

Do You Hear, but it's Not Clear?



Inside the cochlea are thousands of microscopic hair cells called Stereocilia, and these hair cells sense the motion of sound waves.

Consonants like S, T, K, and P, are sensed in the initial section of the cochlea.

Medium speech tones are picked up in the mid section.

The low tones of speech are picked up in the last section.

funnel sound to your ear drum. Sometimes the canal becomes plugged with wax, which mimics a hearing loss because it blocks sound from reaching your eardrum. Use of a cotton swab will pack wax even more. We will check for impacted wax with a video ear camera to see if this is a problem.

cochlea. Otosclerosis is the calcification of these bones, resulting in conductive hearing loss. About 10% of people have this type of loss.

Hearing Problem #3


The cochlea is a snail-shaped organ containing thousands of living hair cells called stereocilia. A condition known as Sensorineural hearing loss (nerve type hearing loss) occurs when any of the hair cells become damaged. About 90% of hearing loss is this type. A new hearing computer has now been released that is programmed specifically for the frequencies of hair cells that are damaged, resulting in improved speech understanding.

Hearing Problem #4

Tinnitus is the phantom sensation of ringing in the ears. It is the result of damaged or misfiring nerves between the cochlea and the brain. A specialist will identify the tone of your tinnitus and demo how the hearing computer may reduce it.

If You Could Unroll The Cochlea's Tube

In a healthy cochlea, all hair cells are alive and standing upright. As sound waves move through the fluid within the cochlea, each hair cell fires and sends an electrical impulse through the Eighth Nerve to the brain.



Damaged hair cells don't fire properly and some sounds (fricatives and high tones) are not transmitted to the brain. Hair cell damage is a natural part of aging. It can be caused by moderate sounds over long periods, loud sounds over short periods, or even by prescriptions.

Tim Duncan Was One of a Kind

Tim Duncan was the best power forward I've ever seen, and I've been watching since his days at Wake Forest

I know I'm not the only Maryland Terrapin who remembers standing outside Cole Field House in freezing cold weather for hours, just to make sure we got great seats to watch a Wake Forest team with the best big man in the ACC. We were surprised he stayed at Wake Forest for four years — he would have been a first round pick any year — and it didn't take a genius to figure he'd play well in the NBA.

It's safe to say that he exceeded expectations.

He's played for only one team, for one coach. He was the only person to win a championship in three different decades. College player of the year, rookie of the year, All-Star MVP, regular season MVP (three times) and NBA Finals MVP (twice). Only Michael Jordan and Larry Bird can say they did something like that. Only Kareem Abdul-Jabbar and Robert Parish have won more games. He and Kareem Abdul-Jabaar are the only players in NBA history with 26,000 points, 15,000 rebounds and 3,000 blocks

Fifteen times, he was an all-star. Every one of his seasons ended with the San Antonio Spurs going to the

playoffs. Five times, his team took the crown — including one time from the King himself, the year that San Antonio avenged their loss in the previous year, picking themselves up and beating Miami. With the exception of the lockout season, the Spurs won more than 50 games each season. There are 20-year-old Knicks fans vomiting tears when they hear that.

He was 42 ... of course we knew that he was going to retire. But look at the way he did. He simply said nothing. No press conferences, no season-long adulation tour, no victory lap. He isn't even going to attend the press conference regarding his retirement. That is an instant classic. Contrast the way he left the game and the way Kobe Bryant left. The Lakers were a joke last season, but Kobe scored 60 in his final game and made sure everyone knew just how proud he was of himself. Not Duncan. "The Big Fundamental" was trying to win another championship.

He didn't have a clothing collection; there were no collectors' item shoes, no commercials of him driving a Buick. None of that. You know what else there was none of? No tirades about being late for practice, no holding out for an outrageous raise, no temper tantrums if he wasn't the guy chosen to take the last-second shot. I scoured the Interwebs, looking for a story about how Tim Duncan once saved somebody's life ... and found nothing of the sort.

When you look at a guy like Tim Duncan, you say to yourself, "They just don't make players like that anymore." They really don't. He was one of a kind

1. Prepare a fire in your grill according to manufacturer's directions. When all the charcoal is lit and covered with gray ash, evenly spread out coals over half of the coal grate. Alternatively, set half the burners of a gas grill to high heat. Set cooking grate in place, cover grill and allow to preheat for 5 minutes. Clean and oil the grilling grate.

2. While the grill heats, combine mayonnaise, sour cream, yogurt or crema, cheese, garlic and chili powder, and cilantro or parsley in a large bowl. Stir until well-combined and set aside.

3. When grill is hot, place corn directly over hot side of grill and cook, rotating occasionally, until cooked through and charred in spots on all sides, about 8 minutes total.

4. Transfer corn to a bowl with the mayonnaise mixture. Use a large spoon to evenly coat corn on all sides with mixture. Sprinkle with extra cheese and chili powder. Serve immediately with lime wedges. Makes 4 servings.



HOLLYWOOD — "Mary Poppins Returns" will be the sequel to "Mary Poppins" (for which Julie Andrews won her Oscar in 1964). Emily Blunt, who starred in "Edge of Tomorrow" (with Tom Cruise), the Stephen Sondheim musical "Into the Woods' and "The Huntsman: Winter Wars," will play Mary Poppins this time around. Blunt and husband John Krasinski ("The Office" and "13 Hours: The Secret Soldiers of Benghazi") have one child, Hazel Grace, and are expecting their second child later this year. Her next film, "Girl on the Train," with Justin Theroux, Luke Evans and Allison Janney, is due

Disney hopes to cash in on the smashing success of Lin-Manuel Miranda, author and star of the hip-hop musical "Hamilton" (which was nominated for a record 16 Tony Awards), by co-starring him with Blunt. P.L. Travers wrote seven more Mary Poppins books, any one of which this may be based on. The story is set in Depression-era London and revolves around Jane and Michael (the Banks children) and Michael's three children. Miranda will play Jack the Lamplighter (which sounds akin to the chimney sweep that Dick Van Dyke played). Miranda's work for Disney includes writing music for "Star Wars: The Force Awakens" and the animated 'Moana," which features the voice of Dwayne Johnson.

Johnson will follow "Moana" (Nov. 23), "Fast 8" (April 14) and "Baywatch" (May 19) by producing and starring in a remake of the 1975 Ron Ely film "Doc Savage: Man of Bronze," which was not a huge success.

"Deadpool," which earned \$754 million in theaters, has crushed the DVD/ Blu-ray market, taking the No. 1 spot er, "Deadpool" star Ryan Reynolds didn't do as well with "Criminal,"

which opened April 15. It cost \$31.5 million but earned only \$32.7 million, despite having Kevin Costner, Gary Oldman, Tommy Lee Jones and "Wonder Woman" Gal Gadot in the cast. Reynolds' next film is "The Hitman's Bodyguard," with Samuel L. Jackson, Gary Oldman and Selma Hayek.

Also on the casualty list are "Nice Guys," with **Ryan Gosling** and **Russell Crowe**, which cost \$50 million to make and took in only \$28.5 in theaters, and the soft opening of "Alice Through the Looking Glass," which cost \$170 million and opened lower than expected at \$105.3 million. It'll be a long haul to catch the original. which made over a billion dollars.


