Mystery Box

Q. I purchased a round tin container at a farm auction several years ago and wonder about its original purpose. It was sold with kitchen items. The lid is stamped with images of wheat and appears to be quite old. What do you think? — *Audrey, Victorville, California*

A. This is just a guess, but I suspect you have a biscuit or cookie tin. During the Victorian era — especially in farm houses — there were often rodents, and tin containers were used to keep baked goods fresh and prevent the contents from being contaminated by pests, including both mice and insects. I make this assumption since it was sold at a farm auction with kitchen items.

Q. I have about 75 pieces of sheet music from the World War II-era. My aunt used to sing with the Perry Como and Lawrence Welk orchestras, and the music is part of her collection. — *Sandra, Port Orange, Florida*

A. Most sheet music from the 1940s seems to be priced in the \$2 to \$5 range, but there are always exceptions. For example, sheet music featuring film personalities such as Betty Grable, Alice Faye and Frank Sinatra are popular with collectors. As you might imagine, prices vary. Early pieces of ragtime, Black Americana and jazz compositions are among the most valuable. Wayland Bunnell is a

sheet music expert and appraiser. Contact is c/o Clean Sheets, 199 Tarrytown Rd., Manchester, New Hampshire 03103.

Q. I have a Smith Corona Super Sterling typewriter that is about 30 years old. Where can I find a ribbon for it? — *Earl, Livingston, Tennessee*

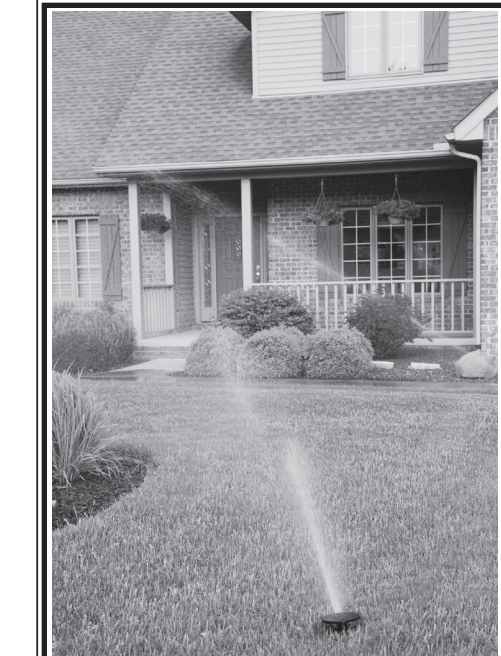

HOLLYWOOD — Bradley Cooper is prepping a reboot of the **Janet Gaynor** (1937), **Judy Garland** (1954) and **Barbra Streisand** (1976) starrer "A Star Is Born," this time with **Lady GaGa**. **Clint Eastwood** was trying to get **Beyonce** to step into the role, but her schedule didn't work for the film. Cooper executive-produced his films "Limitless" (2011), which cost \$27 million and grossed \$162 million; "The Words" (2012), \$6 million cost/\$13 million gross; "Silver Linings Playbook" (2012), \$21 million cost/\$234 million gross; "American Sniper," (\$59 million cost/\$547 million gross) and the recent "War Dogs," with **Jonah Hill** and **Miles Teller**.

In addition to starring as the fading rock star opposite GaGa, Cooper also intends to make this his directorial debut. All three versions of "A Star Is Born" made a profit, especially Streisand's, which cost \$6 million and made \$80 million. Decorator's Notebook
 For Kitchens And Baths, Stone Really Rocks

(NAPS)—Homeowners thinking about creating or remodeling their indoor or outdoor spaces may want to consider these ideas from noted interior designer Courtney Babineaux.
 Don't be afraid to take some risks. While your space needs to be a combination of both form and function, it also needs to speak to who you are. Babineaux recommends filling it with things you love, that represent your travels and interests, and make it a place that you can't wait to get home to.

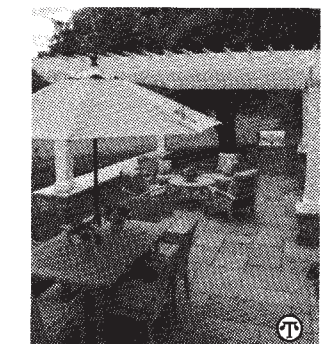

She also recommends using natural stone wherever possible. Whether interior or exterior, anytime you can use a natural material within a space, you're giving a feeling of authenticity and uniqueness, very much like a fine piece of art. The color variations and imperfections are not flaws, but rather unique touches that make your space an original.
 When designing an interior space, all the elements within that room—natural stone, furnishings, paint, fabrics—should have a harmonious feel in both style and color. Whenever possible, select a hue from the color variation of the stone and use that as an accent shade. For example, if there's a copper vein in the granite on your kitchen countertops, add accents such as a copper vent hood.

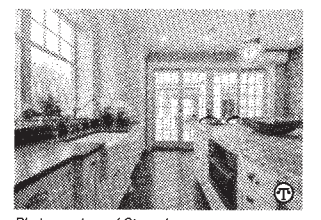

The stone should also work with the surrounding elements. For example, an exotic granite countertop typically has a lot of color variation, so you may want something more subtle on the floor. By the same token, the colors should be harmonious. For example, you may want to pair a dark gray or dark green-colored soapstone countertop with a lighter-hued travertine.
 Today's color trends of grays and "greige" are still going strong, and light-colored stone countertops coordinate well with those shades. Lighter stones also pair well with darker cabinets for a high-contrast look and serve as a nice backdrop for the strategic use of color in fabrics and accessories.

For areas like media rooms, wet bars and powder rooms, where there's an opportunity to make a statement, you can take more of a style risk, such as backlit natural onyx.
 In home design today, Babineaux says, the exterior is often an extension of the interior. Outdoor living spaces are decorated to coordinate with the interior color palette, and the same materials used in the kitchen and family room areas are carried outdoors. When choosing natural stone for your exterior, you will want to consider materials that hold up to the exposure of natural elements like water, sunlight and freeze-thaw cycling. Consult with knowledgeable staff at your local stone yard about where and how the stone will be used to assist in making appropriate material choices.



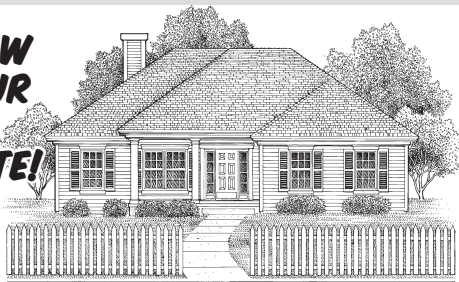

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

• On Sept. 22, 1598, famed playwright Ben Jonson is indicted for manslaughter after a duel. His ability to read and write saved him, and he claimed "benefit of clergy," which allowed him to be sentenced by the lenient ecclesiastical courts.

• On Sept. 25, 1789, the first Congress of the United States approves 12 (of an original 17) amendments to the U.S. Constitution. Only 10, known as the Bill of Rights, were initially ratified by the states.

• On Sept. 21, 1866, H.G. Wells pioneer of science fiction, is born in Bromley, England. Wells worked as a draper's apprentice and bookkeeper before becoming a freelance writer. In 1895, he published "The Time Machine," about a man who journeyed to the future.

• On Sept. 20, 1973, in a highly publicized "Battle of the Sexes" tennis match, top women's player Billie Jean King, 30, beats 55-year-old Bob by Riggs, former No. 1 ranked men's player, 6-4, 6-3, 6-3. Riggs had boasted that women were inferior.

Fashionable Flooring

The Floors Of Tomorrow Will Reflect What's On The Runway Today

(NAPS)—When you walk into a room, your eyes do not move from top to bottom—quite the opposite. Your gaze starts at the floor and moves up. Just as the clothes you wear make a fashion statement, your floors set the tone, add the drama and create the mood in your home.

According to the World Floor Covering Association (WFCA), the latest products and trends in flooring offer high-tech innovations, low-maintenance attributes and eco-friendly features. Below, you'll find a closer look at some of the latest styles to consider when it's time to dress your floors:

Weathered and Worn

Aged and vintage looks have maintained their firm grip when it comes to floor trends. Think genuine hardwood with worn, heavily textured wood grain and the weathered imperfections that can only be achieved with years of use. For many, price has kept these highly sought floors out of reach—until now.

Manufacturers today are building the patina of reclaimed wood into brand-new flooring products. Solid and engineered hardwood formats can have all the distressed and eroded character of products much older so each board has a unique look.

The same vintage looks are available in laminate and luxury vinyl tile (LVT). The surfaces are created using high-resolution digital imaging and state-of-the-art embossing techniques. Designed to minimize repeats, they're almost impossible to tell from the real thing—and significantly less expensive!

Porcelain tiles feature salvaged looks such as oxidized metal and weathered wood. Tiles with dry, earthen textures and parched surface finishes in light to mid sun-baked shades and hazy grays are also popular.



When it comes to decor, the largest palette is right beneath your feet. Now, bold stripes, oversized florals and marine blues are hitting the floor in style.

The beauty of the weathered look is that it pairs well with all interiors, does a wonderful job of hiding blemishes, and works well with both soft and bold color accents.

Depth and Dimension

The right flooring can make large spaces cozy and small spaces grand with long, wide planks and tiles.

Longer wood planks and large format porcelain tiles mean fewer seams and grout lines, lengthening smaller spaces such as hallways and bathrooms as the eye is not distracted by breaks in the flooring. Fewer seams and less grout means easier cleaning, too.

Texture and Pattern

The latest looks in LVT involve nature-inspired low-luster and matte finishes.

Also in step with toned-down looks are oil-finish hardwood floors, which are steadily gaining ground among designers and consumers. Natural oils penetrate the wood grain for a satinlike, zero-gloss appearance. In soft-surface flooring, highly affordable synthetics offer a more delustered look that mimics more expensive natural materials including wool, silk and cotton. The matte surface also works to mask vacuum marks and footprints.

Concrete flooring offers soft and warm looks in muted grays, taupe and beige. Its versatility makes it complementary and adaptable to all kinds of interior settings.

Another trend is to mix contrasting materials such as wood and tile. Though not possible with the "real thing" due to wood's tendency to expand and contract, pairing wood and stone looks in porcelain creates a stunning effect.

Tiles made to look like bricks are also popular. The laid-back "loft look" in porcelain is much easier to maintain than the real thing. The most basic of shapes, the stripe, is also appearing in all categories of flooring, especially soft surface. It appears frequently in the form of striated rock looks in weaves; in porcelain and glass, as mini finger tiles; and in vinyl, in looks that mimic linen, sedimentary rock and parquet.

Carpet continues to get softer and more plush as technology advances. The latest look features layered color, soft texture and lots of dimension. Using another technique that combines both loops and sheared fibers, carpets are imbued with 3-D effects featuring multiple heights and colors ranging from subtle to bold.

Growing in popularity are carpets and rugs in florals and foliage looks in shades of indigo, petrol, purple and green. Other new carpets show sculpted surfaces that look like sand dunes, ocean waves and tree bark.

Modern Conveniences

Beauty is important in floor coverings, but function is also key. Over 70 percent of the population owns a pet, so one manufacturer offers a 100 percent "All Pet Warranty" on carpets with built-in stain repellent and total moisture absorption. New technology forces all the water from the stain to evaporate so the trace material left over can simply be wiped away.

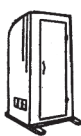

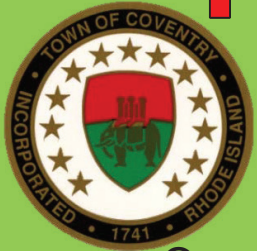

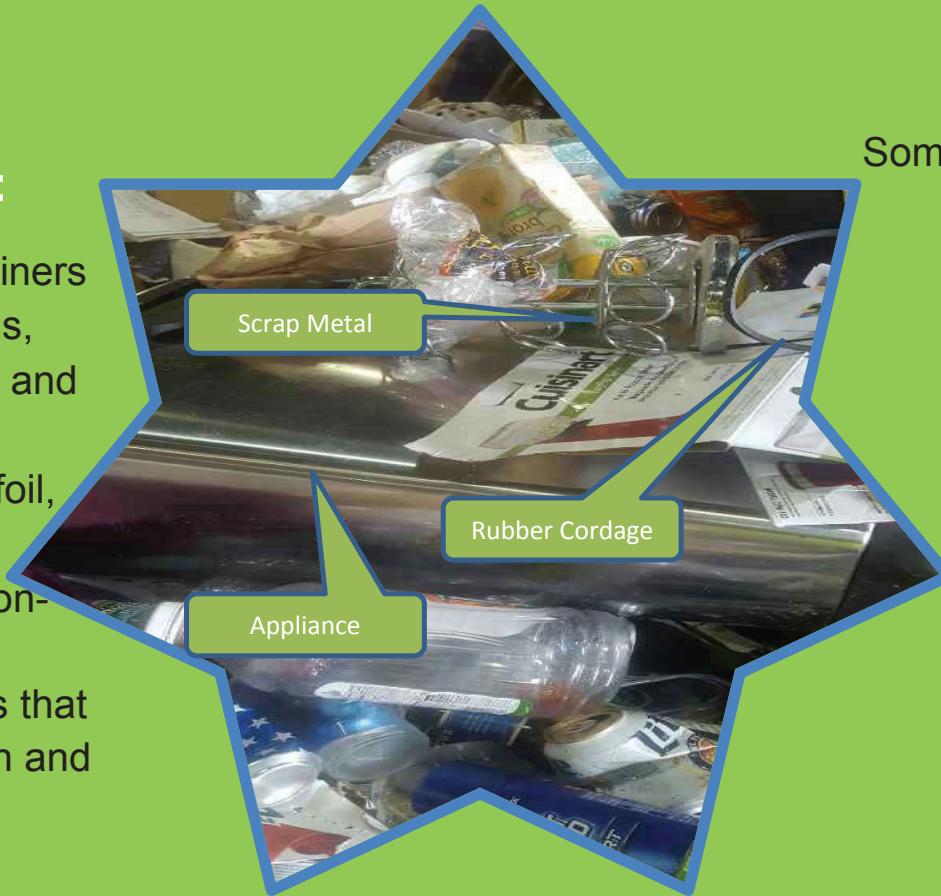


The State of Rhode Island requires all municipalities to recycle 35% of household waste.

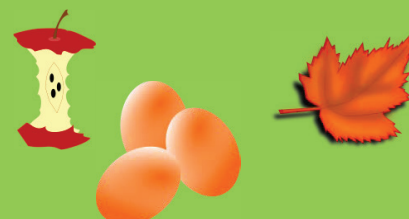

Be Car Care Aware

Five Steps Toward Better Battery Behavior

(NAPS)—Here's hot news about your car battery that may seem surprising: It's not so much the cold that gets it down as it is high heat.

Heat causes battery fluid to evaporate, thus damaging the internal structure of the battery. That's why it's a good idea to check your battery as the seasons change from hotter to cooler or if you've been driving in a hot part of the country.

Here's what else to do about your battery.

Battery Batters

Another reason for shortened battery life is overcharging. That is, a malfunctioning component in the charging system, usually the voltage regulator, can allow too high a charging rate, leading to slow death for a battery, explained Rich White, executive director, Car Care Council.

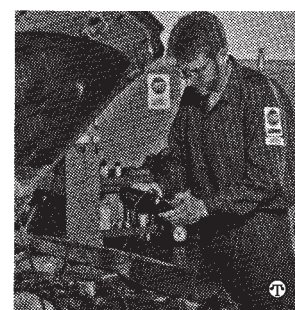
In addition, colder temperatures can increase the thickness of the engine oil, making the engine harder to turn over, causing the battery to have to work more. These factors lead to harder starting.

What You Can Do

To get the most life out of a battery, the Car Care Council suggests the following simple steps:

- Be sure the electrical system is charging at the correct rate; overcharging can damage a battery as quickly as undercharging.

- If your battery is the type that needs to be topped off, check it regularly. Add distilled water when necessary.



Don't let the weather get your car down. Check the battery when the seasons change.

- Always replace a battery with one that's rated at least as high as the one originally specified.

- Have the battery checked if you notice headlights and interior lights dim, accessories that fail to operate, or the "check engine" or battery light illuminated.

- Keep the top of the battery clean. Dirt becomes a conductor, which drains battery power. Further, as corrosion accumulates on battery terminals, it becomes an insulator, inhibiting current flow.

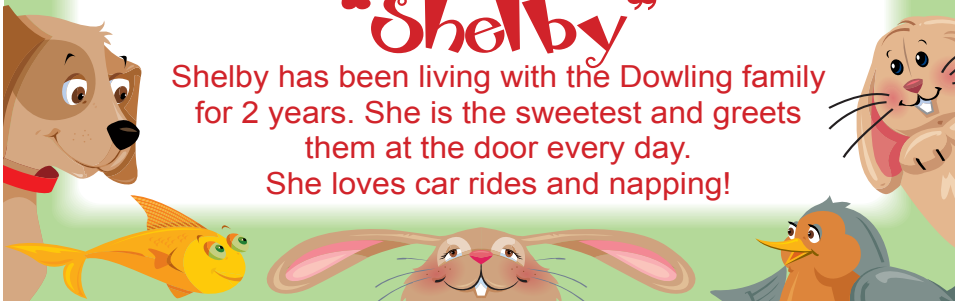

Stuffing Perks Up Bland Cuts of Meat

Here's an easy way to add flavor and flair to a boneless, skinless chicken breast: stuff it! Flavor-boosters like chopped, sauteed vegetables, herbs, cheeses or spices can turn a lean, bland cut of meat from pork to beef into something special.

During the Roman Empire, recipes for stuffing chicken, rabbit, pork and dormouse were common. Stuffing in the Middle Ages was known as "farce," from the Latin "farciare" (and the French "farcir") meaning "to stuff." In the 13th century, lighthearted French farcirs or farce plays were "stuffed" in between lengthy religious productions to keep the audience from being bored. "Forcemeat" and "farce" also were common terms referring to a spiced, chopped meat mixture, still in use when referring to sausage.

In 1538, the word "stuffing" first appeared in English print, but this uninspired term did not appeal to the Victorian upper class. After 1880, "stuffing" also became known as "dressing." Today, "stuffing" is the term most often used in the South and Eastern parts of the United States. Stuffing,

or dressing, is a seasoned mix of vegetables, starches and eggs that are cooked within the body cavity of an animal. Vegetables also are hollowed out and stuffed. When it's served as a side dish during the Thanksgiving holiday, stuffing often is referred to as dressing.

My recipe for Roasted Red Pepper Stuffed Chicken Breasts uses a savory blend of bell peppers, herbs, spices, cheeses and lemon to add a burst of flavor to lean chicken breast.

ROASTED RED PEPPER STUFFED CHICKEN BREASTS

- 4 chicken breasts, skinless, boneless, raw (about 6 ounces each)
 - 2 tablespoons Italian seasoning
 - 1 teaspoon salt
 - 1 teaspoon black pepper
 - 1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper
 - 4 ounces regular or low-fat cream cheese
 - 1 medium lemon, juice and zest
 - 1 jar roasted red bell peppers, packed in oil, reserve oil
 - 8 slices Thin Provolone cheese
 - 4 teaspoons ground flax seed
 - 1/2 cup breadcrumbs (whole wheat or Panko)
- Cooking oil

1. Heat oven to 350 F.
2. Spray a glass baking dish with the cooking oil. Place the chicken breast on half of a large sheet of plastic wrap on a cutting board. Fold the

plastic wrap over the chicken. Using a meat mallet (or a heavy-bottomed skillet), flatten the breast to about 1/4 inch thick. Remove the plastic. Season chicken on both sides with 1 tablespoon of the Italian seasoning, and 1/2 teaspoon of the salt and black pepper, and the cayenne pepper.

3. Mix the cream cheese with the remaining 1/2 teaspoon of the salt and pepper. Remove the zest from the lemon and mix it into the cream cheese. Squeeze the lemon juice into a small bowl. Mix in the reserved oil from the roasted red bell pepper (or use 3 tablespoons of olive oil) and set it aside.

4. Spread the cream cheese mixture across the inside of the breast. Layer two slices of the provolone, then the roasted red pepper. Beginning at the smallest end, roll the breast up, tucking in the peppers as needed. Roll the chicken in the lemon and oil mixture.

5. Mix together the remaining 1 tablespoon of Italian seasoning, the ground flax seeds and the breadcrumbs. Sprinkle the chicken with the breadcrumb mixture. Place the chicken roll, seam side down, in the baking dish. No toothpicks are needed. Repeat the layering and rolling process with the remaining chicken.

6. Drizzle any remaining lemon and oil over the chicken to help it brown and crisp on top. Bake until chicken is cooked through (about 25 to 30 minutes) and no pink flesh remains. Makes 4 servings.

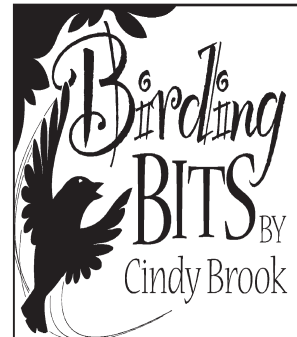
