





Alabama music, his music mentoring of others, his efforts in music education, and keeping the sound of the big band era alive.'

Holden first sang on stage as a pre-teen at the Princess Theatre in Decatur. He was recruited as a singer in high school by the Starlighters, a band that played pop music. In the late 50s and early 60s, Edsel put together his own group called the Eddie Holden Orchestra. This group played all over the tri-state region.

He worked in theatre productions as a trumpet player in the pit, and eventually as an actor. He began working as a studio musician playing trumpet. He is also one of the original

members of the Big Band a musical group at UNA that performs 30's and 40's era classics.

Holden has performed on stage his entire life. However, his accomplishments also reach into music history and education. He was one of the driving forces behind the creation of the annual W.C. Handy Festival. In the late 90's he helped to produce a series of concerts for elementary school students as part of Black History Month. After the series' first year, it was invited to perform in Washington D.C. for the National Geographic Society.

Many of Holden's performances are also for charitable causes, such as the restoration of the historic Shoals Theatre in Florence.

I was driving my friend's car and she doesn't have insurance. I have insurance, but I got a ticket for failure to show proof of insurance. Does my insurance not cover the car that I was driving?

Ashton, Sheffield, AL

Your insurance follows you in terms of your liability coverage. If you borrow a car that is uninsured and do damage to someone else's property, your liability insurance coverage should pay for it absent some contract language to the contrary.

You should be able to show the judge that you had insurance on a car and the judge should recognize that your insurance would cover damage to someone else's car if you were at fault.

If you have collision coverage on your car, that is insurance that will repair your car in the event that it is damaged no matter whose fault it is, that coverage only follows you in a borrowed car under most

circumstances, if your car was broken and/or being repaired. Otherwise, your insurance will not pay to fix a car you borrow if you could have been driving your own.

Because people ask what types of coverage they have, 25/50 means that your insurance will pay \$25,000 to any one person injured and \$50,000 maximum per accident. 100/300 means that your insurance will pay \$100,000 to any one person injured as a result of your negligence and \$300,000 maximum per accident. UM (uninsured/underinsured motorist) covers your bodily injury in the event that you are injured by someone who is either uninsured or underinsured. This coverage stacks so that if you have multiple cars, you have multiple coverage. The buyer of insurance chooses how much coverage protection they need. 50/100 pays \$50,000 to any one person and \$100,000 maximum no matter how many people are in the car.

Obviously, you should buy insurance proportionate to what you need to protect. If you are retired and own your own house be sure and discuss with your agent how much insurance you need. On the other hand, if you are just starting out in life and have no property, very little income then obviously a smaller policy would be adequate.

Buckle up and drive safely.

## **Medicare Minute**

## "Medicare Supplements"

Medicare supplements, also known as Medigap policies, are designed to help cover some or all of the deductibles, copays and coinsurance that Original Medicare does not cover. Medigap policies are sold through private insurance companies.

In Alabama these insurance companies can sell you only a "standardized" policy identified by a letter, such as Plan F. The most common supplemental plans in Alabama are Plans A, B, F, G and N. The term "standardized" means that Medicare requires all plans with a particular letter to have the same basic benefits regardless of the company selling it. For example, a Plan G with one company has to have the exact basic benefits as Plan G with every other company selling it.

Two things to keep in mind when shopping for a Medigap policy. First is the premium. Different insurance companies can charge different premiums for the exact same policy. This means you could pay more for your Medigap policy from one company than you would from other companies offering the same basic benefits. It's a good idea to check with someone who can show you the premiums from several companies to be sure you're getting the best premium for you coverage.

The second thing to keep in mind is the type of Medigap policy you are looking at. Some companies offer a Medicare SELECT policy. SELECT policies may require you to use a defined network of providers to receive full coverage, meaning you may not have full coverage from a provider even though the provider accepts Medicare. A standard Medigap policy will allow you to go to any provider that accepts Medicare. If you are not sure about the type of Medigap policy you are looking at, or its premium, you can contact or come by our office for







Was hunting and target shooting a big concern of the Founding Fathers in securing the right to keep and bear arms or did they have much more important issues in mind?



## Preparing for a Bankruptcy Case

What Documents do I Need to File a Bankruptcy Case?

If you are just starting to consider filing a bankruptcy case, you're probably wondering where to start. You're asking yourself "What information and documents will I need to provide to my lawyer or to the court?" This blog post will lay out the basics you need to get started.

1. Driver's License and Social Security Card. First, you'll need your Driver's License and Social Security Card. The Court will require you to present a government issued photo ID. If your License has been suspended or you don't have one, then you'll need to get a Non-Driver ID card. Your local State Trooper's License Office can issue one and they'll tell you what you need to get one. Also, if you've lost your Social Security Card, then you'll need to go apply for a new one. You can apply at the Social Security office and it usually takes a few weeks to get your new card.

2. Tax Returns. Second, you'll need to be sure you've filed your Federal Income Tax Returns for the past 4 years. If you are filing a Chapter 13 case, it is a requirement that your last 4 years of Tax Returns have been filed. The Court will want to see copies of at least the 2 (two) previous years of returns. If you don't have copies of those yourself, then you'll need to obtain copies from whoever prepared your taxes for those years. If all else fails, you can get copies of your returns or get tax transcripts for those years from your local IRS office. If you were not required to file a tax return because your only income is Social Security or you did not earn enough income to file, that isn't a problem. Your attorney can help you submit to the Court an affidavit that you weren't required to file.

3. Copies of Financial Account Statements. Third, you'll need copies of a recent account statement from any financial account you have. This includes any checking or savings accounts at a bank or credit union. It also includes statements for other kinds of financial accounts, such as Certificates of Deposit (CDs) or Money Market accounts. Additionally, the court will want to see recent account statements from any stocks, bonds, mutual funds, 401ks, or other long-term investments that you have. You should be able to obtain statements either from your bank or from your investment broker.

4. Copies of Paystubs. Lastly, you'll need to provide copies of your last 6 months of paystubs. When filing a bankruptcy case, the court looks at your last 6 months of income in determining whether you qualify to file under the Means Test. Your attorney will also need your paystubs to calculate your monthly income for your budget. If you don't have copies of your paystubs, you should be able to get copies printed from the payroll department at your job.



to a website where you will enter an email address. You will then be inundated with spam that sells anything other than the free car you wanted. Sometimes, you will be asked to enter your cell phone number. Once the scammers have that, they will enter you into a text messaging service that will be billed on your next cell phone invoice often at \$5 per message received.

More often than not, this is an attempt to get you to "like" a Facebook page. This is called "like farming."

When the scammer has enough likes, they will often change the name of the page and start advertising "knockoff" sunglasses or begin spamming your Facebook feed with links to other less reputable websites. Facebook users who participate in such fake giveaways not only unwittingly help spammers pollute the social network with scams, they may also risk being exposed to malware or may find their names and identities endorsing a scam, hate page, or other unpleasant activity.

There are legitimate giveaways, of course. I am determined to one day win that HGTV Dream Home Giveaway. I've participated every year for at least a decade. Y'all are all invited



## **Australian Gun Laws Useless**

The Federal and State Governments of Australia have made it illegal for any unlicensed Australian citizens to possess a firearm. In order to possess one, you must make application through departments and have a good reason to do so. Selfdefense is not considered a good reason.

You must become a member of a gun club and/ or have written permission from a farm owner to hunt on his land. Then you are subject to a stringent background check, etc. If you are finally given permission to own a gun, you are required to keep it locked away in such a manner that it would be practically useless in home defense. There is no such thing as a permit to publicly carry a firearm except for licenseds ecurity personnel.

As an avid observer of the Australian culture for some 46 years since immigrating here from the U.S., I can say with some certainty that only a tiny percentage of people living in urban Australia would own any kind of firearm and practically no one would have a side arm. 




