

Notes from the NUNDA VILLAGE BOARD

ANIMAL SAFETY



Each year there are several calls to the Police Department with public concern of dogs or other animals left in a vehicle on the street, in a parking lot, or at a sporting/public event. On just a 78 degree day - the temperature inside a parked vehicle can become between 100 and 120 degrees in just a few minutes. On a 90 degree day - the temperature can rise to above 160 degrees in less than 10 minutes. Animals can develop or die from complications of heat stroke within this time frame or can sustain brain damage as a result of this exposure.

For these reasons, the Police Department is advising to never leave your animals in an unattended vehicle for any reason.



Dear Dog Owners of Nunda,

On August 9th, 2016, there will be a public hearing regarding a proposed change to our dog licensing law.

The proposed change would require all renewals to be due between July-September of every year. This new timeframe would follow the Livingston County Free Rabies Clinic for Nunda held in June.

The main purpose of this local law is to create more convenience for dog owners. It would help those who may have two or more dogs that are on different renewal due dates by putting them all on the same timeline. It would also eliminate the extra trip for some when it comes to having to update your dog's rabies information before or after your dog license renewal date.

This law would also provide the clerk's office with complete and timely information for reports due to the county and the state.

Your dog renewal letters would still be mailed out beforehand and payments would still be accepted through mail and in person.

The dog license local law is set to be reviewed on August 9th, 2016 at 7:00 PM at the Nunda Town Board Meeting at the Nunda Government Center, located at 4 Massachusetts Street. If passed, the new dog renewal law will take effect in 2017.

Attention Dog Owners: ALL dogs must be vaccinated against rabies and have a current one-year or threeyear certificate in order to obtain a dog license. It is New York State Law that ALL dogs be vaccinated and licensed by no later than 4 months of age.

Attention Cat & Ferret Owners: It is New York State Law that ALL cats and ferrets in the county be vaccinated by no later than 4 months of age to prevent rabies.

NOTE: For cats and dogs previously immunized against rabies, you MUST bring proof of immunization in order to be issued a 3-year certificate. Without proof, a 1-year certificate will be issued. Ferrets must be vaccinated

All animals must either be leashed or in a top-opening carrier and accompanied by a person 16 years of age, or older.
