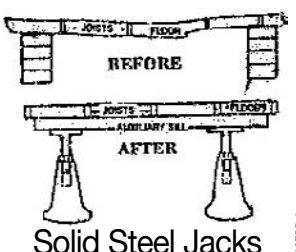

Greatest Game Classics

Football season is almost upon us and you can just feel the excitement in the air. Deshler High School has had many great football teams in their history that's produced many exciting games. This fall will mark the 55th anniversary of one of those greatest game classics.

The date was November 6, 1961. The scene: Ogle Stadium in Decatur. Deshler versus Decatur. The Red Raiders were undefeated and ranked number one in the state. Decatur was led by legendary coach "Shorty" Ogle, who was widely recognized as the inventor of the Wing-T offense.

Deshler entered the game as a two-touchdown underdog. The Red Raiders featured future Alabama signee Jimmy Mitchell at quarterback and Auburn signee Don Lewis at fullback. The Tigers were coached by future Hall of Fame coach Buddy Moore and were led by a host of future major college players including George Patton, Vance Evans, Clifford Winefordner, John Allen Gamble, John Robinson, Terry Mitchell and Don Jeffries.

Rayford Basden, who scored one of the Tigers' touchdowns, remembers the game well. "We were confident," Basden said. "We came out in the Notre Dame Box offense and caught them off guard." The Tigers potent ground game rushed for 200 yards with Gamble picking up 98 of them. George Patton scored two touchdowns as the Tigers scored 19 unanswered points to lead 19-0 after three quarters.

The Tigers defense was awesome, completely shutting down Decatur's vaunted running attack behind the front five alignment of Evans,

Mitchell, Jeffries, Robinson and Ronnie Kirkland. Mitchell called it "the greatest game I've ever been associated with." Buddy Moore put the game in the proper perspective:

"The boys wanted the win and they went out and got it." Final: Deshler 19, Decatur 7.
 The Tigers finished the season with an 8-1-1 record. Deshler's defense gave up only 54 points all season and recorded four shutouts. Deshler High School has won three football State Championships in their history. In 1961, there were no playoffs in effect. If there had been, my guess is that Deshler High School very well might have had four State Championships by now.

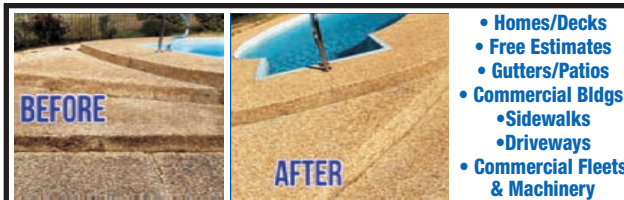

Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part B"

Medicare Part B is the part of Medicare that is billed when you receive services as an outpatient by a Medicare approved provider such as your primary care physician (PCP) or specialist. Although a visit to your doctor is the primary way that you will use Medicare Part B it also covers many other services. Before we look at exactly what Part B covers let's discuss couple of other things.

Whereas Medicare Part A is free to most Americans, Medicare Part B has a cost or premium. For those people who were enrolled in Medicare Part B prior to 2016 the premium for having Part B is \$104.90/month. If you enrolled or are enrolling into Medicare Part B for the first time in 2016 your premium will be \$121.80. Why the difference in premium? Because those enrolled in Part B prior to 2016 did not receive a COLA on their Social Security for 2016 there could not be an increase in their Part B premium. Also these premiums are income based. If you make over a certain income limit your Part B premium can be higher.

Because there is a premium attached to Medicare Part B this coverage is optional. This means you are not required to enroll in Medicare Part B. There are two important things to remember about Part B being optional. First, if you opt out of Part B you will have no coverage under Medicare for your outpatient services. Second, if you decide at a later date to enroll in Part B there can be a late enrollment penalty applied that will last as long as you live and have Part B. There are exceptions to the late enrollment penalty that we will discuss in future articles.



focus upon two cases that are being adjudicated in the context of a memorial service for executed cops created a moral equivalency that can only lead to additional violence against the police.

Obama's deliberate decision to equate the targeted deaths of five officers who were protecting a Black Lives Matter rally to two separate in the line of duty shootings in

Minnesota and Louisiana and created the implicit okay for the future targeting of the police.

Make no mistake, I don't know enough facts about the police shootings that he referenced to know if they were justified or not, but the truth is, neither did Obama.

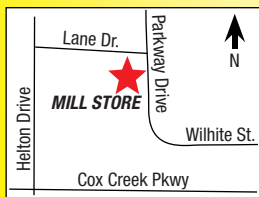

do the same. This bill would make permanent an annual appropriations rider called the Weldon Amendment which bars federal funds, including funds to states, if the government discriminates against those who object to participating in abortion. It adds a private right of action to allow victims of such discrimination a chance to go to court. This legislation is needed because of lawlessness and government discrimination against pro-lifers.

The federal Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has dragged its feet handling complains of such anti-life discrimination, and recently decided to reinterpret the law as an excuse not to enforce it.

This legislation is necessary to enable victims of government discrimination over their pro-life views (including churches, doctors, and nurses) to pursue legal action against the state for violating their consciences. The Conscience Protection Act (CPA) is about basic fairness for everyone. The House passed the bill in a historic debate and vote, with all of the GOP leadership, including Speaker Ryan of Wisconsin, Leader McCarthy of California, Whip Scalise of Louisiana and Chairman of the House Republican Conference Cathy McMorris Rodgers of Washington, speaking on the floor. The bill passed by a vote of 245 to 182.

Hopefully the Senate will follow the House's example and pass this legislation, forcing Obama to decide whether the freedom to believe still has a place in American society.

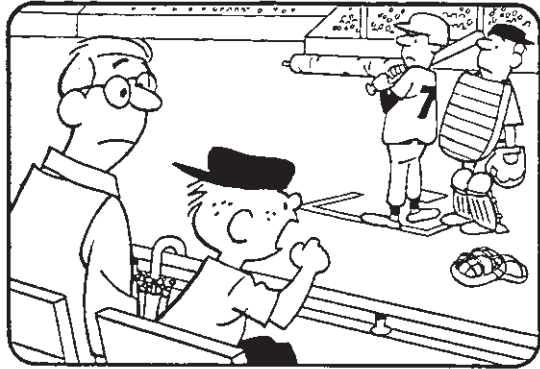

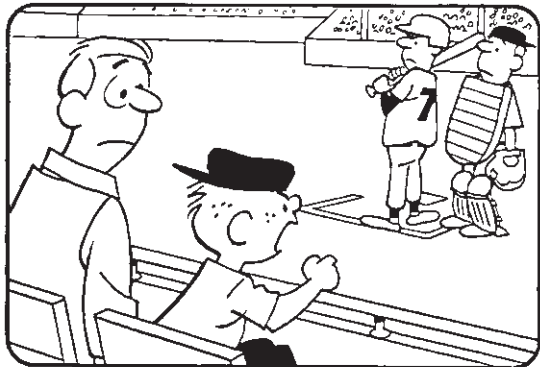
