

I would hope that you would look into some anger management if dumb things like this cause you to become explosive. The screaming. The flailing arms. The vulgarity. It's really not worth this much drama. Chill out.

Dear "Speak Out,"

Taking part in the political process is an exciting thing. Supporting a particular candidate can make one feel more connected, involved, to the issues "their" candidate stands for. It sets an example of civic engagement for younger people, and instills hope that the dysfunctional (in many ways fractured) political climate can change. In many ways, it's a pivotal component of the democratic process.

This support is done with the knowledge that others may not agree with our individual choice. One of the great things about America is that it's diverse--and everyone's opinion has value. We have the freedom to choose, and the freedom to disagree--but we don't have to be disrespectful about it.

I've lived in Mount Morris for my entire life, and I was always proud to be in "the most patriotic town in America." But increasingly I'm seeing--in person and online--a distinct turn; language that seeks to divide us into "left and right," instead of unite us as "Americans." That's not patriotic to me. The unjustified hostility needs to stop.

I don't march into others' yards to uproot the "Make America Great Again" signs. Because they're not mine, and telling another American that their choice doesn't matter is undermining the ENTIRE political process. So why is it okay to come onto my property and steal (not one, but also its replacement) Bernie sign?
