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
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



#### Tuna Mushroom

- Ingredients
  - 1/2 cup water
    1 teaspoon chicken bouillon granules
  - 1 package (9 ounces) frozen cut green beans
  - 1 cup chopped onion
  - 1 cup sliced fresh mushrooms
  - 1/4 cup chopped celery
  - 1 garlic clove, minced
  - 1/2 teaspoon dill weed
  - 1/2 teaspoon salt
  - 1/8 teaspoon pepper
  - 4 teaspoons cornstarch
  - 1-1/2 cups cold milk
  - 1/2 cup shredded Swiss cheese
  - 1/4 cup mayonnaise
  - 2-1/2 cups egg noodles, cooked and drained
  - 1 can (12 ounces) light tuna in water, drained and flaked
  - 1/3 cup dry bread crumbs
  - 1 tablespoon butter

#### Directions

1. In a large saucepan, bring water and bouillon to a boil; stir until bouillon is dissolved. Add the next eight ingredients; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 5 minutes or until vegetables are tender. 2. In a small bowl, combine cornstarch and milk until smooth; gradually add to vegetable mixture. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Remove from the heat; stir in cheese and mayonnaise until cheese is melted. Fold in noodles and tuna.



# Tuna Casseroles

3. Pour into a greased 2-1/2-qt. baking dish. In a small skillet, brown bread crumbs in butter; sprinkle over casserole. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 25-30 minutes or until heated through. Yield: 4-6 servings.

#### **Tuna Melt**

#### Ingredients

- 1 (16-ounce) package corkscrew macaroni
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 3 cups milk
- 2 cups shredded Swiss cheese, divided
- 3 (6-ounce) cans tuna, drained, flaked
- 2 tomatoes, cut into 1/4-inch-thick slices

#### Directions

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Coat a 9-  $\times$  13-inch baking dish with cooking spray.

2. In a large saucepan of boiling salted water, cook pasta 7 minutes, or until al dente. Drain well and return to pot; set aside.

3. Meanwhile, in a medium saucepan over low heat, melt butter. Stir in flour, salt, and pepper and cook 1 minute, stirring constantly. Gradually stir in milk; increase heat to medium-high and cook until mixture thickens, stirring occasionally. Remove saucepan from heat and add 1-1/2 cups cheese, stirring until melted.

4. Add cheese sauce and tuna to pasta in pot; toss until evenly mixed. Transfer mixture to baking dish. Arrange tomato slices on top, overlapping if necessary. Sprinkle with remaining cheese.

5. Cover baking dish with foil and bake 20 minutes. Remove foil and bake an additional 10 to 15 minutes, or until hot and bubbly.

Transfer the cookies to a baking rack and cool completely.

#### **Best Tuna Casserole Ever**

#### Ingredients

- 12 ounces wide egg noodles, cooked al-dente, drained and rinsed
- 1 can cream of golden mushroom soup (any cream of mushroom soup will do, but I find that the golden stuff adds nice color and flavor) – use the low fat stuff if you're counting calories
- 3/4 cup evaporated milk
- 1/4 cup mayonnaise (low fat is ok)
- 1/4 cup sour cream (low fat is ok)
- 1/4 cup water
- 2 five-ounce cans of tuna, drained
- 1/2 packet of dry Lipton onion soup mix
- 1 1/2 cups freshly grated sharp cheddar cheese, separated
- 1 tbsp Worcestershire
- 1 tsp Tabasco
- 1/2 tsp celery salt
- 1 tsp black pepper

Optional – 1 cup of frozen baby peas or vegetable medley, thawed and drained

#### Directions

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. In a large bowl mix all ingredients, reserving 1/2 cup of the shredded cheese, and folding the cooked pasta in last after everything else has been mixed well. Pour everything into a greased casserole dish, and sprinkle remaining cheese on top. Bake uncovered in the preheated oven for thirty minutes. Serve hot – serves up to six.

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## **Kitchen** Creamy Scalloped Potatoes &

Aunt T's

#### Ingredients

- 2 cups milk
- 2 cups whipping cream
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 6 medium russet potatoes
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon white pepper
- 1 tablespoon butter or margarine
- 12 ounces can tuna, drained and flaked
- 1 1/2 cup shredded Mozzarella cheese

#### Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a 3-quart saucepan over medium heat, combine milk, whipping cream, and garlic.

Peel potatoes; slice about 1/8 to 1/4-inch thick. Add potatoes, salt and white pepper to milk mixture; heat to simmering.

Grease an 11 x 7-inch casserole with butter; spoon potato-milk mixture into dish.

Bake 25 minutes at 350 degrees F; remove from oven. Add tuna, stirring gently; top with cheese. Bake 35 more minutes, or until potatoes are baked through and top is golden brown.

Let stand, covered, about 15 minutes to thicken.

- 1. Average number of minutes before outpatients with chest pain or possible heart attack got an ECG,
- 2. Average time patients spent in the Emergency Department, before they were admitted to the hospital as an inpatient,
- 3. Average time patients spent in the Emergency Department before they were seen by a healthcare professional,

Each of the measures indicated above were weighted according to a survey of over 1,000 women on their relative priority, and listed above in order of importance. In addition, hospitals that fell within the bottom 25<sup>th</sup> percentile for patient recommendation scores were eliminated from consideration for the award.

For each Emergency Department measure, the top 25<sup>th</sup> percentile and the top 50<sup>th</sup> percentile are determined for all hospitals reporting the measure. 
We have to exchange our old way of thinking and doing things, and take on a mind like Jesus Christ. Washing our mind daily on the Word of God, can cleanse us.

Thoughts produce words, words produce actions, action produce habits, habits produce destiny. Chang our thoughts and change our life!





### **Claybank Master Gardeners**

#### Hello Gardeners!

August is upon us, and the weeds in my yard are happily producing and multiplying faster than I can keep up with. Being protective of the pollinator bees, butterflies, and birds, I try to stick to organic methods of weed control, like spraying vinegar on the walkways only. Some use boiling water—but if anyone can tell me their favorite method, I'll share it here. (ozarkdee@gmail.com) Some weeds are edible, so adding a few leaves freshly grown (picked early in the morning) to summer salads adds extra nutrition. Dandelion weeds are a bit on the bitter side, like argula, but rich in calcium, potassium and vitamin A, according to Euell Gibbons in <u>Stalking the</u> Healthful Herbs.

Controlling Insects and Diseases of Tomatoes (excerpts from Alabama cooperative Extension bulletin ANR-0302) The more common insect pests of



tomatoes include fruitworms and hornworms, aphids, whiteflies, and stinkbugs. Tomato fruitworms and hornworms may be controlled by sprays of Bacillus thuringiensis (Dipel, Thuricide, others) beginning just after eggs hatch when caterpillars are still small. Insecticidal soaps are effective for control of aphids and whiteflies if sprays are directed to the upper and lower leaf surfaces. Stinkbugs may be controlled, but weekly sprays may be necessary for control. Disease development is favored by wet, humid conditions, so keep foliage dry by watering in the morning and using drip irrigation. Scout your plants often to detect and then identify any potential diseases. [Hot temperatures will cause bud drop, try to shade plants from afternoon sun.]
