GRILLING SEASON IS HERE!

Some important safety tips to remember:

- Propane & charcoal grills should ONLY be used outside.

PROPANE GRILLS

- CHECK the gas tank for hose leaks before using it for the first time each year.

- Apply a light soap and water solution to the hose. A propane leak will produce bubbles. If you find a leak by smell or the bubbles test and there is no flame, turn the tank and the grill off. If the leak stops, have the grill serviced professionally before using it again. If the leak does not stop, call the Fire Department. If you smell gas while cooking, immediately get away from the grill and call the Fire Department. Do NOT move the grill.

- If the flame goes out while cooking, turn the grill off and wait at least 5 minutes before relighting it.

- Place the grill well away from the home, deck railings, out from under any eaves and overhanging branches. Keep children and pets at least 3 feet from the grill area.

- Keep grill clean - remove grease or fat buildup from the grill and in the trays below the grill.

- Never leave the grill unattended.

- Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before you light it.

CHARCOAL GRILLS

- Use a charcoal chimney to start the charcoal grill with newspapers as fuel. Use only charcoal starter fluid to start charcoal grills.

- NEVER add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquid to the fire.

- Keep charcoal fluid out of the reach of children and away from heat sources.

- Electric charcoal starters do not use fire. Use an extension cord for outdoor use. When you are finished grilling, let the coals cool completely before disposing them in a metal container.

- There is nothing quite like outdoor grilling; we have such a short season of it. Take a few extra steps to be safe. Grills can be very hot and they are a fire hazard when placed too close to anything else and can be a source of burn injuries. Grill safely.

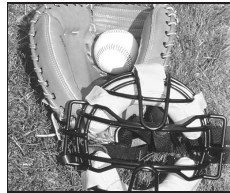

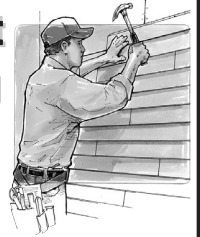

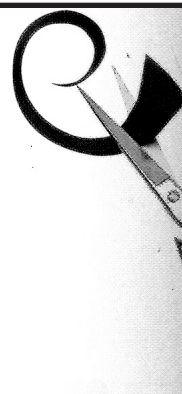
