





# ASK THE **ATTORNEY**

🎙 I was hit in a parking lot by a man who was on his cell phone and not looking at all when he backed into me. He was still on his cell phone when he got out of the car. The police would not make a report because it was on private property and I only have liability insurance. It really makes me mad that he was on his cell phone and not looking. How can I prove that? Emma, Killen, AL

Parking lot accidents really cause problems for people who don't have full coverage insurance. I am not suggesting that everyone should have full coverage insurance. In fact, I spoke to a young lady who had bought a 15 year old BMW and was paying \$200 a month for full coverage insurance. Those cars can be bought for \$4500 and I don't know that the math works out to pay full coverage for a car that can be replaced relatively inexpensively.

Property damage only cases that have less than \$5000 in damage to the car should go to small claims court. It is not economically feasible to hire me to go to small claims court for a \$2000 or \$3000 case. By the time you pay the attorney's fee, your net result isn't enough to pay for the repairs for your vehicle. Small claims court is designed for non-lawyers to prepare reasonably well with common sense evidence and witnesses and present their case to a judge who makes a decision, in writing, typically after the parties leave.

Small claims court does not automatically allow "discovery". Discovery in the legal sense means or includes depositions, written questions that are to be answered under oath and subpoenas. In a regular automobile accident case that we would handle, a case involving a person who was hurt, we would be very interested in obtaining the cell phone number and the carrier (AT&T, Verizon, Sprint) so that we could issue for a subpoena to find out whether or not the person at fault was either talking or texting at the time of the accident.

That brings up a point that should be made. We use repair bills, medical bills and the other side's phone records to prove our case we photograph skid or scuff marks from the accident scene and we use the physical evidence from the damage to the vehicle for the jury to consider. The problem is people that are really hurt aren't out snapping pictures of the car that hit them and writing down the exact time of the accident. People who are doing those things probably are not hurt that badly.

You will be able to testify that you saw the person on the phone. You will be able to describe or show photographic evidence of where the impact on your car was. You will be able to testify as to your version of how the accident happened. You will need to know the value of your car before the accident and after the accident and you should have a person who regularly repairs cars to testify as to how it will cost to repair your car present in court. Unfortunately, I do not believe that you will be able to prove, other than through your testimony, that the person that hit you was a distracted driver.

Buckle up and drive safely.



is increasingly automated. Robots are replacing humans at an alarming rate. So what happens to the economy and our livelihoods when so many jobs are taken by robots? I took a deep dive into what economists and industry

One study from Oxford University claimed that 47% of the total US

employment is at risk of being eliminated. However, the same thing was said at the dawn of the industrial revolution when 80% of all workers worked on farms. Today, it's only two percent--thanks to technology and automation. And we are

much better off because of it. On the other hand, as minimum wage workers demand higher wages, companies are looking to cut labor costs by replacing humans with touchscreen order takers. A company has developed a robot that can turn out 360 burgers an hour. What will those unskilled workers do for a living?

That is not as bad as it may seem. Many of us have watched in dismay as so many of our jobs are shipped offshore for cheaper human labor. That tide is changing. As labor costs in those countries increase, technology

allows US workers to be more productive than their offshore counterparts. As a result, more and more companies are starting to move jobs back to the US.

In just a few short years, we won't even need to buy an expensive car for our daily commutes. We will simply summon a driverless car using our smartphones that will deliver us to our destination safely and comfortably. My favorite car company, Tesla, is working on technology that will allow me to afford their car. I will be able to drive my Tesla to work, then the car will drive itself to paying customers and drive them around while I work thus offsetting the cost of my awesome car. The car will automatically show up later to take me home. How dadgum cool is that?

Although the experts cannot agree on how all this will pan out, it's safe to say that America's workforce -- from the manufacturer's factory floor to law firms -- will soon look very different. I think that is a good thing. After all, back in the 1700's, the advent of automation and the resulting free time resulted in more coffee shops. People gathered in these shops to have intellectual conversations about life, the universe, and the role of government. This was the beginning of the Enlightenment which eventually resulted in the founding of this fantastic country we live in. As a

technological optimist, I think technology will result in another Enlightenment for the entire human race. One that will allow all of us to pursue artistic and philosophical goals while our robots do our bidding for us. So I, for one, welcome our robot overlords.

## **Medicare Minute**

"Medicare Pre-AEP"

Each year anyone who is on Medicare and enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) or Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) has an open enrollment period to make changes in their plan if they wish. This open enrollment period is called the Annual Election Period (AEP). It extends from October 15th to December 7th. There is also a period from October 1st to October 14th that is commonly called Pre-AEP.

Pre-AEP is an important time for Medicare beneficiaries. Insurance companies who offer MAs or PDPs cannot release their plan information for 2017 until October 1st. You can use this time to review your current plan to see if there has been any significant changes in your premium or copays. It's also a good time to review the prescription drug coverage of your plan, especially if you have had changes in the drugs you are taking. If any new plans are coming into your county, this is the time they are announced so be on the lookout for those.

Pre-AEP can also be a confusing time. Although it's designed for you to gather information on any changes that are coming for 2017, you may get phone calls or letters from insurance companies or your local agent. Local agents, in particular, like to use Pre-AEP to reach out to their clients and do policy reviews for the next year. This is totally acceptable under Medicare rules. It is also acceptable for you to attend a meeting or seminar during Pre-AEP to hear the details of 2017 plans. The one thing you cannot do is officially sign up for a new plan until after October 15th.

The good news is if you're happy with the plan you are in you won't have to do a thing. You will automatically roll into the 2017 plan as long as it's still offered in your area. If you have any questions about Pre-AEP you can contact our office for more information.

### OWING ON COMMERCIAL

Dear Dave.

My husband and I own three commercial buildings in Boise, Idaho, that are leased out longterm. We owe about \$500,000 on one and \$400,000 on each of the others, and they earn \$190,000. The only other debt we have is a small amount left on our mortgage. I know you don't like debt, but is it okay to owe on commercial properties that are making good money?

Dawn

Dear Dawn,

I own several commercial buildings, and I don't owe a dime on any of them. So, I can't tell you that I think it's okay to have debt on commercial buildings. I believe the best plan for building wealth is to

necessarily mean you guys should be in panic mode and start selling everything in sight. But I do think that you should systematically work your way out from under these debts over the next few years.

If I were in your shoes, I'd go ahead and get the house paid off first. Then, I'd take a look at these commercial properties, and begin working the debt snowball on them. Start throwing as much money as you can at the smallest debt, while making minimum payments on the other two. When you get it paid off, roll

that amount over - along with every dime you can dig up —and attack the second largest one. Follow these steps until you pay off all of your commercial properties.

It might take up to 10 years

Now, from the situation you've described, that doesn't necessarily mean you're a bunch of equity: you don't particularly like, you might consider selling it and throwing the cash at the remaining two. But whatever the timeline, I'd develop a hardcore game plan to get rid of this debt.

Wouldn't it be cool to have all that paid for? Talk about cash flow!

Dear Dave,

My wife and I are debt-free except for a car and our house. The car is financed through her mom, and her dad agreed to send us half of the payment each month. We owe \$7,700 on the car, and we have enough cash right now to pay off the car in full with plenty left over. Should we do this, even though her dad is making \$100 of the payment each month?

Dustin

Dear Dustin,

If her father had agreed to send you guys \$100 each month, ask him to continue doing that for the duration of the agreement. Then, you guys pay off the car now with your cash. There's nothing dishonest about this, as long as you explain the plan to her

parents and they're agreeable. The reason for this approach is two-fold: it gets the debt paid off, and then you can get the car put in your name. Plus, a situation like this represents drama just looking for a place to happen, if it hasn't already. Family relationships take on a weird vibe when money has been loaned and borrowed.

If they're not agreeable to the idea, that's okay. All you can do is ask. But one way or another, I'd be out of this situation before the sun goes down!

# What is a Violation of the Bankruptcy Automatic Stay?

For many of our clients, the automatic stay is the best thing that has happened to them in a long, long time. In fact, in my opinion, there is no other provision of the law that can do more good for an individual more quickly than the automatic stay.

So what is the automatic stay? It is really central to everything we do in bankruptcy. On the day a bankruptcy petition is filed, in fact at the very moment the petition is filed, the bankruptcy court

enters an order called an automatic stay. The order is entered pursuant to the provisions of Section 362 of Title 11 of the United States Code. It constitutes a directive by a federal judge to each and every creditor of the consumer to immediately stop any and all collection activities. This means that the creditor(s) must cease collection calls, collection letters, lawsuits, garnishments and even foreclosure proceedings. The practical effect of the automatic stay is of utmost importance to anyone seeking relief from creditor harassment, repossession of personal property or foreclosure of real property.

So what happens if a creditor violates the automatic stay and continues with collection activity when it knows, or should know, that the person from whom it is collecting has filed for bankruptcy? Quite simply, the creditor is in violation of a court order and can be made to pay the person damages. At Bond & Botes, we believe in protecting our clients from abusive creditors and often file complaints against creditors for violating the automatic stay. Frankly, there is little that I do as a bankruptcy attorney that I enjoy more that handing a check to one of my clients from a collector who we have made pay for attempting to collect a debt after a bankruptcy has been filed. Our clients have often been harassed and degraded by these collectors and it can be very uplifting when we make the collector pay money for its wrongful conduct.

Please note as I stated above that it must be shown the collector had knowledge of the bankruptcy filing in order to prove a violation of the automatic stay. It is thus very important that folks seeking bankruptcy protection work closely with their attorney to provide proper names, addresses and account numbers for their creditors. We want to be able to demonstrate that the creditor received notice of the bankruptcy filing. In some instances, a debt is transferred from one collector to another shortly before the bankruptcy filing and collection calls come from someone who was not listed. This does not necessarily stop us from suing the collector for violating the automatic stay. In some cases we can show that the collector should have known about the bankruptcy filing. It is enough if the person who has filed bankruptcy merely tells the collector that he or she has filed bankruptcy. If the collector calls again having been notified of the bankruptcy filing then it is in violation of the automatic stay. In other cases, we can show that the collector subscribes to one of several electronic bankruptcy notification services. If it does and failed to properly check for a bankruptcy filing before attempting to collect from someone in bankruptcy than it may have violated the automatic stay.






