CORN FLAKE COOKIES

Ingredients

- 2 cups all purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 1/4 cups shortening
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup brown sugar, firmly packed
- 2 eggs, well-beaten
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 2 cups coconut (shredded or flaked)
- 2 cups corn flakes

Directions

Pre-heat oven to 350* and line your cookie sheets with parchment or grease them well.

Sift flour, soda, salt and powder together and set aside.

Cream sugars and shortening together until light and fluffy. Add eggs and vanilla.

Add dry ingredients to creamed and mix well. Add coconut and cornflakes and mix slowly just til mixed inches.

Drop by spoonful onto the parchment and bake 8 - 10 minutes until delicately browned.

BUTTERSCOTCH CRUNCHIES

- 1 (12 oz.) bag butterscotch bits
- 1/4 c. crunchy peanut butter
- 3 1/2 c. cornflakes

Melt butterscotch bits and peanut butter over very low heat. Stir in cornflakes and mix well. Drop from



teaspoonfuls onto wax paper and refrigerate until hardened, about 5 minutes.

CORN FLAKE FUDGE

Ingredients

- 2 c. packed dark brown sugar
- 1 c. half-and-half
- 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
- 7 tbs. unsalted butter, cut into pieces
- 1 tsp. pure vanilla extract
- 1 1/2 c. confectioners' sugar
- 4 oz. bittersweet chocolate, finely chopped (about 1/2 c. plus 1 tbs.)
- 2 c. cornflakes
- Flaked sea salt, for serving

Directions

- 1. Place the sugar, half-and-half, salt, and 4 tablespoons butter in a medium heavy- bottomed saucepan. Warm over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until the sugar melts and is no longer sandy, 4 to 5 minutes.
- 2. Place a candy thermometer in the pan and gently boil, without stirring, until the mixture reaches 235 degrees F, 10 to 12 minutes.
- 3. Meanwhile, line an 8" square pan with nonstick foil, leaving a 2" overhang on two sides.
- 4. Transfer the mixture to the bowl of an electric mixer and stir in the vanilla. With the mixer on low speed, gradually beat in the confectioners' sugar until the mixture is smooth and lighter in color, 3 to 4 minutes. Spread the mixture into the prepared pan.
- 5. In a large bowl, microwave the chocolate and the remaining 3 tablespoons butter, stirring every 30 seconds, until melted and smooth. Add the cornflakes









and gently fold until evenly coated. Spoon on top of the fudge, then sprinkle with flaked salt, if desired.

6. Refrigerate until firm, at least 30 minutes and up to 5 days. When ready to serve, use the overhangs to lift the fudge out of the pan and cut into 1" pieces.

NO-BAKE EASY CORN FLAKE BALLS

Yield: 45 balls Ingredients

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup light corn syrup
- 1 1/3 cups peanut butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 4 cups corn flakes
- Raisins
- Peanuts
- Coconut

Directions

- 1. Heat sugar and corn syrup in large saucepan until mixture reaches a boil.
- 2. Remove from heat.
- 3. Mix in peanut butter and vanilla; combine well.
- 4. Stir in corn flakes and raisins, peanuts, and coconuts
- 5. Shape into small mounds (about 1 inch) on waxed paper to cool.

NO-BAKE CHOCOLATE, PEANUT BUTTER, CORN FLAKE BARS

Servings: 16
Ingredients

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- 3 cups corn flakes, crushed
- 1 cup crunchy peanut butter
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup white corn syrup
- 6 ounces chocolate chips

Directions

- 1. Heat peanut butter, sugar and corn syrup over low heat to melt. Stir in cereal.
- 2. Pat into a 8×8 lightly greased pan. (I line my pan with foil and then lightly spray it. When it is time to cut them, the foil lifts right out.).
- 3. Melt chocolate chips over low heat or in the microwave and spread over top. Cool until firm.

CORN FLAKE PIE CRUST

Ingredients

- 1/3 c sugar
- 1/2 c butter, melted
- 4 c corn flakes cereal

Directions

Add together: sugar, butter, and crushed corn flake cereal crumbs. Press firmly into the bottom and sides of a 9 inch pie plate. Bake at 350 degrees about 7 -9 minutes. Let cool before adding pie filling.
