

Should Dogs Drink Tap Water?

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: Recently you advised against using human toothpaste to brush dogs' teeth because, for one thing, the fluoride in toothpaste is toxic to them. With this in mind, what are the ramifica-tions of dogs drinking fluoridated water? — Rich, via e-mail

DEAR RICH: That's an excellent question, and one that all pet owners should consider. About 67 percent of the U.S. population receives municipal drinking water with added fluoride, according to a 2012 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention

Opinions on fluoride and its effect on people and pets is an emotional issue, for understandable reasons. And that can leave pet owners even more con-fused about whether they should be

protecting their pets from tap water.

The Merck Manual of Pet Health details the effects of fluoride at toxic levels (for pets, that can be as low as 1 milligram per kilogram). But that does not address fluoride in water. If municipalities fluoridate their water, it is diluted at 0.7 parts per million, which is very small — but many people are concerned that those small amounts can build up in one's system over time,

causing long-term health effects.

For the short term, you can simply avoid giving pets tap water every day — use filtered or bottled water instead. But bottled water has its own set of issues (such as plastic filling up land-

How can you find out if your drink ing water has added fluoride? Contact your local water utility provider and ask (the number is on your water and sewer bill). Or, check out the CDC's My Water's Fluoride website, which has fluoridation data supplied by 39 participating states. Send your tips, questions or comments

Jordan Has Spoken

It was less than a year ago that Kareem Abdul Jabbar mentioned that Michael Jordan chose "com-merce over conscience," failing to comment on the social issues we face in America.

Welcome to this week's sports column. It's time to let the man have his say, which he did on ESPN's newly dropped website called "The Undefeated" — the famous sport channel's attempt to address racial mat-

ters, presumably in sports.
Wedged between a listicle about
Prince and the death of Ms. Cleo (which she surely predicted), we have a statement from his Airness himself.

When you think about sports drinks or really cool sneakers or a guy who can fly and dunk on Bugs Bunny, only one name bubbles to the sur-face: Michael Jordan ... the second greatest player to ever play who did not fight Bruce Lee, through no fault of his own.

When you think about social causes, the second most exposed athlete of all-time - Jordan - remained silent on the issues that mattered.

No longer, Jordan has spoken. Here

"As a proud American, a father who lost his own dad in a senseless who lost his own dad in a senseless act of violence, and a black man, I have been deeply troubled by the deaths of African-Americans at the hands of law enforcement and angered by the cowardly and hateful targeting and killing of police officers. I grieve with the families who have lost loved ones, as I know their pain all too well

pain all too well.
"I was raised by parents who taught
me to love and respect people regard-less of their race or background, so
I am saddened and frustrated by the divisive rhetoric and racial tensions that seem to be getting worse as of

late. I know this country is better than that, and I can no longer stay silent. We need to find solutions that ensure people of color receive fair and equal treatment AND that police officers — who put their lives on the line every day to protect us all — are respected and supported.
"Over the past three decades, I

have seen up close the dedication of the law enforcement officers who protect me and my family. I have the greatest respect for their sacri-fice and service. I also recognize that for many people of color their experiences with law enforcement have been different than mine. I have decided to speak out in the hope that we can come together as Americans, and through peaceful dialogue and education, achieve constructive

change.
"To support that effort, I am making contributions of \$1 million each to two organizations, the Inter-national Association of Chiefs of Police's newly established Institute for Community-Police Relations, and the NAACP Legal Defense Fund. The Institute for Community-Police Relations' policy and oversight work is focused on building trust and promoting best practices in community policing. My donation to the NAACP Legal Defense Fund will support its ongoing work in support of reforms that will build trust and respect between communi-ties and law enforcement. Although I know these contributions alone are not enough to solve the problem, I hope the resources will help both organizations make a positive dif-

"We are privileged to live in the world's greatest country — a country that has provided my family and me the greatest of opportunities. The problems we face didn't happen overnight and they won't be solved tomorrow, but if we all work together, we can foster greater understanding, positive change and create a more peaceful world for ourselves, our children, our families and our communities."



In a large nonstick pan over medium heat, cook the turkey bacon until slightly crisp. Transfer the turkey bacon to a cutting board and roughly chop. Place on a small plate and set aside.

In the same pan, add the olive oil and turn the heat to medium. Add the onion and apple. Sauté for 10 minutes or until the ingredients are soft and translucent.

Stir in the rosemary and thyme. Turn off the heat and allow the mixture to cool to room temperature.

Safe Trips Start With These Six Maintenance Tips

(NAPS)—While many people know to check their oil and tire pressure before a road trip, there is one commonly overlooked car care component it would be a bright idea to remember: headlight maintenance.


As the National Safety Council points out, driving at night is more hazardous than at any other time since vision-one of the most important senses necessary for driving—is compromised. Depth perception, color recognition and peripheral vision are all affected.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration adds that the primary reason for severe nighttime accidents and reduced driving safety is dim, cloudy or improperly lit headlights. In fact, a 20 to 50 percent reduction in headlight output leads to a 90 percent increase in the possibility of an accident. Yet an estimated nine out of 10 cars on the road have dirty or vellowed headlights that greatly reduce vision and need to be replaced, repaired or restored.

Before hitting the streets, it's important to not join the majority-check vehicle headlights and ensure that visibility is high. Try these headlight maintenance tips to prepare for the open road ahead and improve vehicle

safety year-round. You have choices for better headlights: Better headlights can help increase visibility farther down the road, which in turn can help drivers feel safer and more secure when driving at dusk, dawn or nighttime. If there's an object on the road, better headlights can help drivers react sooner. Any upgrade above a basic headlight replacement can create a better, safer experience for drivers. Many high-performance halogen headlights don't increase glare, which avoids affecting other drivers on the road.

• Replace before burnout: Headlights can dim over time so make sure to replace them before they burn out. If you can't remember the

last time the headlights were changed, it may be time for an upgrade.

 Always swap in pairs: It's very important to replace headlights in sets of two. Since headlights dim over their lifetime, a new bulb paired with an old bulb will create an uneven field of vision, which can be a major distraction on the road for oncoming traffic.

• Consider DIY: Depending on the vehicle's make and model, changing the headlight bulbs can be a simple process that doesn't require a mechanic or service professional. Various online guides exist to help consumers swap out headlight bulbs in a matter of minutes. Consult the vehicle's owner's manual for replacement procedures, precautions.

 Restoration as an option: The average age of vehicles on the road today is more than 11 years old. Millions of these cars have faded, cloudy plastic headlight lenses. There are DIY restoration kits that can help you restore clarity and remove the hazy yellow appearance on headlight lenses. A good restoration kit can let up to three times more light shine on the road from the same, once cloudy headlight.

• Keep it clean: Be sure all vehicle lights, including headlights, taillights and turn signals, are clean.

(NAPSA)—To make your fried chicken one for the history books, chef Kevin Houston offers this advice:

chei Revin advice:

"Start with quality chicken," says Houston, who is the "chief flavor officer" and lead chef for Church's Chicken. "Buy a whole bird but separate it into parts so everything cooks evenly." Wings and breasts cook faster than legs and thirths. "Give each piece a double dunk in batter and bread-ing. You'll end up with a lighter, flakier crust and, because batter

fully coats each piece, it locks in juiciness. Even white meat pieces will be tender and moist. If you like extra crunch, put some cornstarch into your batter recipe instead of flour."

Most batter starts with flour and water as a base. Houston prefers a 50/50 mix of flour and cornstarch before adding salt, pepper and spices. "You can triple dip before frying," Houston adds. "Just be sure to give each layer of batter time to settle." Now it's time to fry. "You don't need a deep fryer—just a good cast-iron skillet and either peanut or canola oil." Bring oil to 350 degrees or just between medium and high on the stove. Cook light and dark meat in batches, submerging pieces halfway in oil... without crowding the pan. Wait five minutes before turning, then dial heat down to medium-low to prevent overcooking and dark crust. Cook five to a drying rack (never paper towels). Crust should be golden brown, shiny, and ready for greatness.
