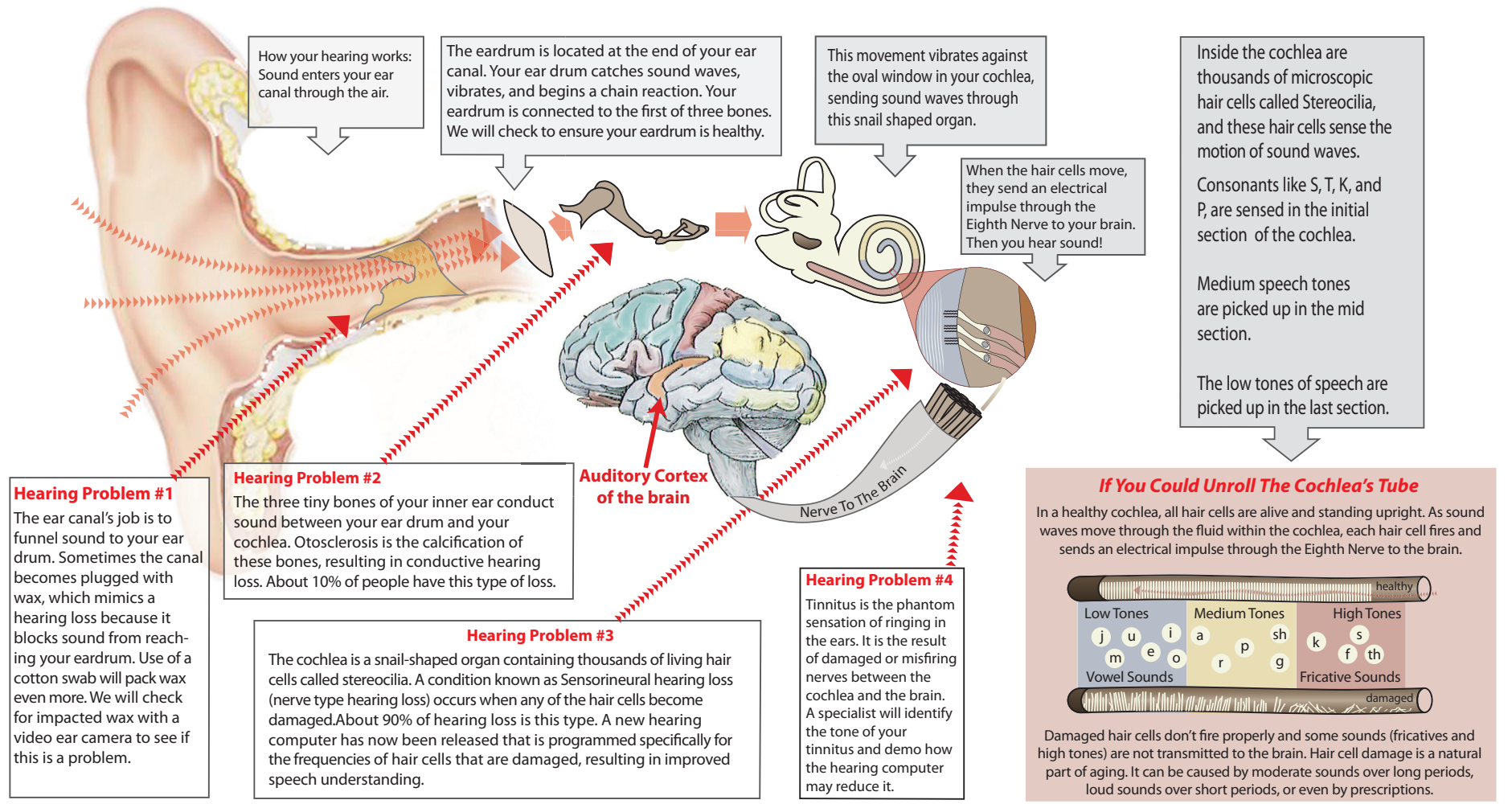

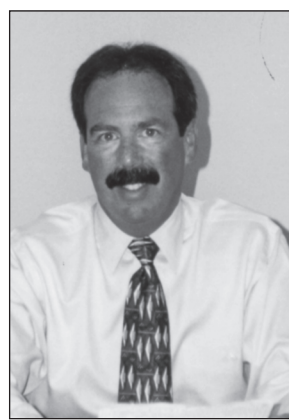

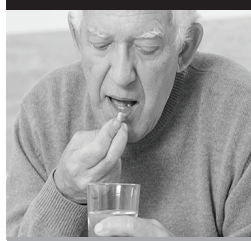

Donna's Day Creative family fun

Cool Summer Snacks

The playful, less-structured days of summer signal a change in family schedules, especially when it comes to eating habits. Instead of three structured meals, kids seem to graze all day long and hang around an open refrigerator door. Keep ahead of the game when hunger strikes. Here are some tasty and healthy ideas for the little snackers in your household:

fresh fruit, such as grapes, watermelon and strawberries, on wooden skewers. Wrap each fruit kebab in plastic wrap and freeze. When it's time for a treat for your school-age kids, remove from the freezer and enjoy!

Yogurt Popsicles

In a medium-size bowl, stir together 1-pint low-fat plain yogurt and six tablespoons of frozen orange-juice concentrate. Add a dash of vanilla if desired. Spoon the mixture into Popsicle molds or waxed paper cups. Cover the cups with foil and poke Popsicle sticks through the center of each covered cup. Freeze. To serve, remove foil and peel away the cup or pop it out of the cup. Don't sweat the drips if you're serving them on a hot day. Just push the stick through paper muffin cups that will catch the drips to keep small hands sticky-free.



Nature's Basics

Stick to the basics, and take advantage of "pick your own" berries, vine-ripe melons at fruit stands, fresh-squeezed juices and selected veggies from the local farmer's market or your own backyard garden patch. A basket of peaches here and a bowl of nuts or grapes there not only make snacking easy and nutritious, but the tempting bounty looks beautiful on the kitchen table.

Infused Water

Keep kids hydrated. To add pizzazz to a glass of water, make a citrus fruit infusion in a big pitcher in the morning and leave it in the refrigerator or on the counter throughout the day. Simply toss thin slices of lemon, lime or grapefruit in the water for an easy, thirst-quenching drink. Get creative and vary with slices of apple, mango, kiwi or chunks of peeled pineapple for tasty alternatives.

Stick a variety of whole or cubed

playoffs. Five times, his team took the crown — including one time from the King himself, the year that San Antonio avenged their loss in the previous year, picking themselves up and beating Miami. With the exception of the lockout season, the Spurs won more than 50 games each season. There are 20-year-old Knicks fans vomiting tears when they hear that.

He was 42 ... of course we knew that he was going to retire. But look at the way he did. He simply said nothing. No press conferences, no season-long adulation tour, no victory lap. He isn't even going to attend the press conference regarding his retirement. That is an instant classic. Contrast the way he left the game and the way Kobe Bryant left. The Lakers were a joke last season, but Kobe scored 60 in his final game and made sure everyone knew just how proud he was of himself. Not Duncan. "The Big Fundamental" was trying to win another championship.

He didn't have a clothing collection; there were no collectors' item shoes, no commercials of him driving a Buick. None of that. You know what else there was none of? No tirades about being late for practice, no holding out for an outrageous raise, no temper tantrums if he wasn't the guy chosen to take the last-second shot. I scoured the Interwebs, looking for a story about how Tim Duncan once saved somebody's life ... and found nothing of the sort.

When you look at a guy like Tim Duncan, you say to yourself, "They just don't make players like that anymore." They really don't. He was one of a kind.

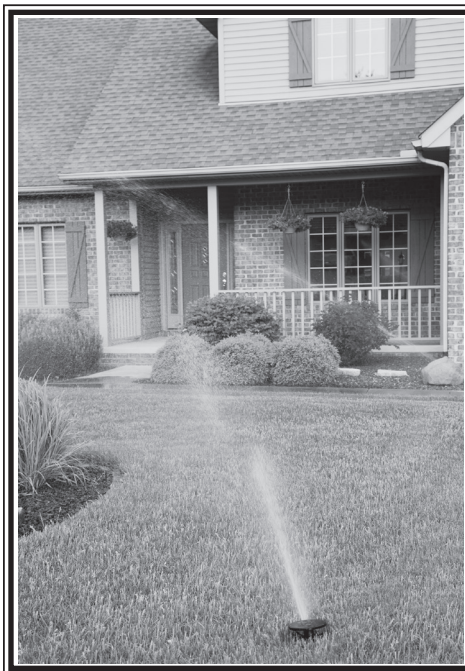

Jayne Mansfield Hot Water Bottle

Q. I have a 1957 Jayne Mansfield hot water bottle. Does it have any value? — *Tim, Taylor, Michigan*

A. Your Jayne Mansfield container doubled as both a hot water bottle and cocktail shaker. It was made by Poynter Products in 1957 and featured a storage stand. With the original cap and stand, and in good condition, your item is probably worth in the \$75 to \$150 range, according to several I found on eBay.

Q. My husband has several large albums of old and new postage stamps, even some from Nazi Germany. Would anyone be interested in them? — *Maxine, Albuquerque, New Mexico*

A. You have several excellent coin and stamp dealers in Albuquerque, and that is where you should begin your search. My advice is that you contact at least two dealers to get an idea of current demand and values. There is a website that also might be helpful: www.stamp-collecting-resource.com.

Q. I have a small syrup pitcher that I have been told is a piece of Stemless Daisy. It is very similar to milk glass but has relief-molded flowers on a crosscut background, which is much different from the milk glass I have seen. Can you help me identify this piece? — *Barbara, Rio Rancho, New Mexico*

A. Stemless Daisy, sometimes called Cosmos, is a pattern glass that was produced by Consolidated Lamp and Glass Company between 1894 and about 1915. Although milk glass, the floral design makes the Cosmos pieces unique. Although I was unable to find Cosmos glass being offered on eBay, I suspect your pitcher might be valued in the \$200 to \$300 range. It is rare, it is early, and it is desirable.

Q. I have an incredible collection of baseball cards that was started by my dad during the 1950s. Although I haven't counted them, they fill six shoeboxes. Can you recommend some price guides? — *Henry, Davenport, Iowa*

A. There are several excellent guides. Three I especially like are "Baseball Card Price Guide" by Joe Clemens, "The Standard Catalogue of Baseball Cards" edited by Don Fluckinger, and "Baseball Card Price Guide" by the editors of Sports Collectors Digest, all published by Krause Books.

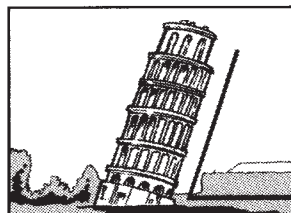

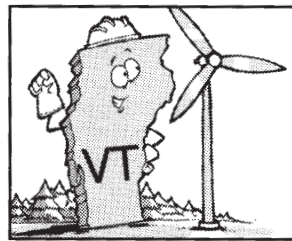

Summer on the Cob

Summer is the time of year when I get what I call "produce overload." There are so many fresh, plump, delicious, vibrant fruits and vegetables available, and so many ways to prepare them! Currently, I'm in love with the flavor infusion that heat and smoke impart to fresh fruits and vegetables prepared on the grill.

Corn on the cob is in abundance now, and it's the perfect vegetable to grill. This is the season to indulge in this almost candy-like vegetable that is a favorite of so many. Farm-fresh corn is blatantly delicious in its simplicity, and with every bite we get a chance to re-create and relive a treasured food memory.

While we all know how important corn, or maize, was as an early American food, it has taken scientists decades to learn how corn evolved as a domesticated, cultivated grain. They now know that corn, like wheat and rice, has a wild ancestor. Corn is related to a grass called teosinte. Over many years, but with surprisingly dramatic effects, early farmers began the process of seed selection, saving and planting kernels from plants with desirable characteristics. This was the primitive beginning of hybridization.

The early corn of our ancestors was called field corn and was somewhat different from what we grow and eat today. Some field corn was eaten fresh, but most of it was used dried and ground into cornmeal. It also

was used as a livestock feed. Today, corn has countless uses, making it one of the most studied, reviewed and important crops of our agricultural economy.

Many people today wonder if corn is even good for us. While it's true that corn is high in sugar and starch, it possesses a healthy dose of vitamins and minerals, like vitamin B-6 and magnesium. It also contains a significant amount of dietary fiber. Add to that the simple pleasure eating a fresh ear of corn.

Try my recipe for the guiltiest of grilled corn pleasures, Mexican street corn with chile and lime. Taking that first bite is a taste sensation, and something we shouldn't deny ourselves. It also creates yet another

happy summer food memory, and that has got to be good for you.

MEXICAN STREET CORN WITH CHILE AND LIME

This flavorful corn recipe also is known as Elotes, which in Spanish means "corn," "fresh corn" or "sweet corn." It's often sold in Mexico by street vendors, and in America from food carts and at fairs. This recipe serves one ear of corn per person, but

I'd double it. It's hard to eat just one when it's prepared this way!

- 1/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup sour cream, Greek yogurt or Mexican crema
- 1/2 cup finely crumbled cotija or feta cheese, plus more for serving
- 1 tablespoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ancho or guajillo chili powder, plus more for serving
- 1/4 cup finely chopped cilantro or parsley leaves and tender stems
- 4 ears shucked corn
- 1 lime, cut into wedges

1. Prepare a fire in your grill according to manufacturer's directions. When all the charcoal is lit and covered with gray ash, evenly spread out coals over half of the coal grate. Alternatively, set half the burners of a gas grill to high heat. Set cooking grate in place, cover grill and allow to preheat for 5 minutes. Clean and oil the grilling grate.

2. While the grill heats, combine mayonnaise, sour cream, yogurt or crema, cheese, garlic and chili powder, and cilantro or parsley in a large bowl. Stir until well-combined and set aside.

3. When grill is hot, place corn directly over hot side of grill and cook, rotating occasionally, until cooked through and charred in spots on all sides, about 8 minutes total.

4. Transfer corn to a bowl with the mayonnaise mixture. Use a large spoon to evenly coat corn on all sides with mixture. Sprinkle with extra cheese and chili powder. Serve immediately with lime wedges. Makes 4 servings.

HOLLYWOOD — “Mary Poppins Returns” will be the sequel to “Mary Poppins” (for which Julie Andrews won her Oscar in 1964). Emily Blunt, who starred in “Edge of Tomorrow” (with Tom Cruise), the Stephen Sondheim musical “Into the Woods” and “The Huntsman: Winter Wars,” will play Mary Poppins this time around. Blunt and husband John Krasinski (“The Office” and “13 Hours: The Secret Soldiers of Benghazi”) have one child, Hazel Grace, and are expecting their second child later this year. Her next film, “Girl on the Train,” with Justin Theroux, Luke Evans and Allison Janney, is due Oct. 7.

Disney hopes to cash in on the smashing success of Lin-Manuel Miranda, author and star of the hip-hop musical “Hamilton” (which was nominated for a record 16 Tony Awards), by co-starring him with Blunt. P.L. Travers wrote seven more Mary Poppins books, any one of which this may be based on. The story is set in Depression-era London and revolves around Jane and Michael (the Banks children) and Michael’s three children. Miranda will play Jack the Lamplighter (which sounds akin to the chimney sweep that Dick Van Dyke played). Miranda’s work for Disney includes writing music for “Star Wars: The Force Awakens” and the animated “Moana,” which features the voice of Dwayne Johnson.

Johnson will follow “Moana” (Nov. 23), “Fast 8” (April 14) and “Baywatch” (May 19) by producing and starring in a remake of the 1975 Ron Ely film “Doc Savage: Man of Bronze,” which was not a huge success.

“Deadpool,” which earned \$754 million in theaters, has crushed the DVD/Blu-ray market, taking the No. 1 spot its first two weeks on sale. However, “Deadpool” star Ryan Reynolds didn’t do as well with “Criminal,”

which opened April 15. It cost \$31.5 million but earned only \$32.7 million, despite having Kevin Costner, Gary Oldman, Tommy Lee Jones and “Wonder Woman” Gal Gadot in the cast. Reynolds’ next film is “The Hitman’s Bodyguard,” with Samuel L. Jackson, Gary Oldman and Selma Hayek.

Also on the casualty list are “Nice Guys,” with Ryan Gosling and Russell Crowe, which cost \$50 million to make and took in only \$28.5 million in theaters, and the soft opening of “Alice Through the Looking Glass,” which cost \$170 million and opened lower than expected at \$105.3 million. It’ll be a long haul to catch the original, which made over a billion dollars.

The box-office dip may have been caused by the beating allegations made against Johnny Depp by his wife, Amber Heard. Imagine saying the first week’s grosses were a disappointing \$105 million? I’d cry for them, but I need to save my tears because of the drought we’re having in California!

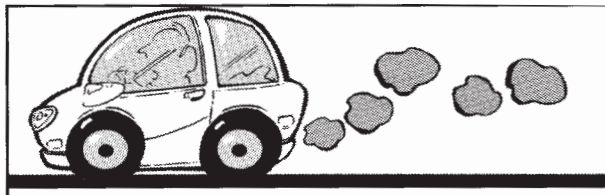


