#### My Turn, by Major Euell White, U.S. Army, (retired)

\$85 million budget shortfall, both to protect a program that nearly one million Alabamians rely on, and to move forward with these long-term reforms that will slow Medicaid's

exploding costs."

Cutbacks in state Medicaid agency reimbursements (the doctor's bump from Obamacare) have narrowed that shortfall closer to \$70 million.




## **Spending Tax Dollars Wisely**




In 2013 the city administration funded 11 capital projects by borrowing over \$19 Million. Now, 3 years later, only 3 of the 11 projects are complete. 2 of the 3 came in significantly over budget. None of the remaining 8 projects have any concrete plan or date for completion, while almost \$8 Million lie unused.

Meanwhile, Florence families have paid \$1.4 Million in interest on the unused borrowed funds – roughly \$89 per household in wasted interest expense.

serious one.

Sims insists the budget can be met easily without the lottery.

Monetizing the BP Oil Spill settlement money by issuing a bond would make about \$630 million available.

Those funds could be immediately used to pay down debt owed to the state's Rainy Day Fund (\$161 million) and the People's Trust Fund (\$422 million). By doing that, the state would save \$15 million that was budgeted to make debt payments in FY 2016, which ends in two months, and another \$20 million debt payment that was scheduled for FY 2017. In addition to that, by paying off the debt the state would begin to draw interest on the Rainy Day account, which would mean an additional \$15 million in revenue for FY17. That interest would increase to \$35 million in FY18 and \$50 million in FY19.

The state will also begin FY17 with approximately \$10-\$15 million in the General Fund account because tax revenue was higher than expected this year. There is also \$35 million left from BP's FY16 \$50 million payment since the state only budgeted \$15 million. The savings of \$95 million actually offers a \$25 million buffer since the doctor bump was already eliminated.

There are several other budget issues to address. One we are still not honestly dealing with is our infrastructure concerns. Alabama's state gas tax is 16¢ per gallon. Counties add a few more cents. That still pales in comparison to other state taxes like California at 39.5¢/gallon in California, 29.4 in Kentucky, 28.3 in Florida, 37.5 in NC, 40.7 in Pennsylvania, and 42.4 in New York. That contrasts with 8¢ in Alaska and 7.5¢ in Georgia.

in Georgia.

Word has it that an increase in the Alabama state gas tax may be proposed this year as well. It's not a bad idea for long overdue bridge and road concerns. The responsibility is distributed evenly based on use. It's just aggravating when resurfacing perfectly good roadways takes precedence over legitimate resurfacing and repair needs just because one project may be from a specific pot of money.

We all know the pros and cons of a lottery, and there are very few pros.

Some 90% of the states with serious financial shortfalls already have a lottery, so it is clearly not a cure-all. In fact, after a few years the same financial gaps usually resurface with even greater need.

Voters rightfully should decide the issue. However, as is often the case, voters may not make the prudent decision.





## HOUSETRAINING HABITS

These 8 expert tips will start you and your pup on the path to housetraining success

re you a new or potential puppy owner? If so, housetraining is probably on your mind. We've gathered some of our favorite tips for ensuring a rewarding experience — for you and your pup.

1. Learn "caninese." Body language is the first clue that your puppy needs to go out. He might not be crossing his legs, but pawing at you, standing at the top of the stairs or in front of the door and barking are all signs that he needs your attention — fast! Some dogs go with the classic sniffing and circling behavior. The instant you see this, scoop him up and take him out.

2. Use a crate. It's not punishment, and it's not cruel unless you leave him in it all the time. A crate is your puppy's safe spot and sleeping area, so he'll instinctively want to keep it clean. And when he's safely confined in it, you don't have to worry that he'll have an accident in the house. Staying in a crate helps a puppy learn to control his bladder and bowels. Without it, he may get into the habit of relieving himself whenever and wherever he likes.

3. Choose the right crate. It should be large enough for your pup to stand up and turn around inside it but not so large that he can potty at one end and sleep at the other. Purchase a puppy-size crate and graduate to a larger one later, or buy a crate with a divider. A removable panel allows you to section off the crate as peeded and adjust the

amount of space the pup has as he grows. You can also block off the back of the crate with a box or some other item that the puppy can't get over or around. Just be sure it's safe and not edible. Bricks or cement blocks are out; instead, try vertically inserting a large, cushion-style dog bed. An empty cardboard box could also work if your pup isn't a chewer.

**4. Stick to a schedule.** Puppies need to potty frequently. Set a timer to take your puppy out every two to four hours.

**5.** Certain events trigger a pup's need to urinate or defecate. Take him out as soon as he wakes up in the morning or from a nap and immediately after eating or drinking. Excitement and stress can lead to potty accidents. Prevent them by taking your pup out to potty every few minutes if he is playing vigorously indoors. Finally, take him out just before bedtime. By 3 to 4 months of age, most pups can sleep through the night, but younger puppies may need to go out once or twice during the night.

Purchase a puppy-size crate and graduate to a larger one later, or buy a crate with a divider. A removable panel allows you to section off the crate as needed and adjust the

potty outdoors. Play is another good reward when your pup potties outdoors. Let him play for a few minutes after he performs. If you take him back inside immediately, he'll be reluctant to relieve himself right away.

**7. Feed regular meals.** Free-feeding (leaving food out all the time) makes it more difficult to know when your puppy needs to pee or poop.

**8. Limit freedom.** Letting a puppy have free run of the home is a recipe for potty accidents. Instead, keep him attached to you with a leash unless he's in a puppy-proofed bathroom, kitchen or laundry room. You should always know where he is and what he's doing.

## pet **Suzz**Snakebites need

quick attention

• Snakes are out in full force this time of year. According to veterinarians at the University of California at Davis School of Veterinary Medicine, pets are most likely to encounter snakes between late April and October. If you take your dog hiking, keep him on his leash and on the trail. Better yet, take him through a snake-avoidance course to help him learn to avoid the scaly critters. A bite from a rattlesnake calls for immediate veterinary attention and administration of antivenin. Before you head out, check with your veterinarian or a local veterinary emergency hospital to find out

whether antivenin injections are available.
• Calling Dr. Bombay. Not the character from the 1960s sitcom "Bewitched," but the cat breed nicknamed "the patent-leather kid with the new-penny eyes." The muscular, medium-size cat was created in the 1950s by crossing Burmese cats with domestic shorthairs or American shorthairs. 

great football games in UNA history. Some may even consider any one of the 41 wins during UNA's three straight Division II National Championship seasons as a great one. Oddly enough, one of the all-time greatest games happens to be the only loss during that stretch from 1993-1995.

The year was 1994. Coach Bobby Wallace's Lions were coming off their first national title. Up in Ohio, Youngstown State was coming off their first Division 1-AA national championship. Their coach was Jim Tressel, later of Ohio State fame. The game in Youngstown was being billed the "Battle of Two National Champions."
It was homecoming

for the Penguins and a record crowd of 17,000 fans were on hand to take a look at this national championship team from Florence, Alabama. Most wondered if the Lions stood a chance. It didn't take long for the answer to that question. The Penguins took the opening kickoff and marched 72 yards in just seven plays to grab a 7-0 lead.

But this was a special UNA team. The Lions featured the famed "Purple Swarm" defense, led by Ronald All-American McKinnon. Youngstown would not score again until the fourth quarter. and suggestions to Quarterback Cody Gross jerrywknight@comcast.net

There have been many scored the Lions first touchdown late in the third period. With the Penguins leading 14-7 in the fourth quarter, Gross teamed up with Michael Edwards on a 62-yard scoring pass to tie the game.

A Youngstown State field goal with 7:33 left in the game gave the home team a 17-14 lead and set up the Lions with a chance to stage the biggest upset in school history. It was not to be as the Penguins stopped the Lions on a fourth down try at midfield. If a loss can be called a great game in UNA history, this was it. It showed the Lions had guts, determination and talent.

Jim Tressel had nothing but praise for the Lions. Coach Wallace offered to return in 1995 for a rematch, but Tressel knew better. He saw who would be returning for the young Lions and decided not to go that route. A wise decision none the less.

The 1995 returning team would be named the "Best Team of the Quarter Century" in Division II football. Both UNA and Youngstown State went on to repeat as National Champions that season with the Lions adding a third title in 1995. matter how you feel about the game, it was truly a UNA football classic.





#### Do You Smell What I'm Cooking?

Does your home smell? As a Realtor, I know all too well the powerful effect that the smell of a home can have on prospective buyers. I have seen otherwise appealing homes linger on the market and can only draw the conclusion that smell matters. Unfortunately, it can be hard to tell if your own home smells bad. Our bodies are designed with an override switch called olfactory adaptation, and it kicks in after prolonged exposure to a smell. That can be a great thing if you're, say, sprayed by a skunk. To find out if your home is stinky, you'll have to stay away for long enough to be able to smell it yourself, or enlist the help of a brutally honest friend.

Offensive home odors fall into a few main categories, and their removal often depends upon their source. Cigarette smoke, pet odors, mold/ mildew/damp smells, and trash or garbage disposal odors are the main culprits. Whatever the source, airing out the space is the best place to start. Open all doors and windows and turn on fans, replacing stale air with fresh air.

Cigarette odors linger heavily in fabrics, such as draperies, rugs, upholstery, and carpeting. Remove and/or replace as many of these as possible, and clean the rest with an odor-neutralizing product. Many pros use diluted white vinegar for this, as well as for pet odors. Pet odors can be extremely difficult to remove. Sometimes carpeting and pad must be removed and the subfloor treated with Kilz or other similar product.

Smells of dampness most often occur in basement or below-grade areas. To truly get rid of them, you have to address the issue of moisture and may need to hire a professional. Running a dehumidifier in the space can help short-term. Any mold or mildew must be removed, and disturbing the mold spores can be hazardous to your health. Consult a professional in those situations. Eliminating trash odor is as simple as keeping your trash can and the surrounding area clean. Garbage disposals often develop odors, but periodically running citrus peelings or a product like Plink through should do the trick. Whatever you do, don't overdo it with air freshener products. Besides screaming "There's something we're trying to cover up!" they can trigger an allergic reaction, which would definitely

leave a bad impression on a buyer.






