He led Auburn to nine straight bowl games and its first victory over Alabama in nine years. Coach Dye was National Coach of the Year in 1983. He was inducted in the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame in 1985 and the Georgia Football Hall of Fame in 1987.

At Auburn coach Dye produced 21 All-American players, 71 All SEC players, 85 NFL players, and one Heisman Trophy Winner. His overall coaching career record is 153-62.5 62-5.

He currently serves as assistant to the President at Auburn University and spends most of his time on his farm in Notasulga, Alabama.







Medicare Minute "Medicare Part A & B Review"

The past few weeks we have discussed Medicare Parts A & B in detail. These are the two parts of Medicare that are received through the federal government. This week let's review what we have discussed.

Although Medicare Part A and Part B are great programs that cover a lot of services, there are some things Medicare does not cover. They include most dental care, eye exams related to prescribing glasses, dentures, acupuncture and hearing aids.

Medicare Part A is primarily used to cover your inpatient care. Part A has a \$1,288 deductible for each benefit period, meaning the deductible can be applied more than once in a calendar year. This deductible covers hospital services, including semi-private rooms, meals, general nursing, drugs as part of your inpatient treatment, and other hospital services and supplies. Part A is free to most Medicare beneficiaries.

In most cases Part B is used to cover your outpatient services. These include visits to your primary care physician and/or specialist. It also may cover transportation by ambulance, durable medical equipment, preventive services and mental health treatment. Part B also entitles you to an annual "Wellness" visit to a qualified provider. Most Medicare beneficiaries joining Medicare Part B for the first time in 2016 pay a monthly premium to Medicare of \$121.80. Part B has an annual deductible of \$166 and a coinsurance the beneficiary pays of 20% after the deductible is met.

To cover the deductibles and coinsurance that Part A and Part B have you would need to look at some type of supplemental policy sold through private insurance companies. These include Medicare supplement plans or Medicare Advantage Plans. Charles Caine Anderson

Widely known and admired both for his success in business and for his philanthropy, Charles C. Anderson was was one of only 12 people nationwide to receive the Horatio Alger Award in 2014. Born in Florence in 1934 Anderson has lived here his entire life, graduating from both Coffee High School and UNA. He is married to his high school sweetheart, Hilda, and they have four sons who are all involved in the family businesses. Anderson is a successful businessman locally, nationally, and internationally.

Learning at an early age the value of hard work and the importance of faith and family, Charles went from working for his father in a small newsstand to being the head of a multi-million dollar business enterprise. His entrepreneurial spirit and solid upbringing led

him along the way. In all of his successes, he has given back into our community and across the globe many times over and made numerous worthwhile projects feasible. He was not one who sought recognition, but quietly gave a hand of financial support or an opportunity for others to work.

son of former slaves, became the first 20th century African-American Congressman from the north. He is credited with the Anti-discrimination Amendment to the 1933 Civilian Conservation Corps Bill.

Born in Florence in 1871, DePriest rose from humble beginnings as the son of former slaves in Alabama to become the first black Congressman from the north. He moved from Florence to Kansas, and then in 1888, to Chicago where he started working first as a painter and then in his own real estate business. From there he became a politician and a legislator. For many years he was a major force in local politics in Chicago.

According to the Chicago Tribute Markers of the Distinction, DePriest was "shrewd, smart, and street savvy." He developed great organizational skills and devoted his time to politics. He became popular among the Republican Party leaders and was nominated for Cook County Commissioner in 1904. In 1915 he was elected alderman of the 2nd Ward. He introduced a civil rights ordinance in the City Council the next year. In 1928 he was elected to the First District seat in the U.S. House of Representatives and served three terms. He is credited with the passing of the antidiscrimination amendment to the 1933 bill establishing the Civilian Conservation Corps.

Dr. Ellen Dorrit Hoffleit

Dr. Ellen D. Hoffleit, celebrated worldwide for her many contributions to astronomy, discovered more than 1,200 variable stars. She authored Yale Bright Star Catalogue which is used in almost every astronomical observatory in the world.

Dr. Hoffleit was born in Florence and raised in New Castle, Pennsylvania. Her interest in stars began as a young child watching fireballs appear to collide in the skies above her backyard. She graduated from Radcliffe College with a degree in mathematics in 1928. She then began her

into the Alabama Academy career as a research assistant at the Harvard Observatory where she soon became an expert at determining spectroscopically the absolute brightness of stars. Under the supervision of Harlow Shapley, she went on to earn a Ph.D. in astronomy in 1938, for which she was awarded the Carolyn Wilby Prize for the best original research. She worked at Harvard for 25 years and then was hired at Yale University in 1956 to run its star cataloging program.

Dr. Hoffleit's major work during her years at Yale was The Bright Star Catalogue which is still used today at virtually every Astronomical Observatory in the world.

Though officially retired in 1975, Hoffleit continued to research for star catalogues as a Senior Research Scientist Emeritus. She passed away in 2007 at the age of 100.

Rear Admiral John Hood

Commander of the Hawk, the fastest U.S. ship In the Spanish-American War, Rear Admiral John Hood then commanded the Fourth Division of the Atlantic Fleet in World War I. The USS John Hood (DD-655) was named for him.

John Hood was born in 1859 and grew up in Florence where he heard many stories of gunboats on the Tennessee River during the Civil War, and he watched the steamboats travel up and down the river.

He graduated second in his class from the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis in 1879 and embarked upon a career which brought him to the rank of Rear Admiral.

Hood commanded the gunboat Hawk, the fastest ship in the American Squadron during the Spanish-American War. After the war, Officer Hood was responsible for the laying of the Pacific Cable.

During World War I, Admiral Hood commanded the Fourth Division of the Atlantic Fleet.

In 1943 the destroyer USS John Hood (DD-655) was named in his honor.

Admiral John Hood was a widely recognized military hero for his accomplishments during the Spanish-American War and World War I.

Southpaw **Sensation**

Back in the 1960's, lefthanded quarterbacks were few and far between in Shoals area football circles. One exception was one of the area's most prolific quarterbacks – Steve Coates of Deshler High School. Coates was a three-sport athlete for the Tigers as a member of the football, baseball and track teams.

In spite of his success in all three sports, football was definitely Coates' specialty. As a senior he passed for over 1,000 yards and his 12 touchdown passes led the tough Tennessee Vallev He also Conference. rushed for over 500 yards and 5 touchdowns. His versatility also stamped him as one of the area's most outstanding punters. He led the Tennessee Valley Conference in punting, averaging 42 yards per kick.

One of Coates most outstanding games saw him throwing for two touchdowns and intercepting four passes, all leading to Deshler touchdowns. His four interceptions in one game tied him for second place with several other players for most interceptions in a single game in Alabama High School history. In the game that gave the Tigers the Quad-Cities Championship, Coates completed 7 of 9 passes for three touchdowns and rushed for another score.

In baseball, Coates attracted the attention of pro scouts with his outstanding performance in the East-West All-Star baseball game as a senior. Coates was an outstanding local golfer and softball player. He won several local golf tournaments and was the

Most Valuable Player on his team's Quad-Cities softball championship.

TimesDaily Former sports editor Ronnie Thomas probably paid Coates the últimate compliment when he was quoted as saying: "Coates is the type young man coaches enjoy coaching. "The kind they like to have on their team. The southpaw is in the mold of Alabama great Kenny "Snake" Stabler." "He knows how to strike a fire under an offense and is an ace when it comes to stifling the opposition."

Coates received the ultimate honor for his achievements athletic recently when he was inducted into the Colbert County Sports Hall of Fame. There have been a lot of great quarterbacks in Shoals area football history and without a doubt, Steve Coates will always be remembered as one of the greatest.





ATTORNEYS' CONTRACTS: CONTINGENCY v. RETAINER

I had a couple of calls this week about last week's article and what accident and injury lawyers charge.

Lawyers in divorce, criminal or commercial cases typically work on an hourly basis against a retainer. When the retainer is exhausted by hourly billing, the lawyer is then paid an additional amount of money so as to continue the representation. The client pays all costs such as expert witness fees, filing fees, deposition costs and in some cases paralegal charges.

Accident and injury lawyers typically work on a contingency fee basis. That means that at the end of the case, the attorney recovers the costs of litigation and receives a

percentage of the amount of settlement or jury award. I think any straight forward accident case should be handled on a percentage basis where the lawyer agrees to pay the costs even if they lose. I'm always suspicious when an accident or injury case client is charged some upfront fee. If the case is genuine and the lawyer genuinely knows how to value the case, then there is no reason why there should be any retainer charged to a client.

In an average on-the-job injury case, a worker is injured and out of work. This is not the best time to start paying court costs and expert witness fees. On average, Joel and I have to spend around \$3,000.00 to convince the other side or the judge that we can prove our case and our client deserves to win.

Automobile accident cases can be more expensive because liability is an issue in those cases and the expert witness fees are not limited to what physicians charge for their time in providing a summary of the client's case and an opinion as to the cause of the injury. In some cases it is necessary to use medical drawings for the benefit of the jury. These are expensive. There are other experts such as life care planners or economists and an attorney may have \$25,000.00 to \$100,000.00 of their own money in a case. This money is necessary to show the dramatic impact that a serious injury causes. By the same token, if the case is lost, the attorney is out the money. It should be realized that most people don't know the value of a case or what has to be proven or have that kind of money to pay for their own case. That's why a contingency fee, as a percentage of the recovery, makes sense for everyone. Buckle up and drive safely.







pet connection TEMPLE CATS petbuzz Cats are smart about their food

Around the world, cats are welcome members of monastic communities


hen I walked onto the grounds of Gachen Lama Khiid at Erdenetsogt in Mongolia's Khangai Mountains, nearly the first thing I saw was a cat sunning himself outside the temple. Cats are not especially popular as companion animals in Mongolia, but when I thought about it, the cat's presence made sense. I confirmed my suspicion later as I drank salty milk tea with the monastery's head lama.

"Is it common for monasteries to have a

monks labored to create. The occasional inky paw print on a page was less destructive.

Nuns in convents were forbidden to have pets such as dogs and monkeys — a rule they frequently broke — but there was one exception. The 13th-century "Ancrene Wisse," rules for nuns, notes in the section titled "On Domestic Matters": "You shall not possess any beast, my dear sisters, except only a cat."

Between 1306 and 1467, Exeter Cathedral had a succession of official cats. A penny per week was budgeted to supplement the diet of the cat, who was otherwise expected to chow down on mice and other pests. The north transept wall still has a hole (an early cat door?) through which the cat could enter and exit.



 A recent study has found that cats are not simply obligate carnivores — meaning that they must have meat in their diet - but hypercarnivores, requiring a 1:1 ratio of energy from protein to energy from fat. When given a choice, cats choose foods with an appropriate balance, even if that food choice doesn't smell or taste as good as others. They need meat protein because they're unable to process plant proteins for energy. The study also found that cats instinctively avoid new foods to lessen their risk of stomach upset. So your finicky cat? He's just looking to eat right.

• Does your dog wolf his food? Eating too quickly is a common canine problem, especially among Labrador retrievers, beagles, basset hounds, cocker spaniels, corgis, dachshunds and pugs. It can lead to gassiness and may even contribute to the development of gastric torsion, or bloat. To encourage your dog to eat at a more moderate pace, place some clean, smooth stones — too large for him to swallow — in his food dish so he has to eat around them. You can also purchase food bowls with built-in obstacles that will force him to eat more slowly. Scooter, a 30-year-old Siamese, has assumed the title of world's oldest cat, according to Guinness World Records. Scooter was born March 26, 1986, and has lived with owner Gail Floyd from day one. Scooter's daily routine includes waking Floyd at 6 a.m. by "talking" and jumping around. When Floyd comes home from work, Scooter is waiting at the door to greet her. Scooter is also fond of traveling — he's even visited 45 states. Floyd believes Scooter's active lifestyle, which involves making visits to the nursing home where her mother lives, has contributed to the cat's longevity. Cats have served as pest control at temples and monasteries throughout the world for centuries. Egyptian temple cats were trained to hunt snakes and rodents, reported fifthcentury Greek historian Herodotus.

In Cyprus, at the Monastery of St. Nicholas of the Cats, snakes overran the island after a drought. The monastery's patron, the future St. Helena, had 1,000 cats brought in from Egypt and Palestine to kill the snakes.

An unknown ninth-century Irish monk wrote a poem about his cat, Pangur Ban, that we still read and appreciate today:

"I and Pangur Ban my cat, 'Tis a like task we are at: Hunting mice is his delight, Hunting words I sit all night." Medieval monks prized cats not only because they warred against mice to protect food stores, but also because they prevented mice from nibbling on the manuscripts the

Several cat breeds are reputed to have originated as monastery or temple cats. The legend behind the Burmese is that Buddhist monks regarded the shorthaired brown cats as embodiments of gods.

The Birman, once known as the Sacred Cat of Burma (now called Myanmar), is said to descend from cats that were companions to temple priests in the northern part of the country.

The story goes that a priest named Mun Ha, accompanied by his beloved white cat, was praying in the temple beneath the golden statue of the goddess Tsim Kyan Tse, whose eyes were represented by brilliant sapphires. Marauders in search of treasure broke in and attacked the priest. As he lay dying, the cat rested his paws on Mun Ha's head and faced the statue. Suddenly, his white fur became tipped with gold, his legs darkened and his eyes changed from yellow to deep sapphire blue, but his paws remained

pure white. The next morning, the remaining monks awoke to find that all the cats had undergone the same transformation.

In France, the Chartreux was once known as the monastery cat associated with Carthusian monks at the Grande Chartreuse monastery near Grenoble. The blue cats were believed to have originally come from Syria, brought to France in trade or by returning Crusaders in the Middle Ages.

The cat's mousing prowess is surely what gained him entrance to contemplative life, but undoubtedly his tranquil nature and love of solitude earned him a permanent home.



Dog Tethering Never Humane

Dear Editor:

The puppy Montgomery who reportedly strangled to death when the rope that was tethering him became entangled in brush is a reminder of the dangers of tethering and why it should be banned outright.

Strangulation is just one of the many risks that tethered dogs face. They are also vulnerable to the searing heat and frigid cold, parasites and disease, and cruel humans who shoot, stab, poison, set them on fire, and steal them for "bait" in dogfighting rings and to sell to laboratories. Tethered dogs are often denied food, water, shelter, veterinary care, exercise, and the things they want most: love and companionship.

Tethering âlso poses the a risk to the public. Because of their intense confinement and tethered deprivation, dogs can become overly aggressive and territorial. They are three times more likely to bite than dogs who are not tethered. Children and the elderly have been severely injured and killed after




