How do I get a doctor in my on the job injury case when my employer denies that I even had an injury at work but I did. Randy, Killen, AL

For most of the 30 years that I've handled workers compensation cases representing injured workers, we could file a motion with the court to compel medical care.

However, the Court of Civil Appeals in 2007 in a case called Ex parte Publix Supermarkets 963 So.2d 654 completely changed the law in this area. By the way, the 963 is the book in the series Southern 2d which covers Alabama and a few nearby states and the 654 is the page the case is found. In this case, the trial court granted the injured worker's motion to compel medical treatment. I had filed these motions for years and absent some wildly unusual circumstance, they were always granted.

After 2007, the Court of Civil Appeals ruled that there was no such "motion to compel medical treatment" and required the injured worker to take a doctor's deposition to obtain medical evidence that the doctor believed the injury occurred on the job and any other evidence that had some bearing on the issue such as a first report or injury or a witness who saw the accident and try one half of the case to establish liability and then the court could and would order medical treatment.

As you can see, when there is a controversy regarding an employer's obligation to pay for medical treatment, you have to follow the court's holding in Ex Parte Publix Supermarkets and take a doctor's deposition, get your witnesses and ask for a "bifurcated hearing". This is not something that someone without a lawyer will be able to do.

Remember that legitimate workers compensation attorneys never ask for any money up front and pay all of the costs of obtaining the doctor's testimony and other items necessary for trying half the case. After that is done successfully and the injured person obtains medical treatment, you cannot resolve the case until the injured worker reaches what is known as "MMI". MMI is a term that means maximum medical improvement and is the point at which temporary total disability payments stop and no payment is made until the case is resolved. At the end of the case, the lawyer can recoup his expenses plus charge a 15% attorney's fee.

Buckle up and drive safely.



Do you have five minutes?

One had a wife and couldn't come, so the host decided to seek others to fill his house and sit at his table. The original guests would not be allowed to taste of the supper. Look at Acts 26:19-32. In this passage, Paul shares his testimony with King Agrippa, who listened very attentively. However, in the end, he walked away, saying, "Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian. As the old hymn goes, "Almost, but lost." In your lifetime, God may present you with several opportunities to receive Christ, or He may just give you one. Don't wait, thinking you'll have another chance tomorrow. Tomorrow may never come. Read Proverbs 27:1. II Corinthians 6:2 says, "Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation." Take five minutes to hear and receive the gospel. Read John 1:12-13. Your soul's destiny depends on it.

subject a few times but not a day goes by that someone-usually a senior citizen -- calls to wonder if they just got scammed. My hope is that you will cut out this article and share it with an elderly person

(or a young gullible person) and save them some heartache. Tech support scams are big business. They have victimized an estimated 3.3 million people and have raked

in over \$1.5 billion last year. That equates to one victim every 10 seconds with an average loss of close to \$500 per victim.

There are two ways of perpetrating this scam: The first is a phone call from a



person (often with a thick Indian accent) posing as Microsoft, Comcast, Dell, McAfee, or Symantec who insists you have a virus on your computer. They will then walk the victim through installing some software that will allow the scammer to take remote control of the victim's computer. Once he has access, he will invariably find a "virus" and will go into great detail of how this virus steals your bank account information or puts illegal pornographic material on your computer.

The second way is a scary looking pop-up with big red letters that implores you to call an 800-number immediately. This notice often locks-up your computer. If you happen to run into this, simply shut down your computer by pressing and holding the power button for a few seconds. The vast majority of the time, you'll not see this message again. If you see the message after restarting your computer, you may have a bit of malware that will need some attention from a professional.

Many of my clients who call me about this scam stridently insist that the scammer actually showed them the virus infection. Whatever they said is a lie! Your computer does not have a virus. The scammers will often pester you with phone calls until you finally either give in or tell them to pee up a rope. My advice is to tell them to pee up a rope and stop answering the phone.

What these people are doing is beyond cruel. If you are a senior citizen (or gullible young person) and feel like you can't even answer your phone, your life can become very lonely inside your own home. So far, our government has essentially given these scammers a free ticket to scam you. You need to write your congressman. What if you did actually get scammed and did give them your money?

All is not lost! Credit card companies are very forgiving of these kinds of things Simply call them, tell them what happened, and they will almost always give you your money back.

Again, please share this with your elderly loved ones. Let them know that Microsoft or Comcast (nor anyone else for that matter) will neverever call you about a virus on their computer.

The Tigers potent ground game rushed for 200 yards with Gamble picking up 98 of them. George Patton scored two touchdowns as the Tigers scored 19 unanswered points to lead 19-0 after three quarters.



Medicare Minute "Medicare Part B"

Medicare Part B is the part of Medicare that is billed when you receive services as an outpatient by a Medicare approved provider such as your primary care physician (PCP) or specialist. Although a visit to your doctor is the primary way that you will use Medicare Part B it also covers many other services. Before we look at exactly what Part B covers let's discuss couple of other things.

Whereas Medicare Part A is free to most Americans, Medicare Part B has a cost or premium. For those people who were enrolled in Medicare Part B prior to 2016 the premium for having Part B is \$104.90/month. If you enrolled or are enrolling into Medicare Part B for the first time in 2016 your premium will be \$121.80. Why the difference in premium? Because those enrolled in Part B prior to 2016 did not receive a COLA on their Social Security for 2016 there could not be an increase in their Part B premium. Also these premiums are income based. If you make over a certain income limit your Part B premium can be higher.

Because there is a premium attached to Medicare Part B this coverage is optional. This means you are not required to enroll in Medicare Part B. There are two important things to remember about Part B being optional. First, if you opt out of Part B you will have no coverage under Medicare for your outpatient services. Second, if you decide at a later date to enroll in Part B there can be a late enrollment penalty applied that will last as long as you live and have Part B. There are exceptions to the late enrollment penalty that we will discuss in future articles.

focus upon two cases that are being adjudicated in the context of a memorial service for executed cops created a moral equivalency that can only lead to additional violence against the police.

Obama's deliberate decision to equate the targeted deaths of five officers who were protecting a Black Lives Matter rally to two separate in the line of duty shootings in Minnesota and Louisiana and created the implicit okay for the future targeting of the police.



do the same. This bill would make permanent an annual appropriations rider called the Weldon Amendment which bars federal funds, including funds to states, if the government discriminates against those who object to participating in abortion. It adds a private right of action to allow victims of such discrimination a chance to go to court. This legislation is needed because of lawlessness and government discrimination against prolifers.

The federal Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has dragged its feet handling complains of such anti-life discrimination, and recently decided to reinterpret the law as an excuse not to enforce it.

This legislation is necessary to enable victims of government discrimination over their pro-life views (including churches, doctors, and nurses) to pursue legal action against the state for violating their consciences. The Conscience Protection Act (CPA) is about basic fairness for everyone. The House passed the bill in a historic debate and vote, with all of the GOP leadership, including Speaker Ryan of Wisconsin, McCarthy Leader of California, Whip Scalise of Louisiana and Chairman of the House Republican Conference Cathy McMorris Rodgers of Washington, speaking on the floor. The bill passed by a vote of 245 to 182.

Hopefully the Senate will follow the House's example and pass this legislation, forcing Obama to decide whether the freedom to believe still has a place in American society.






