"The program is aimed at students between 6th and 12th grades from lower income backgrounds who will be the first in their families to attend college. The program also encourages persons who have not completed education programs at the secondary or postsecondary level to enter or re-enter and complete postsecondary education.

The Educational Talent Search Program identifies and assists those who have the potential to succeed in higher education. The program provides academic, career, and financial counseling to its participants. It encourages them to graduate from high school and continue on and complete their postsecondary education.

The Talent Search program is one of three TRiO programs, including Upward Bound and Student Support Services, at NW-SCC. The programs are 100% federally funded by the U.S. Department of Education.



For patients: make your own choices by having a living will and a Power of Attorney with someone you trust to honor your wishes and not allow you to suffer.

For families: consider the following as you make decisions.

Dr. Robert Webb * If adults hope a parent won't die before them, ask: would you want your own child to die before you? The answer is, "of course not"! Parents do not want to outlive their children.

Adult children often say, when coping with an impending death, 'at least we did everything'. Anticipating death generates many grief reactions—anger, sadness, guilt [read Dunn's "Hard Choices for Loving People"]—that can make us feel we are 'giving up' rather than 'giving over' and lead us to do things that rob a loved one of a peaceful

* Doctors feel pressured to use the latest technology to 'do everything'. Because seniors respond differently to treatments compared to younger adults (studies are usually based on younger people [Ioannidis. Why Most Published] Research Findings Are False. 2005]), the American Geriatrics Society recommends 'less is best': seniors live more comfortably and longer with fewer drugs and





I had a car accident and my medical bills were over \$30,000.00. A lawyer told me that I didn't have uninsured motorist coverage and all the coverage the other side had was \$25,000.00. This person pulled out in front of me and the police report confirms they failed to yield the right of way. I thought the law was that the insurance company had to pay all of my medical bills. Isn't his insurance company responsible for my medical

A lot of people are under the misconception that if someone else causes an accident, they have to pay your medical bills. They may be responsible for your medical bills and you may get a judgment against them for that amount or more but you can't spend a judgment.

If a person elects to buy \$25,000.00 worth of coverage and they pay the premium for that coverage, then all

their insurance company has to pay is \$25,000.00. Insurance coverage isn't free and the more you pay, the more coverage you get. If all of the insurance coverage the person that caused your accident bought was \$25,000.00, then that's all the insurance company has to pay.

Generally speaking, people that have only \$25,000.00 worth of coverage don't have a house or land or a retirement account with a lot of money in it. If someone buys a minimum limits policy that has a lot of property or money, it's possible that the agent that sold them a small policy when they are worth a lot of money may have been negligent.

I think that a lot of companies aren't selling or explaining why uninsured motorist coverage is so crucial. You are on the hook for over \$30,000.00 in medical bills through no fault of your own. The hospital can file a lien for almost no cost but you probably can't prosecute a lawsuit to collect the \$25,000.00 and lawyers have to be compensated for their time. That will leave you about \$15,000.00. If the hospital gets a judgment, you won't be able to buy a house or receive an inheritance. Uninsured motorist coverage would not only pay the remaining medical bills but pay you for lost wages and pain and suffering.

Sometimes we are able to negotiate the medical bills down and reach a compromise that pays your bills and puts some money in your pocket. Sometimes the bills are so large, that's just not possible. Always buy coverage in relative to what you own or expect to own.

Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part B Coverage"

Medicare Part B is most used when you visit your primary care physician or specialist. But Medicare Part B is also used for many other medically necessary services. Medicare defines medically necessary as "healthcare services or supplies needed to diagnose or treat an illness, injury, condition or disease, or its symptoms and that meet accepted standards of medicine".

One of these other services covered by Part B is transportation by ambulance. Medicare covers and helps pay for ambulance services only if other types of transportation will endanger your health and will only cover and help pay for you to be transported to the nearest medical facility that's able to give you the care you need. If you choose to be transported to a facility farther away you may have to pay more.

Another service Part B covers is Durable Medical Equipment (DME). DME must be long lasting equipment that is used in your home for medical reasons and has an expected lifetime of at least 3 years. Medicare has a long list of equipment that falls under DME.

One of the most important benefits of Medicare Part B are the preventive services that it covers. These services include health care that is used to prevent illness or detect illness at an early stage.

Medicare.gov list 23 screenings and shots that fall under preventive services. They include things such as mammogram screenings, colorectal cancer screenings and flu shots.

Part B has an annual deductible of \$166 and a coinsurance of 20%. This means that if you have Original Medicare only, with no other supplemental coverage, you will owe the first \$166 filed on Part B each year and after the deductible is met you will be responsible for 20% of the cost of Part B services you

Association and river art from private collections. Dinner will be available from Steak N Stuff.

In recent years Modes has been located on the Upper Mississippi River. He has floated for months at a time collecting the stories of people who live and work on the river from the deck of his shantyboat. This year Modes, his crew and his dog Hazel launched in Knoxville for a journey through Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, and Kentucky.

"A Secret History of American River People is a project to build a collection of personal stories of people who live and work on the river from the deck of a recreated 1940s-era shanty boat over a series of epic river voyages," Modes said in a press release. "The project explores the issues facing current river communities, the long history of people who have lived on and adjacent to the river, and basic river ecology.'

Modes seeks people whose stories are not typically part of the historical record. "I try to find our elders who grew up here and remember a different time and a different river. I talk to poor and working folk and people who grew up poor along the Tennessee River. I find the stories of African-American folk and the stories of native people."

Along with gathering stories of local river people, Modes is exhibiting the project in Knoxville, Cháttanooga, Huntsville, Florence, and Paducah. At exhibitions visitors step onto the recreated shanty boat, pick up the banjo or a book from the library, sit awhile and overhear the stories of shantyboaters, scientists, historians, and locals who live and work on the river.

The project will result in a series of books, short and feature documentaries, and an archive of river stories available to future generations of scholars.







School Choice

"Which school can my kids attend?" Realtors are often asked that by buyers who are either new to our area or moving to a different part of our area. When choosing a new home, most people with school-age children give great consideration to which school their children will attend. Although the Shoals is blessed with many incredible school choices, most people still have a preference. It's an important part of the home-buying decision, and I have always recommended that my clients double-check with the school system to be certain.

I decided to look into it a little further to see if I could be more helpful. This being back-to-school season, all of the administrators are unbelievably busy. (Can you imagine? Instead of getting one or even a few kids ready for school, getting ready for ALL OF THEM?) I was able to catch up with Mike Stamps, Assistant Superintendent of Lauderdale County Schools, and he shared with me how Lauderdale County handles school selection.

According to Stamps, most of their students live in Lauderdale County but outside the city limits of Florence. Lauderdale County Schools will, however, accept out-of-district students "on a case-by-case basis." He says that the parents must initiate a request through the particular school they are interested in. If the student is accepted, there is no out of-district tuition.

Transportation is not provided for students who live outside the district, and that brings about a really important point: bus zones. The Lauderdale County school system is divided into several bus zones, which dictate the school to which a student living at a certain address will be transported. Here's the kicker: bus zone also dictates athletic eligibility. Stamps pointed out that the zones sometimes meet in the middle of a county road. Literally, one house might have players at Rogers High School, while their neighbors across the road play for Brooks. This was surprising news to me, and Stamps said that I'm not alone. He said that many people assume that because a bus runs by their house, they could put their kids on it. "If anyone has a question, we encourage them to call that individual school to ask what zone the address is in", Stamps said.

Each school district has its own rules. We've only discussed the policy of one district here, but Mr. Stamps' advice is good for everyone. Wherever you're looking to buy, check with the school first.

The technology that Tom Wheeler wants the phone companies to offer to all of us at no charge costs money to develop. It costs money to deploy. It costs money to maintain. Who's going to pay those costs? Tom Wheeler? No. The phone companies. And their customers. Even if it's not a listed charge on your phone bill, either your bill will go up or the service you're paying for will be cut back somewhere else.

college Ditto free Campuses education. don't build or maintain Contractors themselves. staff build and maintain them. Professors don't lecture at their own expense and out of the goodness of their hearts. They must be paid. As must the phone bills, the electric bills, the water bills, etc.


