# Four added to JCJC Sports Hall of Fame

Four people will be enshrined into the Jones County Junior College Sports Hall of

Fame on Sept. 1. Former football and baseball player David Hopper, former football player and track participant Ray Ishee, historian Cecil R. "Boots" Jordan and the school's first Sports Information Director, Rebecca Ratcliff Patrick, comprise the Class of 2016. There will be a banquet at the Ronald E. Whitehead Advanced Technology Center at 5 p.m. prior to the Sept. 1 home football game vs. East Mississippi in honor of the inductees and they will all be recognized during halftime of the game. Kickoff for the game will be at 7 p.m. There are now 41 members in

the JCJC Sports Hall of Fame.

Patrick began her employment at JCJC in 1983 as school president Dr. Terrell Tisdale's secretary.

Patrick became the school's first SID at JCJC in 1984. She held that position for two years until those responsibilities merged with those of the Public Relations Director, a position she held from 1987-97.

She established media guides for football, basketball and baseball

and Media Days for the same sports. Four of those football guides were named No. 1 in the nation by the NJCAA, as well as two of the basketball press guides.

Patrick compiled records for the Bobcat football teams from 1927-97 and sent statistical information and game stories to all NJCAA voting members on a weekly basis.

Watkins High School in Laurel, also served as the basketball scorekeeper for 10 years, the baseball scorekeeper for six years and kept football statistics from 1984-94. In 1995, Patrick coordinated publicity and many activities for the 40th reunion of the 1955 Junior Rose Bowl team that gained national attention because African-American members of the Compton College (California) team JCJC played in the game were invited by a person outside the college to attend the reunion.

The 1955 JCJC team broke the racial barriers of the time by becoming the first Mississippi athletic team to play an integrated team.

Patrick attended JCJC from 1976-78 and worked with all of the sports teams as their statistician. She served as Sports Editor and Executive Editor of the school's student newspaper, The Radionian.

She covered the 1977 Junior Rose Bowl in Pasadena, California, and the 1978 Region 7 Men's Basketball Tournament in Tennessee, which was the first time a JCJC basketball team participated in a region

She was a member of the Maroon Typhoon Marching Band, marching at halftime and keeping statistics during the game.

After JCJC, she attended the University of Southern Mississippi where she was Sports Editor of the USM Student Printz newspaper during her first semester and was hired during her second semester by the Hattiesburg American to write sports. She was one of only two female sportswriters at a major daily newspaper in Mississippi at

Patrick was the announcer/scorekeeper/ scoreboard operator for Laurel-Jones County Dixie Majors baseball from 1977-83 and served as secretary/treasurer for Ellisville

She is a lifetime member of the JCJC

Alumni Association and, along with he brothers Wilroy and Bruce, has endowed a scholarship at Jones in honor of her parents.


She is married to Howard Patrick and they have a son, Rease, and a daughter-inlaw, Danyelle.

won the Best Defense Award, was named Honorable Mention All-American and was selected by the Jackson Touchdown Club as Best Senior Athlete in 1969. He coached at Cleveland High School from 1971-75, Greenwood High School from 1975-78 and was defensive line coach at Delta State in 1978-79.

Ishee went to Copiah-Lincoln as defensive coordinator in 1979 and was named head football coach and athletic director in 1985.


In five seasons as head coach of the Wolfpack, Ishee led the team to a 37-17-1 record. Co-Lin made the playoffs four times in five years under Ishee's leadership, winning South Division titles in 1986 and 1989 and both the MACJC championship and East Bowl in 1985.

He also served as track coach and led Co-Lin to the state and NJCAA Region 23 title in 1987. Ishee retired as head football coach and became Dean of Students at Co-Lin in 1990, a position he held until 2001. He became principal and head football coach at Brookhaven Academy in 2001 and served as head coach at BA until 2006. He now works for the Gatlin Corporation in Brookhaven. Ishee was named to the NJ-CAA Hall of Fame in 1995, the Co-Lin Hall of Fame in 2009 and the Delta State Hall of Fame in 2013.

He is a member of Wesson Baptist Church and is a member of the Copiah County Economic Development Authority. He is married to the former Rhonda Wilson of Brookhaven. They have two children, Brad Ishee and wife, Linda, of Madison and Marci Kristen Ishee of Knoxville, Tennessee; and two grandchildren, Braden and Bryce Ishee of Madison.

#### **David Hopper**

Hopper attended JCJC from 1982-84 and was a standout football and baseball player. Hopper was a quarterback and punter for the Bobcats in 1982 and 1983. He led

# Hite excited about first Don't forget the beauty of grass

If you are searching for the prettiest, absolutely no-effort plant for the home garden, my pick is grass! Really!

Check out ornamental grasses for your landscape . . . just plant them and enjoy the show.

We have mully grass, which will start putting on a purple show in a few

weeks; dwarf miscanthus, great for screening those unsightly but necessary utility boxes and meters; and striped zebra grass, which is lovely when the wind ruffles the tall blades. You should be able to locate grasses in many different heights, colors and textures. There are variegated varieties that are perfect in containers. Check the labels, some of these get really big!

The grasses I've selected are winter hardy; we cut them almost to the ground in January, and they come back pretty as ever in early spring. The following suggestions may come in handy as you plan your fall containers and hanging baskets:

\*Larger baskets give roots room to spread and command attention, or try several small baskets to screen a view;

\*Choose a growing medium made specifically for use in containers;

\*Select plants suitable for the light conditions where the basket will hang. I like baskets with fiber liners – reduce water loss by covering the porous material with a layer of plastic before adding soil, or buy cheap saucers to place in the bottom of your pots. Coffee filters also work well to hold soil in

\*Baskets located in the sun may need water once or twice daily. Baskets in the shade require less. Using a watering wand for containers makes it less of a chore;

\*If you mix slow-release fertilizer into the soil at planting, you won't need to add more fertilizer. Or you can use liquid fertilizer mixed to half strength every other week to increase flowering;

\*Remove spent blooms (deadhead) to encourage flowering. It's not too late to cut your leggy plants back by one-third. Mums should be planted now for September bloom and color; remember to feed every two weeks and water thoroughly until buds show color. (I place nursery pots of mums into decorative pots or baskets and throw them away after they finish blooming.)

Several years ago we built a lovely pergola in the backyard, using rough-cut cedar that we bought at a local sawmill. Of course, it needed landscaping in a hurry. We planted evergreen wisteria at two corners for long term impact. The wisteria now covers entire top of pergola, providing shade and fragrant flowers all summer long.

We have since planted cross vine on the other two corner supports. These prolific growers put on a beautiful show of bright orange flowers in spring and occasionally during the summer have bloomed for us.

We decided to connect the climbing plants with small flowerbeds on two sides. Since my plant budget was shot way back in June, I relocated iris to the new beds and pinched off runners of sweet potato vine and coleus to fill out the new beds. I am here to report that the beds are almost covered with the "found" plants. Yeah!!!

It looks like we may be in for a hot, dry September. Remember to water the dear plants that have provided such beauty all summer. Hey, we didn't need to water in July and August!

# **Sideline View: Looks** like Dak is next up for the Dallas Cowboys

Week one in the National Football League could be

another big weekend for football fans in the state of Mississippi. Dallas Cowboys starting quarterback Tony Romo broke a bone in his back last week in Seattle. Romo's injury could lead to a Rebel vs. Bulldog battle at quarterback in the season's first week. If Romo is not ready to go, Dak



Prescott will most likely get the start against the G-men. The former Mississippi State quarterback has completed almost 80 percent of his passes in three preseason games for five touchdowns and no interceptions. Prescott could | face off against former Ole Miss Rebel Eli Manning in that opening game. So the lines have been drawn in the state of Mississippi for this game on September 11.

#### **SEC Quarterback Questions Linger**

Only Ole Miss quarterback Chad Kelly, LSU's Brandon Harris, Georgia's Grayson Lambert and Tennessee's Josh Dobbs return as starters in the opening week of the SEC. Texas A&M has transfer Trevor Knight from Oklahoma, but the other nine schools are having to go with inexperienced signal callers. The SEC is not really known as a quarterback league as the league has had only three quarterbacks drafted in the first round of the NFL since 2010. Two of those were Johnny Manziel and Tim Tebow. Mississippi State head coach Dan Mullen will try to replace fourth-round pick Dak Prescott with either junior Damian Williams, sophomore Nick Fitzgerald or freshman Nick Tiano. National champion Alabama will have Cooper Bateman (one career start) or either David Cornwell or Blake Barnett.

Tide coach Nick Saban believes the quarterback must win the team over. It seems to work in Title Town. Florida will go with a former Alabama walk-on in Luke Del Rio. He is the son of Jack Del Rio, who is head coach of the Oakland Raiders. He is a former Saints player and assistant coach. Auburn might turn to Florida and East Mississippi CC transfer John Franklin as their starting QB, although Sean White, a returning QB, seems to have the inside track for the War Eagles. You could do like Arkansas and just call up another Allen. This year junior Austin Allen will replace his brother Brandon. Brandon led the Razorbacks' high-powered offense for the last three years. And then a seventh string quarterback (Brett Favre) could rise to the top and surprise us all.

The new scoreboard will be twice the size of the current scoreboard. Mississippi State baseball coach John Cohen was recently awarded a four-year contract extension, which takes him through the 2020 season. Cohen led the Bulldogs to the SEC regular season championship.

This comes from Yahoo Sports. Billy Hamilton of Taylorsville made one of the most awesome catches this past week. The Cincinnati Reds centerfielder made a Ken Griffey type catch. Some say he should be awarded a gold medal for his efforts. Texas Ranger DH Carlos Beltran hit a ball to left-center that seemed like it was heading for the wall. Billy sprinted 123 feet and dove head-first into the wall to make the catch. Everyone in attendance at the game in Arlington was stunned. He traveled 22 mph, according to Statcast. Gold Medal champion Usain Bolt had been recorded at 27.8 mph at the Rio games, so Billy is almost in his league.







the team to an 8-3 record and a playoff appearance in 1982. In 1983, he guided the team to the MACJC championship, an East Bowl victory and an 11-2 record and a No.4 national ranking. He was All-MACJC, the Most Valuable Back in the South Division, was named to the All-Star team and was an Honorable Mention All-American. He was also elected a permanent captain of the 1983 team. Hopper was involved in one of the most famous plays in JCJC history.

The Bobcats were playing East Central in 1983 in the ninth game of the season at Bush-Young Stadium. The winner would advance to the playoffs. East Central led 20-19 with 30 seconds left and JCJC had the ball at its own 20-yard line. With one second left, the Bobcats had the ball at their own 48-yard line. On the game's final play, Hopper dropped back to pass, could not find an open receiver and began to run. He made it all the way to the end zone for a touchdown and JCJC won the game, 25-20. He also played centerfield for the baseball team at Jones and was named All-MACJC, All-Region 23 and played in the All-Star Game.

Hopper went to Mississippi College after leaving JCJC and played football and baseball. He was the quarterback and punter and helped the Choctaws to a 13-4-2 record. He was a leftfielder for the MC baseball team. Hopper later received his master's degree in administration from William Carey University. He has been a teacher and coach for the past 30 years in the area. He was the 1992 WDAM Coach of the Year at Perry Central. He was the Laurel Leader-Call 2004 District 4-4A Coach of the Year at South Jones. He also coached at West Jones and Petal. Over the years, he has served as a head coach in football, track, golf and soccer. From 2002-11, he was a volunteer Dixie Youth Baseball coach. Hopper is a member of the JCJC Alumni Association. He and his wife, Sonja, have two children: daughter, Nichole Bell and husband, Preston; and son, Samuel.

#### Cecil R. "Boots" Jordan

Jordan was a longtime supporter of JCJC. He, along with former head coach and Hall of Famer Parker Dykes, wrote four books on JCJC football, including "A History of Bob-


cat Football at Jones County Junior College," "A Supplement to the History of Bobcat Football at JCJC," "The Final Chapter" and "Twentieth Century Football at JCJC." Jordan also published other sports history books about Jones, including "Twentieth Century Lady Bobcat Basketball at Jones County

Junior College," "Twentieth Century Bobcat Basketball at Jones County Junior College" and "The History of Jones County Junior College Baseball."

In addition to the books on athletics, Jordan also wrote a family history book and a book entitled "Ellisville in the Roaring '20s and the Terrible '30s." Jordan served four years in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. His outfit was involved in the "Battle of the Bulge" and he received the Battle Star. After the war, Jordan returned home and received his associates degree from JCJC and a bachelors degree from Southern Miss. He began his teaching career at Kosciusko High School. He became principal at Long Beach High School and then went to Rolling Fork High School where he was a teacher and coached baseball and track and was an assistant football coach. Jordan earned his masters degree during this time and eventually returned to Ellisville High School where he taught Science, was head track coach and assistant football coach. In 1963, Jordan became head football coach and continued as track coach.

In 1965, schools were consolidated in Jones County and Jordan was assigned to South Jones High School as a science teacher, assistant football coach and track coach.

In 1968, he became principal at South Jones and remained there until his retirement in 1981. Jordan was a faithful member of Ellisville United Methodist Church. He was also an ardent Southern Miss fan. Jordan died Oct. 26, 2005, at the age of 87. He was preceded in death by his wife,

# JCJC OL coach Garner excited about coaching in the MACJC

#### Local high school stars to play role on OL for Bobcats

Grant Garner is making his first venture into junior college football. But the firstyear Jones County Junior College offensive line coach is impressed with what he has seen so far of the MACJC.

"I really don't know much about the JUCO league," said Garner, who was an All-Big 12 performer at center for Oklahoma State University. "All I've seen is game tape, but it's a really competitive league. We have some really good players and I'm excited about getting into it. It's nice to have no bye weeks, which is great as far as having a routine. But I love it and I think it's fantastic. This Mississippi JUCO league is just a well-kept secret."

JCJC head coach Steve Buckley hired Garner away from Southern Methodist University, where he was an offensive line graduate assistant coach in 2015. Prior to that, Garner was at Southern Miss for two seasons working with the offensive line. The Bobcats only have one returning offensive lineman from the 2015 team – guard Josh Newcomb. Tackle Khadedryck Todd was on the team two years ago and guard Jemar Nunley redshirted last season. Even though it's pretty much an entirely new unit in 2016, Garner likes the makeup of the group.

"I think we feel really good about our starting five," he said. "I feel good about those guys individually and as a unit. We've had some troubles with snaps and that's something we have to get cleaned up and we will. Our 'twos' know they have a challenge. If somebody gets hurt, who will step up? Everyone has their pluses and minuses; it's just who wants it the most? We just have to find that next guy."

Leading the way at left tackle is sophomore Kelby Wickline (6-5, 276). Wickline is a transfer from Texas-San Antonio. "Kelby will be our starting left tackle," Garner said. "He is a heckuva player. I have been very impressed with what he has done. He is a 'Power 5' type of guy and we are lucky to have him here. He has great feet, he has worked really hard and I can't say enough good things about him on and off the field."

Newcomb (5-11, 273) is a sophomore from West Jones and is the starting left guard. "Josh has been bouncing around between center and guard," Garner said.

"He has done a really good job at guard of making all the calls. You can trust him to block who he is supposed to block. He is all bought in and he has done everything we have asked. I can't say enough good things about Josh and the leadership he brings. You can tell it's important to him."

At center will be Prentiss freshman Andrew Smith (6-1, 266). "Andrew has great feet and a good low base of gravity," Garner said. "He is powerful and has a great first step. You can tell he loves football and he can be a really good player for us. He just needs to learn the nuances of line play – when to be aggressive and when not to be aggressive."

Leading the way at right guard is Oak Grove freshman Nick Vines (6-4, 316). "Nick has been a huge surprise for us," Garner said. "He is big, powerful and has done a heckuva job for us. He has good feet, plays with good technique, is smart and has a great personality. I've been very, very pleased with him. Maybe the one thing he can improve on is his outside zone play. But as far as double teams, he is what you want. He does a great job and you can rely on him in the passing game as well."

Todd (6-3, 291) is a sophomore from Hattiesburg and gets the nod at right tackle. Laurel freshman Malik Cooley (6-4, 288) is behind Wickline at left tackle. "Malik has done a really nice job of picking things up," Garner said. "He is getting better everyday and we just need him to learn a sense of urgency as far as coming off the ball. Once he puts it all together, I think is going to be a good player."

Nunley (6-3, 301) is a redshirt freshman from Lake and backs up Newcomb at left guard. "Jemar has all of the physical tools," Garner said. "He just has not been able to quite put it all together. But everyday there is no doubt he has gotten better. He just needs to come along with his physicality and keep progressing. But if that light switches on for him, he can be a heckuva player for us."

Forest Hill freshman Melvin Hollins (5-11, 345) is at center behind Smith. "Melvin is overweight right now and he knows it and we know it," Garner said. "Physically, he is not able to do some things he needs to do right now. He has a good attitude and he works hard. Once he loses the weight, he will be a good player for us."

Vancleave freshman Calton Bakker (6-3, 294) is seeing action as a backup to Vines at right guard. "To his credit, I've moved Cal around a lot," Garner said. "He has not really found a home yet, due to injury and getting other guys reps and things like that. He has done everything I've asked him to do and he goes full speed."

Behind Todd at right tackle is Madison Central freshman Dylan Desper (6-4, 268). "Dylan has done a really nice job," Garner said. "He is kind of that next guy to go in there if something were to happen. I've been very pleased with him. He just needs to work on his flexibility - he 's a little stiff. But he's got good feet, is athletic and is still kind of learning the position. I think he actually played a little receiver in high school, so I hope he keeps coming and progressing. I feel good about Dylan."

Desper's older brother, Devon Desper, is a starting guard at Mississippi State Uni-

Garner is thrilled to be at JCJC and is optimistic about the season. "I have loved every minute of it," he said. "I've really enjoyed it. I feel so blessed and lucky and thankful to be here.
