

Claire and the other two boys realized Ragan was hurt as she floated in the water face down not moving. They quickly were able to get her turned over, and two other heroes jumped in and managed to get Ragan out of the water and onto a nearby

She was unresponsive when paramedics arrived. She was quickly airlifted to Huntsville Hospital to be stabilized and then to Children's Hospital in Birmingham. After being admitted to the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, CT scans and other medical tests revealed Ragan had suffered a traumatic brain injury (TBI) and a broken arm. She has been unconscious since May 30 as the family holds vigil by her bedside.

My husband and I have a survivorship will and a durable power of attorney typed and ready to sign before a notary public. We have two children and they are equally named in the will and power of attorney. Our reasoning for the power of attorney is that if one or both of us became incapacitated then there would be someone who would be able to make decisions for us regarding health problems, finances, etc. Do you have to probate a will when you have a power of attorney signed by both parties?

Peggy, Tuscumbia, AL

First of all, I am glad to see that you have taken the time to get your priorities in order with regards to your future. There are some things, however, that you need to know regarding Last Wills and Testaments and Power of Attorneys.

Power of Attorneys and Wills perform distinctly different functions and come into play at different times. A power of attorney allows the "grantor" to convey to another person the power to act on their behalf in the making of financial and medical decisions during a time of incapacity. A power of attorney ends immediately upon the death of the grantor. When the grantor passes away, the power of attorney is no longer valid and therefore of no use.

A Last Will and Testament comes into effect immediately upon the maker's death. A Last Will and Testament has no power or effect until an individual's death. A person's Last Will and Testament conveys the individual's wishes for the dispersal of their property after death.

From your question, I want to make sure that it is understood that both you and your husband need a separate will. Make sure that the will is signed by two witnesses and a notary to ensure that it is a "self proving" will. Wills, as well as powers of attorney, are services that our office provides.

So in answer to your question, yes, you would need to probate the will upon the death of the person in order to facilitate his or her last wishes.

Buckle up and drive safely.



"Important Facts about Supplements"

If you are considering a Medicare Supplement, or Medigap policy, for the first time there are some important facts you should know. To begin with you have to be enrolled in Medicare Part A and Part B to sign up for a Medigap plan. If you choose to sign up for a Medigap plan, you then will pay the private insurance company a premium in addition to your Part B premium that you pay Medicare. Occasionally we will speak with someone who thinks the Part B premium paid to Medicare covers the cost of their Medigap plan. This is not the case. The Part B premium paid to Medicare covers the benefits, discussed in earlier articles, that Medicare allows you

Another fact to keep in mind is a Medigap policy will only cover one person. This is also true of Medicare Advantage and prescription drug plans. If your spouse wants a Medicare plan of any type they will have to sign up for themselves. However, some Medigap companies will give you a premium discount if you live with someone over the age of 60. This can be a huge savings for you.

Medigap policies do not cover most prescription drugs. If you want prescription drug coverage you will need to purchase a stand-alone prescription drug plan from a private insurance company. Medigap policies are designed to supplement, or fill in the gaps of, Original Medicare. When a claim is filed with Medicare, Medicare will pay first and the Medigap policy will pay its part depending on the type of plan you have chosen. Therefore, because Original Medicare does not cover most prescription drugs, your Medigap policy will not have that coverage



Two Native American award-winning artists, Arvel Bird (Paiute and Celtic) and group Injunuity (Chickasaw and Choctaw) will head the musical line up for this year's festival and present a unique combination of traditional and contemporary Native American music.

It has been said, "If the stories fall silent, who will teach the children?" Elementary school groups from across the region will attend special activities Friday, including storytelling, dancing, music, art, and living history demonstrations. Last year's event drew an estimated 9,000 people over the two days with about 1,000 students benefiting from the educational program. The 2015 festival was again named a Top 20 Event by the Southeast Tourism Society. Bring lawn chairs. In the event of rain, the program will be inside.

Rain, More Rain and Much Misery

achary, Louisiana was one of the towns hardest hit in East Baton Rouge Parrish when 24 inches of rain fell in a two-day period beginning on August 11. My sister, Ginamarie, recently moved from Baton Rouge to this small, quaint town about 20 miles away, with her

husband, Lee, and son, Dane. She awoke to unusually heavy rain on August 11, which happened to be her 50th birthday. Within hours, she began receiving flash flood alerts on her cell phone. However, because their home wasn't in a predetermined flood zone, she dismissed them. That was until photos from neighbors and friends also came flooding into her phone, depicting the rapidlyrising water flowing into their homes. Fortunately, my sister's house was spared the wrath of the floodwaters that breached some homes in her neighborhood, as well approximately 120,000

other homes in the parish. Homes were inundated with one - eight feet of water... and the sewage. Yes, to make matters worse, backwater flooding from the onslaught of rain in such a short amount of time caused sewer lines and drain lines to swell, mixing with flood water. With nowhere for the water to drain, it rapidly flowed into properties, into businesses, and into homes. The odds of such a rain disaster were unfathomable, one-tenth of 1% in any year, making it a one-thousand year rain event.





This may be a really un-hip or un-cool thing to say, but I wouldn't buy a tiny house at all. Paying cash for something like that might make the mover smarter, but that still doesn't mean it's a smart choice.

Now, don't take what I'm saying the wrong way. I don't have a problem with people

who build tiny houses or buy them. My problem with these things is that there's no track record on them. There's also a pretty good chance they're going to be just a fad. Another problem is that you'd have a really small market when it comes time to sell your tiny house. In other words, they probably won't go up in value like a traditional home. They

may actually lose value over

the years.

There's a thing in economics called the supply-demand curve, and from what I've seen tiny houses also have a tiny demand and pretty narrow market appeal. Their appeal seems to be mostly for early adopters and people who think they'll never be able to afford a house. That means they're not going to have broad appeal when you get ready to sell them, either. And that creates a problem.

I could be wrong, though. I mean, if enough people buy tiny houses and they become a real part of our culture, then maybe they'll do okay. But right now it's an unproven product line and an unproven concept. So I wouldn't buy a tiny house. Honestly, I wouldn't even buy one at half of its current value because I'd be afraid it would drop to a fourth of its value. There's just no proven record at this point of these things going up in value.

Dear Karen,

I'm really sorry about your dad. I'm also sorry this was never taken care of or discussed while he was still alive.

There are a lot of emotions at play, so I don't want to beat you up too much. But legally, he didn't have to leave you anything in his estate. The stuff we're talking about, money included, was his to do with as he saw fit. It was a little odd that he didn't address this with you beforehand, but there are lots of instances where kids get nothing from an estate or not as much as others. It's not uncommon.

In my mind, and, from the sound of it, his too, he left you an equal share minus what you still owed. He loaned you the money, and he had the right to set terms on that. I understand your frustration. You feel like he took something away that was yours. My point is it was never yours; it was his.

I know it still hurts though. This is one of the reasons I advise never borrowing money from, or loaning it to, relatives. The best of intentions can end up in places like this. —Dave





injuries, The death, devastation, despair behind is incomprehensible to those of unable witness it in person. Damage estimates are at \$20 billion. Over 100,000 people have been displaced makeshift housing, shelters, or friend's couches and floors. And sadly, because most of these homes also were not in the traditional flood areas, they did not have flood insurance.

By day three on Sunday, the sickening waters began to recede. In the days that followed there was no time to mope. In an attempt to salvage as much of their homes as possible, they had to be completely emptied and gutted to the studs almost immediately to avoid the development of mold in the muggy Louisiana heat and mostly powerless homes. In many cases, seven-eight feet of water meant that even ceilings were soaked and had to be removed.

Along with thousands of other residents, Ginamarie, Lee, and Dane have been experiencing some incredible life lessons in recent weeks. Their days continue to consist of helping neighbors, friends, and even complete strangers move their beloved, sewagesoaked belongings, clothes, sofas, furniture, appliances, mattresses, soaked insulation and sheet-rock to the curb, where it all may remain for months.

In spite of such an unexpected tragedy, the community in and around Baton Rouge has come together in ways no one thought imaginable six







The bankhar returns to an age-old job with a new twist

Their goal? To not only protect the goats, sheep, horses, camels and yaks belonging to Mongolia's nomadic herders, but also to protect endangered snow leopards and other predators such as wolves and bears from being shot, trapped or poisoned for killing livestock. By warding off predators and forcing them to seek wild prey, the bankhar performs double duty as a protection dog, saving lives on both sides.

"More often than not, the physical presence of the dog would be enough of a deterrent to the predator," says Greg Goodfellow, project scientist for the Mongolian Bankhar Dog Project. "Predators might just view the cost/benefit ratio as not significant enough and just move on."

The MBDP is a nongovernmental environmental conservation organization founded in 2011 by Bruce Elfstrom, a biologist by training and CEO of a company that does frequent business in Mongolia. It seeks to bring back the historic use of the dogs as livestock guardians. The practice faded away in the mid-20th century when the government sought to introduce more modern methods of livestock care.

Elfstrom was familiar with the use of livestock guardian dogs in other countries

and wondered why they weren't being used in Mongolia, where predator-livestock interactions were a problem. When he discovered that some people in remote areas still kept dogs for that purpose, he became interested in learning more about them.

Bankhars go way back in Mongolia. When I asked wildlife ecologist and MBDP national project coordinator Batbataar Tumurbataar how long the bankhar has existed, he said, "It's the first dog, which means 15,000 years."

"Is that what the stories say?" I asked. "It's what DNA says," he replied.

Although there's no way of knowing what early dogs looked like or when bankhars took the form they have today, DNA indeed shows that bankhars, along with other Central Asian dogs such as Tibetan mastiffs, have much more genetic diversity than dogs elsewhere, says Adam Boyko, Ph.D., a geneticist at Cornell University who is studying the evolution and genetics of village dogs around the world.

"It is consistent with these being ancient groups of dogs" he says

groups of dogs," he says.

Bankhar are big and athletic, giving the impression that they can move quickly if the need arises. They don't typically bark unless provoked, but when they do, it sends a menacing message. Bankhar have a playful, curious side as well, Goodfellow says, and can be clever escape artists from their kennels at the training facility near Mongolia's Hustai National Park.

Their job is to stay with livestock 24/7, whether they are in pastures or barns. They are fed and watered with the animals they guard to ensure that they don't have any

need to leave their charges. That's a key part of training them to stay with the flock, Goodfellow says.

Since the winter of 2014, approximately 19 puppies have been placed with herders in the Hustai area as well as in the South Gobi desert and near Gorkhi Terelj National Park. The dogs don't typically show mature livestock guarding behavior until they are 2 to 3 years old, Goodfellow says. It's not yet known how their presence has affected predation on livestock.

"Ultimately, we want to compare predation rates pre- and post-bankhar placement and then translate that into economics," Goodfellow says. "Our hope is that by giving herders dogs that protect their livestock from predators, they won't feel the need to kill or trap predators."

· Is a goat in the running for your new best friend? A paper published recently in the journal Biology Letters found that like dogs — goats look to people for help when faced with a problem. Researchers at Queen Mary University of London School of Biological and Chemical Sciences trained goats to remove a lid from a box in exchange for a reward. Then they made the reward inaccessible and recorded the goats' reaction. If researchers were facing the goats, the animals would frequently look from the reward to the person and back again, making eye contact more often and for longer periods than if the person was facing away from them. "From our earlier research, we already know that goats are smarter than their reputation suggests, but these results show how they can communicate and interact with their human handlers even though they were not domesticated as pets or working animals," says lead author Alan McElligott.



Family Fire Emergency Plan

My son has a friend who is a Boy Scout, and he's been working on a merit badge called Emergency Preparedness. He was telling me about all of the badge requirements, and one of them in particular stuck in my mind as something that everyone should be reminded of. He had to sit down with his family and create an Emergency Plan in case of fire or other emergency situation in the home. This is something that my wife and I did with our children when they were young, and it is something that all families should make a priority. It doesn't have to be a huge production. It takes just a few minutes, yet gives peace of mind and could save the lives of the people you love. If you're not sure how to get started, the National Fire Protection Association suggests the following steps:

 Walk through the house together as a family (EVERYONE), pointing out and discussing all possible escape routes. Also note the location of all smoke alarms. Smoke alarms should be inside, as well as directly outside of, every sleeping area and on each level of a multi-level home.

• Everyone must understand the plan, and as you walk through, check to make sure that each exit or escape route is clear and easily operable. If your home's doors or windows have security bars, make sure that they have emergency releases.

Making a drawing of your plan is a great idea.

• Choose a safe outside meeting space. You might consider a light post, mailbox, neighbor's house, or other location that is a safe distance from the home. Note the meeting spot on your drawing.

• Make sure that your street number is clearly visible

from the road, so that emergency personnel can find you. If it isn't, remedy that as soon as possible.

• If there are infants, older adults, or family members who might need assistance, assign someone to assist them. Also assign a backup person in case that person is away from home during the emergency.

• Remind everyone not to try to gather up any possessions on the way out, and that once they're out of the house, they must stay out. Practice your plan, but be careful to present it calmly rather than frantically, which could scare your children.

A fire could happen any time, to anyone. Being prepared could mean the difference in loss of property and loss of life. -mr





This birth was so has creamy white skin and different. Now I am comparing births, not babies. Our second grandbaby's birth was so different than the first. As some of you might recall our first grandchild's birth was traumatic. She was 'very sick", as the doctor had said. I had wondered what she would look like. Our son, Randall, is a handsome young man, who has medium brown skin. He looks like a Turner. His beautiful wife, Brianna,

She looked like a Turner. And as usual with our children, she had a head full of hair. It was slick and black. Her skin was the color of the inside of my hand rather than the outside of my hand. When our daughter held her niece for the first time, she looked at me and said, "Mom, she's a white Randall!" My thought was, "How can God do that?" How can He take two people who look so different and make one person who looks like both of them? How can He do that over and over again and nobody look exactly like anybody else and yet we all look like somebody? How can Mica look like Randall and Brianna? God is amazing. And how can it be that Mica acts like her parents already? Peaceful and calm. She's amazing.

Aren't we all? Whether babies come how they are planned or when are planned, they are a blessing. Whether their birth is traumatic or tranquil, or in the midst of physical or spiritual upheaval, the end result is a Godsend. Fearfully and wonderfully madé. God produced and God presented for our pleasure and for His glory. We have grown in both these births and both our grandbabies have caused us to seek God and to thank Him.




