Angel Park construction gets underway with massive outpouring of community support



Volunteers from the Perry Hall community worked around the clock over the weekend and made great progress on the construction of Angel Park. Each shift throughout the weekend saw more than 300 people actively working to bring Angel Park to life.

When Kelli Szczybor lost her 15-monthold son, Ryan, to leukemia, she wanted to keep his memory alive. And while the park was masterminded to serve in memory of her son, she soon realized many out there were going through the same thing.

"We named it Angel Park because there's a lot of people that have an angel in their life that has passed on," said Szczybor.

That message touched thousands in the community, and the proof is now tangible as construction for Angel Park kicked off over the weekend.

With hundreds of volunteers pouring into Angel Park to work from approximately 9 a.m. until dark, the park is starting to take shape and become a reality.

"It's an extraordinary project. I've never seen anything like this," said Fifth District Councilman David Marks as workers of all ages and sizes bounced around him, setting up beams and filling holes. "It's a project that's been many years in the making, all done through the community members."

Community members have been instrumental in making Angel Park a reality from the get-go. Not only did a lot of local businesses and families donate

money to the park, which costs \$1.5 million, they also helped design it.

"This is a playground for kids, so we wanted it to be designed by kids," said Szczybor. "They know better than anyone what makes a good park."

What they designed is a 16,000 squarefoot playground and amphitheater that is all inclusive, meaning there will be a wheelchair accessible shaky bridge, a braille pane and even a static-free slide. County Executive Kevin Kamenetz touted Angel Park as the first such park in the county and hoped it would provide a blueprint for park construction moving forward.

#### **HOME** Act bill sees more criticism than support on east side

On Tuesday, July 5, Baltimore County Executive Kevin Kamenetz's bill 46-16, known as the HOME Act (Housing Opportunities Made Equal), was introduced to the County Council. And since then, community debate has centered on the intentions and merits of the bill.

The HOME Act would remove the ability of landlords to discriminate against prospective tenants on the basis of their source of income. It chiefly targets Housing Choice Vouchers (HCVs) - commonly known as Section 8 - but also includes things like disability, annuity, alimony and child support payments.

"This is the bill we expected and it does exactly what we hoped it would

do, which is to prevent the source-ofincome discrimination," said Matt Hill, a lawyer with the Public Justice Center and an advocate for the bill.

The intent of the bill is to remove an obstacle to the county's mobility counseling program, being undertaken as a result of a legal settlement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

That program seeks to help 2,000 HCV holders over a 10-year span move from where the vouchers are concentrated largely in southeastern and western communities - to other parts of the county where they may find access to better jobs and schools. It will provide counseling, security deposit assistance and help in

identifying where people have opportunities for those who want to move.

Without the bill, it would be difficult for the county to meet its goals since landlords in certain neighborhoods will still refuse to take vouchers, Hill said. "And there's nothing the mobility program can do about that."

However, some believe that the bill and mobility program will not do enough to entice people to move and spread evenly throughout the county.

Sixth District Councilwoman Cathy Bevins noted that the government cannot force people to move, and they tend to stay where their support groups are. For instance, if they have a child care provider who is a family member or if their children have friends or other family in their school, they likely will not want to relocate.

Bevins, whose district already has around 1,400 vouchers, also fears she could see even more coming to her district if the bill passes.

Hill was clear that the bill does not create any new HCVs for Baltimore County. And he stressed that voucher holders can already choose to live in areas of the Sixth District, such as Essex and Middle River, where landlords accept them.

But he also identified White Marsh, which is in District 6, as an opportunity area that voucher holders could move to where most landlords do not currently accept HCVs.

Bevins said it is no secret that the Fourth, Sixth and Seventh districts have more vouchers than the rest, and she did not comment on whether or not the county has enough affordable housing. "But what I do know is I have my fair share and more," she said.

"They're not moving across the county, she continued. "I'm going to get more and no one can tell me otherwise."

Bevins also believes that landlords should still have the choice of who they want to rent their private property to.

While she has not yet made her final decision, Bevins said it would be "very hard" for her to support the bill in its current form. She added that most of the letters she has received asking her to support it have come from outside her district.

The Essex-Middle River Civic Council took a similar position to Bevins at its July 6 meeting, stating that the proposed bill does not appropriately address the problems related to HCVs in the county.

They recommended putting a cap on the number of vouchers accepted in areas of high concentration and lowering it annually to achieve a better distribution.

They also suggested providing incentives to property owners in targeted areas to accept HCVs such as tax credits, reduced paperwork, monitoring to discourage new residents from being disruptive to existing communities and other ways of ensuring successful integration without restricting property rights.

Fifth District Councilman David Marks said that most of the constituents he has

#### Overlay bill aims to curb, control development at Fort Howard

At the Baltimore County Council legislative session on Tuesday, July 5, Seventh District Councilman Todd Crandell introduced a bill which would create a Fort Howard Overlay District to specify what can and cannot be done with a 100acre property in his district.

The bill was crafted in response to public outcry over the last several years about a developer's plan to build a "mini-city" on the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA)-owned Fort Howard site.

Timothy Munshell, of Montgomery County-based Fort Howard Development, LLC, had planned nearly 1,400 residential units alongside office and retail space on the site. But he was met with stiff opposition from nearby communities, as well as from Councilman Crandell, who refused to submit a planned unit

development resolution for the project.

The new overlay would specify that no more than 400 residential units can be built on the site, and they would have to be marketed as "veterans preferred" housing. The bill also specifies that apartments would be prohibited under the overlay unless already provided for in the developer's Enhanced Use Lease (EUL) with the VA.

Additionally, the overlay would allow for a veterans-preferred assisted living facility for up to 100 people to be built in an existing building on the site, as well as community, recreational or educational buildings of limited sizes. The overall project would have to be compatible with the existing Fort Howard community and integrate the historic structures on the site with the adjacent rural park setting.

Development would be prohibited in

the areas zoned for resource conservation in the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area on the site, and any project would have to comply with all open space standards while not being able to pay a fee in lieu of providing any required open space.

Other specifications of the bill, such as providing therapeutic amenities for disabled veterans in any project and having those amenities open to any disabled veteran, regardless of their place of residence, are intended to ensure that the property is redeveloped with veterans in mind.

The Save Fort Howard organization, has sought a return of the site to a fully functioning VA medical center, as well as its designation as a living national historic monument.

And Francis Taylor, president of the North Point Peninsula Council (NPC)

- an umbrella group of several community organizations - said the council is concerned that the "veterans preferred" designation is only a guideline and there is no real veteran obligation.

Additionally, with the VA now backing away from any presence on the property, questions remain about who will run the facility for homeless veterans that the VA has said is part of the EUL agreement with the developer.

"Who will have responsibility for this homeless program?" Taylor asked. "Who will monitor health, well-being and daily activities, and how will this number of people without transportation impact the surrounding community?"

There have also been questions, Taylor noted, about the new development plan presented by Armando Cignarale, - see **OVERLAY** on page 8 -

The help from the community extends well beyond building and supplying money for the park. DeWalt donated all of the tools used during the process. Home Depot donated supplies and has had approximately 50 volunteers per shift, lending their expertise. Weis and McDonald's provided food and beverages for the volunteers.

"This type of support was something

that we hoped for, but we didn't really think it would turn out like it has," said Szczybor. "We got a few big donors, but most of what we raised was from people giving us jars of change, or sacrificing their lunch or morning coffee just to donate. So seeing how supportive the community has been

is just overwhelming."

According to Szczybor, the park should be completed and ready to for a grand opening by the end of August.

"This is just something that I wanted to help out with because I was in special needs classes," said Albert Glass, who graduated from Perry Hall High School two years ago. "I wanted my friends and the people in those classes to have somewhere to go and have fun.

continued from page 2 heard from on the issue are against the legislation. "So that clearly weighs on me," he said.

Marks acknowledged his feeling that advocates of the initiative genuinely care about making sure everyone can find a home. "But there are a lot of complex issues that have to be weighed against that," he noted.

He explained that there are many landlords who accept HCVs with no

problems. "But many people feel that, if you're a property owner, you should have the discretion as to whether or not you accept the voucher."

Marks, whose district stretches from Perry Hall to Towson, believes the bill would "certainly help" to decentralize vouchers in the county. "And that's a real issue to me," he said.

"If you truly want to eliminate poverty, you need to do a lot of things," the councilman said, including improving education and child care, as well as having better access to jobs and workforce training. "There's a menu of things you have to do. And simply spreading poverty throughout the suburbs isn't the right answer."

Marks assured that he is in favor of doing those necessary things because they are what help build strong communities and lift people out of

Councilman Todd Crandell, who represents Dundalk, Edgemere and much of Essex and Rosedale in the Seventh District, went so far as to state that he will be voting "no" on the HOME Act bill.

"I don't believe that [county] government should be requiring property owners to enter into a contract with the federal government," he said.

"Attempts at social engineering haven't worked in the past," he added, "so I'm not sure why we're trying it again.

"No one is saying we shouldn't give a helping hand," he stressed. "But from an economic standpoint, a concentration of vouchers in an area makes it difficult to attract the kinds of amenities we're trying to attract," he said, referring to ongoing revitalization efforts throughout his district such as at Sparrows Point.

On top of that, Crandell also feels that it would ultimately result in his district getting more vouchers since property values are generally lower there than in other parts of the county and people can get more house for their voucher there.

Additionally, people make decisions about where to live based on their family or job they may already have in the area, he said. And there are currently some property owners in his district that do not accept vouchers but would be forced to under the legislation.

"That, to me, says I'll get more." Crandell said.

The HOME Act bill will be discussed at the Council work session on Thursday, July 21, at 2 p.m. The vote will occur at the legislative session on Monday, Aug. 1, at 6 p.m. in the Council Chambers in the Historic Courthouse in Towson.

But Crandell's legislative aide, Doug Anderson, said the councilman did not work with Cignarale at all in drafting the

Cignarale's plan in putting it together.

'Actually, there's no real plan," Anderson said, noting that no formal plans or drawings have been submitted to the county. "Everything that Cignarale is going with now is kind of like a written-onthe-back-of-a-napkin type thing."

He added that Cignarale did not see the overlay bill until July 5, just hours before it was introduced to the Council, "and that was by design."

"We didn't want their input; we wanted community input and we wanted to dictate the project," Anderson explained.

Like the general public, Crandell has not seen the entire EUL document, Anderson said.

"So now we're faced with drawing up legislation guessing what's on the lease based on a loose, 10-page talking point thing that we finally got last week, he lamented. "There's so many moving parts here, it's tough to nail this down."

If approved, the bill would take effect just in time to be placed on the property through the county's zoning process.

### **DUI** madness and its consequences

- By Parker, Pallett, Slezak & Russell, LLC -

The legislature continues to make the penalties for driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs - or a combination thereof - more stiff to save lives. The laws remain constant, that if a defendant fails to take a breathalyzer test or submit to a drug recognition expert, he will forfeit his driver's license for a period of time. A high blood alcohol reading or outright refusal will cause the loss of a license for up to year. Conviction of driving under the influence can result in a sentence of up to a year in jail for a first offense, and multiple years for repeat offenders. And a further burdensome sanction has been passed by the recent state legislative session: any conviction for a DUI will require an interlock on the defendant's vehicle for a minimum of a year.

Here's an item of great importance to those who have had that unnecessary last drink at the "Coyote Watering Hole": if you are stopped after leaving the bar, and are asked to take the breath test - do not refuse to take the test! The consequences are draconian: you will lose your license for 120 days, unless you agree to using an expensive and cumbersome interlock system for one year.

On the other hand, the breath test can be a shield rather than a sword, especially if the BAC reading is







We are taking steps to preserve a network of green space throughout Perry Hall.


The zoning maps will be adopted by the County Council on Aug. 30.

'THE SECRET LIFE OF PETS' barks up the right tree

If you have a dog or a cat, you've probably experienced this scenario. You've gone out for a while - maybe to work, maybe to eat, maybe to see a movie. So, you return home, you slide the key in the lock, you open the front door, and... nothing! Where's the pup?! Where's the kitty?! Then, a few seconds later, you hear a little commotion, a "kerplunk" and your four-footer comes running to you from a remote part of the house or apartment. "There you are!" you exclaim. After a hug and a stroke of the fur, you then look at the animal and wonder, "What were you doing?!" And he or she just looks at you with that silly, panting face as if to say, "I wasn't doing anything! I'm here! You just caught me napping!"

Er, maybe you did. Maybe you didn't. The new animated flick, "The Secret Life of Pets" attempts to show some of what might be going on when animal lovers are not home and their furry or feathered housemates are left to take care of things. It's a fun, funny "What if?" story that is at its best when the action is confined to the New York apartment building where most of the main animal characters live. The early scenes of owners leaving and dogs, cats, birds, fish and turtles raiding the fridge, working the remote and rocking out to music are blissfully fun. Yes, it's a variation on "Toy Story" when the various dolls, stuffed animals and action figures come to life when no one's around. But,

hey, I'm surprised it's taken 20-plus years to deliver this twist on that narrative.

"The Secret Life of Pets" does not have the emotional depth of the finer Pixar movies or the political and social allegory of a "Zootopia." What does it have? Fun! Gobs and gobs of fun! Comedian Louis C.K. voices Max, a loyal dog who loves his life with his female owner Katie (Ellie Kemper). But his world is thrown for a loop when she adopts a big, lumbering lummox of a canine named Duke (Eric Stonestreet) and he is forced to cohabitate with him. During one misadventure in a Manhattan park, Max and Duke become separated from their dog walker and fall into a big-city underworld of tough, stray, unwanted former pets run by Snowball (voice of Kevin Hart). The dictatorial hare is kind of a cross between Hocus Pocus of the classic "Frosty the Snowman" cartoon and Erwin Rommel.

The second half of the film centers on Max and Duke putting their differences aside to get back home, cross-cut with Snowball and his forces' obsession with getting revenge on the two dogs (for reasons I won't spoil here), cross-cut with Max's animal friends from his building trying to find him. They're led by a scrappy white Pomeranian named Gidget (Jenny Slate) who's not so secretly in love with Max and an old, literally on-his-last-legs beagle named Pops (Dana Carvey, resurrecting his classic Grumpy Old Man character



from "Saturday Night Live").

"Pets" gets a bit too manic in its climactic moments for my tastes. In this day and age of cell phone cameras and surveillance footage, you can't have dogs and cats and lizards driving cars and getting into "Matrix"-style fights on major Gotham bridges and expect to maintain the "secret life" illusion. Again, when the action is away from human eyes, the film is at its absolute best. But even when the flick is going way beyond the bounds of plausibility (if we're being truthful here, so did the much praised "Finding Dory"), I never stopped laughing.

This is a very entertaining film. And I can't wait to add it to the home collection so I can watch with my dog, Bear, and get his reaction as I stare intensely at the hound throughout.

"The Secret Life of Pets" is rated PG for action and some rude humor.

#### Man charged in **Essex homicide case**

Detectives with the Baltimore County Police Department Homicide Unit have charged a suspect in connection with a January homicide in Essex.

Just before 2 a.m. on Jan. 26, Baltimore County Police and Fire personnel responded to the unit block of Valley Arbor Court in Essex for a report of a shooting. When officers arrived on the scene, they found two men that had been shot. Both were transported to area hospitals where one of them died.

The man who died was identified as 25-year-old Antonio David Truesdale of the 1100 block of Sandstone Road in Essex. The other man was treated at an area hospital and later released.

The initial investigation into this incident has indicated that Truesdale and another man were involved in an interaction with two male suspects. During that interaction, at least one of the suspects shot both men.

Further investigation led detectives to identify 21-year-old Sadiq Torrez Heyward (no fixed address) as the person responsible for this crime. Heyward has been charged with first-degree murder and attempted first-degree murder. He is being held without bail at the Baltimore County Detention Cen-

This incident remains under investigation by the Baltimore County Police Homicide Unit. Detectives are continue working to identify the second suspect.



#### Current crime trends

Since June 5, there have been seven auto thefts in the Joppa Heights and Apple Ridge communities in the Towson, Parkville and White Marsh precincts. Cases occurred mostly overnight. #### 10-year-old pedestrian struck by car in Dundalk

Two young children were struck by vehicles in Baltimore County during the night on July 6. These incidents happened just less than an hour apart in separate sections of the county.

The first crash took place on the west side of the county and resulted in a young boy being treated for serious injuries. The second crash happened at 7:10 p.m. on Bank Street and Rolling Mill Road in Dundalk. The investigation into that crash has indicated that a 10-year-old boy was chasing a dog while attempting to cross Bank Street. He was struck by a Toyota Matrix when he ran into the vehicle's path. The boy was transported to Johns Hopkins Hospital by ground for treatment. The Toyota Matrix remained at the scene.

Both crashes are under investigation by the Baltimore County Police Crash Team. Those investigations are expected to take several weeks.

The Baltimore County Police Department encourages parents to speak with their children about pedestrian safety and recommends the following:

- \* Always cross at traffic lights, marked crosswalks or intersections.
- Obey traffic signals at all times. Don't attempt to cross if the signal tells you to stop.
- \* Stay alert when crossing. Even when the signal says WALK, you should check that the path is clear.
- Always check in all directions for approaching vehicles before crossing the street. If there is a vehicle approaching, wait until it passes before trying to cross.
- \* Try to make eye contact with drivers before stepping off the curb.
- Walk on the sidewalk whenever possible. If there is no sidewalk, walk on the side of the road, facing
  - Wear bright or reflective clothing at night.
- \* Avoid distraction when crossing. Turn off headphones and put away your cell phone before crossing.






