

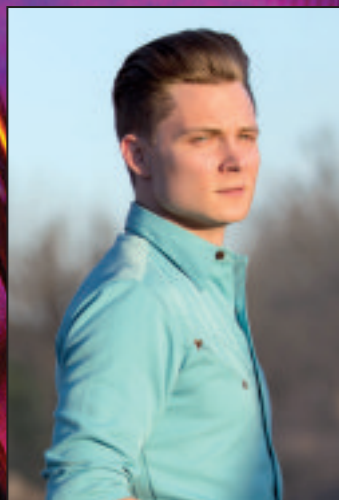

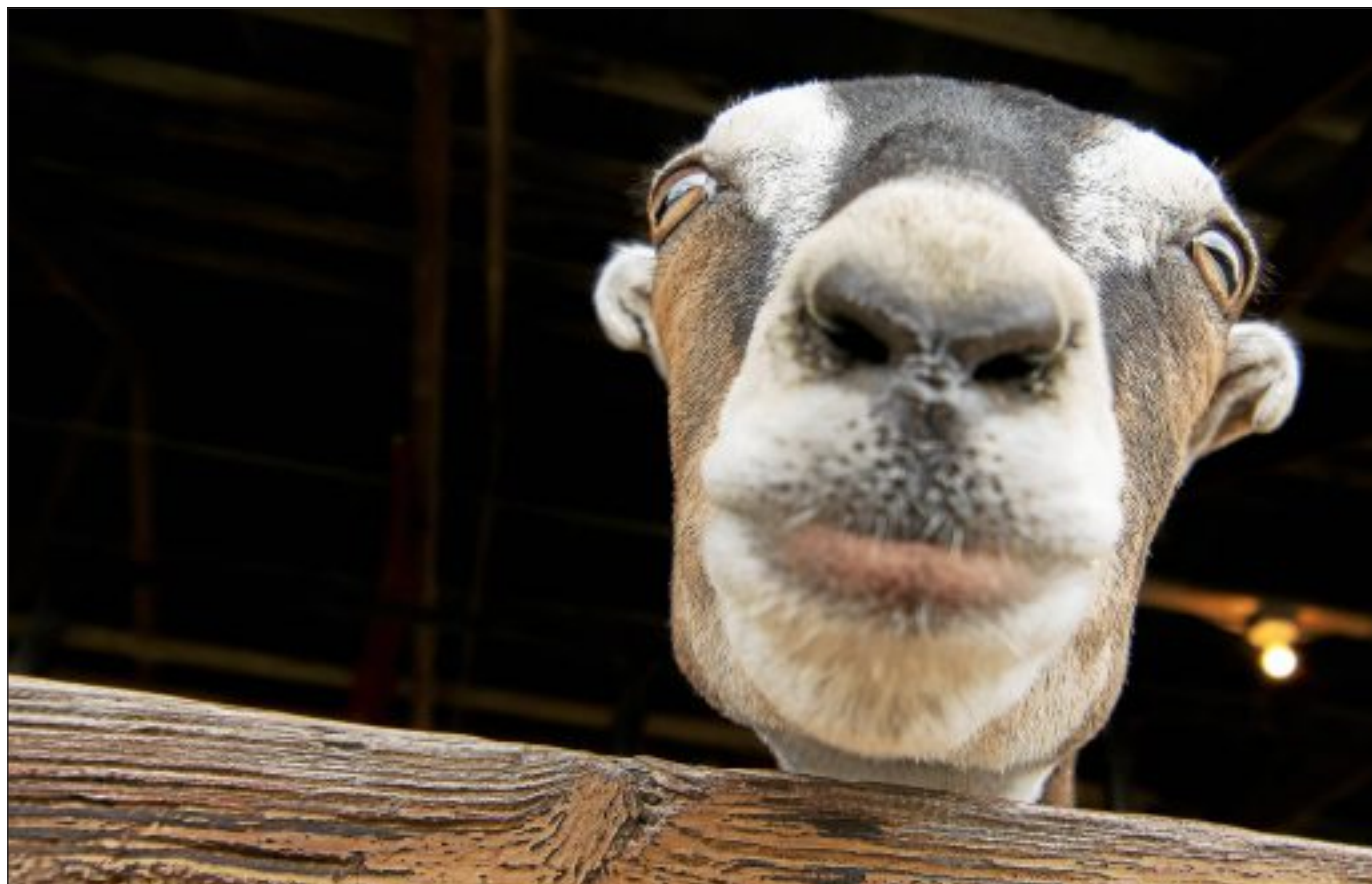

That's entertainment

Grandstand events will offer something for everyone

The 2016 Lorain County Fair opens Aug. 22 and many people will be flooding in to see the attractions held at the grandstand which acts as a central hub to all of the other attractions.

According to Tim Buchs, a director of the fair, this year's lineup will feature some exciting acts and attractions including rock band .38 Special on

Aug. 22 and singer-songwriter Frankie Ballard on Aug. 23.

"Every year we make a list of who we feel are good candidates, and it just comes down to routing and schedules and that type of things," he said. "We could get anywhere from 10 to 20 names, and it just comes down to what schedules will permit."

Buchs said that while many spend all day at the fair, he thinks that some people come out just to catch the shows at the grandstand.

"We would hope that would make them consider coming, but a lot of people come to the fair and make a day of it," he said. "Go to the shows, or just walk

around. There's entertainment going on constantly. But yeah, I'm sure the shows are a draw and that people come that particular day just for the show.

Yes. I don't for sure know a percentage rate."

Tickets to see the grandstand concerts are \$25 as well as the \$5 price of admission to the fair. Children under 9 years old get in free.

Senior citizens and military personnel also get in free on Aug. 25, according to Buchs.

Brian Twining, Lorain County senior fair board president, said that he's excited for a grandstand event that may fly under most people's radars: The horse pull on Aug. 25.

"A lot of people don't know about it," he said. "I guess a better word for it is 'old school'."

He said that horse pulls are reminiscent of the kind of activities that fairs were created to showcase.

"Back when they would put together a fair, it was 'my horse is better than yours' or 'my wife can cook a better pie than yours and we'll get Jill our neighbor to come down and figure out who has the better pie,'" he said.

"That's how the original fairs came together."

Something new

Fair to feature new Veterans and EMT Building

The 2016 Lorain County Fair is preparing to get underway, and with this year's fair there are a number of new features to the fair-ground, according to Brian Twining, the Lorain County senior fair board president.

The main improvement of the grounds is the new Veterans and EMS building, which sits behind the Fair Board Office, 23000 Fairgrounds Road in Wel-

lington.

The veterans held a special place for John Emerich, who served on the board for 44 years until his death in 2013.

The board took up that passion by replacing the barn that formerly housed the veterans.

"When John passed away, the board kind of took it upon themselves to say, 'this is something he really wanted,'" he said. "We kind of dug in, and the VFW donated some money and we had some fundraisers going on, and we

decided this late fall, early winter, to put this up."

There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony at 11 a.m. Aug. 22 which will feature a special guest, according to Twining.

"We actually asked John's widow, Judy, to come up and cut the ribbon," he said.

"It'll be kind of neat to have her up there. It'll be kind of like closure for us board members."

Also new this year will be general grounds improvements such as lights

Always entertaining

Fair will feature free entertainment

For many people, the allure of the Lorain County Fair is the entertainment they find while just wandering around the grounds.

Tom Adams, the free stage director, said that this year the fair is offering some of the best entertainment you can find.

New this year will be the Dock Dogs, which is an event in which dogs compete to see which can jump the highest and farthest into a body of water. The competitions will be held near gate three.

"They do basically a dog competition," he said. "There will be some demonstrations and stuff like that. They'll be jumping and grabbing various items off of a hanging line. The dogs will jump higher and further to try to grab this item. I think there should be four or five demonstrations each day. Starting at like 10 a.m. or 11 a.m. and

the last one usually concluding about 7 p.m."

On the afternoon of Aug. 27, the fair will welcome singer Morgan Myles, whom Adams believes has a future in country music.

"I think she might be one of those up and coming artists," he said. "She'll be playing 1-3 p.m. She has an agent in Nashville. She has her own website and plenty of videos on YouTube. She has a really good voice; I wouldn't be surprised to see her on the charts in the near future."

outside of the grandstand, new blacktop to cut down on holes and trip areas and increased handicap parking, which Twining said was sorely needed.

"That's always been a

problem; not enough," he said. "More and more people need access to handicap parking."

According to Twining, these improvements were paid for through fundraising, donations, and also the fair board's budget.

"We did get some grant money, the VFW with the veteran's building" he said.

"I can't give you an exact number, but it was quite a few VFW groups that donated money. It would come out of our budget, too. We've been planning this. In November we have Night at the Races that raised some money to help with the costs. We prepare, we work year round to make those fairgrounds better."

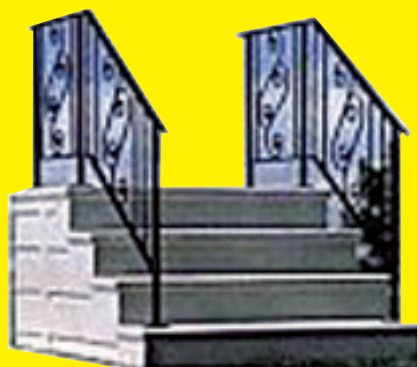

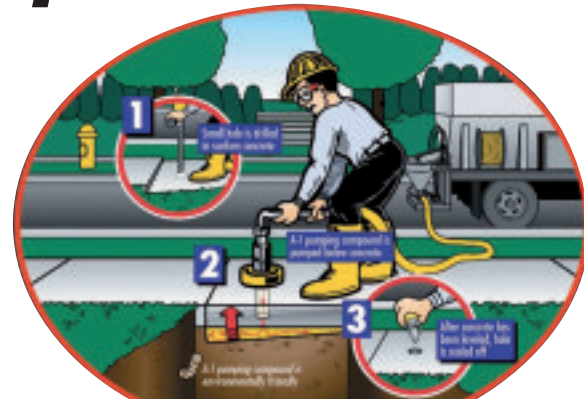

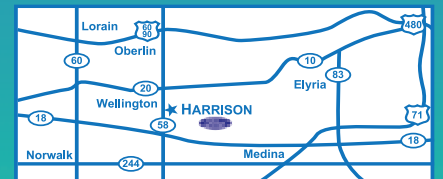
