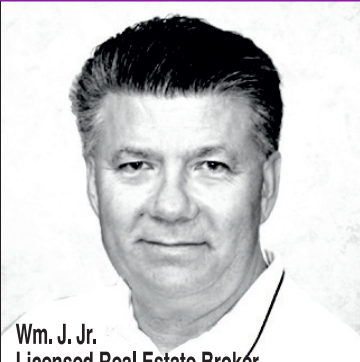

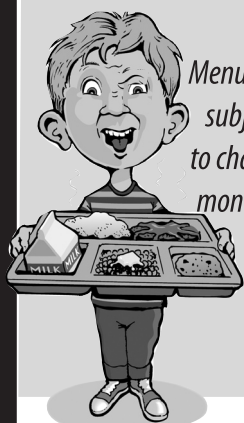

DRIVERS

Please be aware that school is back in session and keep your eyes open for children crossing the street. Remember, when a stopped school bus flashes its red light(s), traffic that approaches from either direction, even in front of the school and in school parking lots, must stop before it reaches the bus. You should stop at least 20 feet away from the bus. Before a school bus stops to load or discharge passengers, the driver will usually flash yellow warning lights. When you see them, decrease speed and be prepared to stop. When you stop for a school bus, you cannot drive again until the red lights stop flashing or when the bus driver or a traffic officer signals that you can proceed. This law applies on all roadways in New York State. You must stop for a school bus even if it is on the opposite side of a divided highway. After you stop for a school bus, look for children along the side of the road. Drive slowly until you have passed them. Remember that vehicles that transport people with disabilities can be equipped as school buses and you must stop for them as you would for other school buses. Wishing all our students and staff at MMCS and all area schools a safe, productive and awesome school year!!

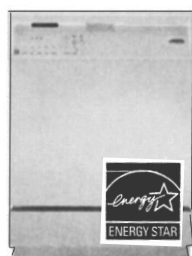

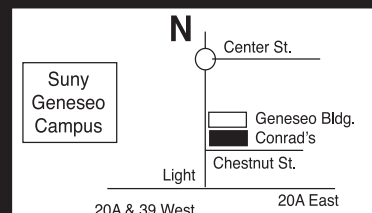

When using a fire extinguisher, remember the word PASS.

Pull the pin. Hold the extinguisher with the nozzle pointing away from you and release the locking mechanism.

Aim low. Point the extinguisher nozzle at the base of the fire.

Squeeze the lever slowly and easily.

Sweep the nozzle from side to side.

Check your fire extinguishers for:

Easy access in an emergency: Be sure nothing is blocking or limiting your ability to reach it.

Recommended pressure level: many extinguishers have gauges that show when pressure is too high or too low.



Working parts: Make sure the can, hose, & nozzle aren't damaged, dented or rusted.
Cleanliness: Remove any dust, oil, or grease that may be on the outside of the extinguisher.

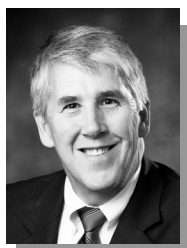
Guidelines and instructions: Some extinguishers need to be shaken monthly, others need to be pressure tested every few years.
