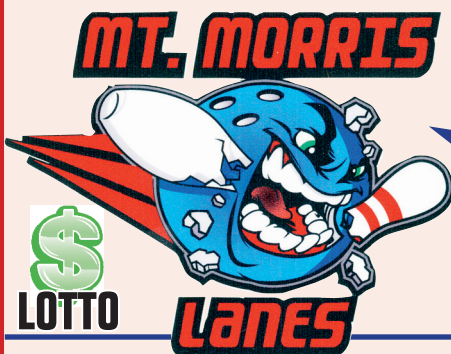

Big Ben's Silent Minute



The story begins after Saturday mass at Our Lady of Mercy Roman Catholic Church in Leroy, New York. Diana Lapp had read a book about WWII in Europe that documented London's Big Ben's 'daily minute' to call all of Europe to attention at 9:00 o'clock each evening during the war. This minute consisted of sixty seconds of silence, reflection and prayer beseeching God to grant England victory over Germany. The request was answered. Germany was defeated. God had heard the cries of His people.

Diana Lapp and Joe Mathis of Leroy were so inspired by this 1940s story of faith and devotion that the two Leroy natives wanted to resurrect the "Silent Minute" of the Second World War. They saw clear parallels between the hardships of Britain at war and the problems facing 2016 America. They acknowledged that we are at a tough crossroad in America: morality has declined, disrespect for others runs rampant, religious beliefs and values are no longer woven into the American tapestry. Joe Mathis and Diana Lapp yearn to see a return to a God-centered society.

They began by giving their pastor an insert explaining Big Ben's "Silent Minute." Leroy's Protestant Churches were presented with silent minute information. A Baptist minister devoted a homily to the silent minute. Living Waters Church took the message and is building a website. The concept spread to Batavia churches; the [Batavia Pennysaver](http://BataviaPennysaver.com) published a silent minute article.

The publicity encouraged each home to take one minute at nine each evening to pray, in this crucial election year, for the future of our country. Mr. Mathis sees himself as a member of the "Silent Majority" of Americans who believe in God, family and traditional values.

It has been estimated that the 'silent minute' has reached 500,000 people through the written word, facebook, nuns, clergy and lay people. Many citizens are supporting this vital and much-needed sixty seconds of peaceful contemplation.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Part 2 – Different Types of Fire Extinguishers

From fireextinguishers101.com

There are 5 primary types (or Classes) of fire extinguishers, each designed to put out different kinds of fires.

Type A: for use on ordinary materials like cloth, wood and paper
Type B: for use with combustible and flammable liquids like grease, gasoline, oil & oil-based paints.

Type C: for use with electrical equipment like appliances, tools, or other equipment that is plugged in.

The above 3 types are most common and may be found in most homes and businesses

Type D: for use with flammable metals- often found in factories

Type K: for use with vegetable oils, animal oils, & fats in cooking appliances-often found in commercial kitchens (restaurants, catering businesses, cafeterias)

There are also multipurpose fire extinguishers that may be labeled "B-C" or "A-B-C". Most home improvement stores carry multipurpose fire extinguishers that cover Class A through Class C. Fire extinguishers are helpful for immediate use on small fires. However before you decide to use a fire extinguisher, a few questions must be answered

- Have I alerted others in the building that there is a fire?
- Has someone called the fire department?
- Am I physically able to use the fire extinguisher?
- Is the fire small and contained in a single object (like a pan or a wastebasket)?
- Am I safe from the fire's toxic smoke?
- Do I have a clear escape route?

Use a fire extinguisher when all of these questions have been answered "yes". If you're not sure about whether or not it's safe to use the fire extinguisher, and for all other situations, alert others, leave the building and call 911 from a mobile or neighbor's phone. It is not recommended that children use fire extinguishers.
