

MMFD Greetings Dalmatians



Dalmatians first appear in a painting in Italy dated 1360. These spotted dogs were named after Dalmatia, an Adriatic coastal region. Therefore, it is assumed that they originated from that area. The name "Dalmatian" was not used in the English language until the 1780s.

Dalmatians are a very physical breed, with a strong, muscular body and the ability to long distance run without tiring. Standing 19 to 23 inches tall and weighing 25-55 pounds, they


were the perfect size to serve as coach dogs. Even today, in Great Britain, Dalmatians are still nicknamed "English coach dogs" and "plum pudding dogs".

It was quickly discovered that Dalmatians had a natural calming effect on horses and soon Dalmatians began to be identified with horses. They may have been used by mounted warriors or hunters in their activities. During the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries, the mode of travel was by horse or by carriage and the Dalmatian became a society dog and trained to run alongside the women's carriages. They became known as "Ladies dogs "or "Coach dogs. "The term "coaching" is referring to how the Dalmatian will take position just off the side and toward the rear of the horse and run with them.

In the 1700s, Dalmatians were used to protect horses that pulled English stagecoaches. Typically, two Dalmatians would run next to the horses as they pulled the coaches. When other dogs would run out and try to scare the horses, the Dalmatian teams would chase them away. Over the years, Dalmatians formed a close bond with horses.



SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

Recently, a house on lower Hopkin Street in Mount Morris was purchased at the County Auction and the owner/landlord has decided to turn it into a boarding house. The owner allegedly* performed modifications to the house without the appropriate zoning permits, adding new walls and rooms. The residence is zoned as R1 (single family) but the owner still moved in several individuals (at least 4) into the home at the start of September without the proper re-zoning of the property, and without giving written notification to the surrounding neighbors or providing them with an opportunity to voice their concerns. When approached by the Zoning Code Officer on August 31, the landlord allegedly* provided him with false information that a single family was moving in. There is a village meeting on September 19 at 6 pm at the Village Hall in Mount Morris at which this issue will be discussed. This is a major concern to all residents of Mount Morris since if this is allowed to stand, then it sets a bad precedent that any landlord can indiscriminately change the zoning of a property to whatever they want. How would you feel if the house across from you suddenly turned into a bording house housing up to 7 individuals? How would that affect your property value and possibly your safety? Mount Morris has made several positive steps forward in recent years in the renovations of the village. This would be a major step back and affect everyone in the long run. If this is also a concern to you, please attend the village meeting and let your concern be known. (*These alleged items will be verified publicly at the village meeting.)
