

As much as I love a day spent around the corral gate, once again music took me away! Let's go on a "TV" tour of Reilly Springs, Texas, USA!

Just as he promised, Tyler's Bob Mauldin of the travel/discovery television program "Expedition Texas" came to Reilly Springs in Hopkins County, bringing along his TV cameraman Sean and assistant Ashleigh. They turned out to be such nice young professionals and I thoroughly enjoyed my day with them! It was actually the Reilly Springs Jamboree that brought the crew to town, but they wanted to film every working structure/site in Reilly Springs. There are only four locations, but it took most of the day anyway, Saturday September 17, 2016.

First stop was the former Methodist Church, which is privately owned by Terry and Leslie McCullough. The fellowship hall and Sunday School classrooms now house their art studio and offices, but the sanctuary has been preserved as originally built. It has beautiful pine paneling and floors with maple wood pews which reflect the warm glow of sunlight streaming in the many windows of the sanctuary. For Expedition Texas, Terry explained the building's past and shared some personal memories of childhoods spent in the church with his extended family, who were Attleseys, Sheltons and McCulloughs.





Local historian Bobby McDonald, a Reilly Springs native, volunteered his knowledge of the neighboring cemetery. In the oldest section, he pointed out gravestones with names of families who settled the area and established the community. Former resident Finis Attlesey spent a small fortune constructing a brick wall to surround the cemetery, and local brickmason Ted Boggs completed the work during the 1990's. A

feeling of community pride is evident there. Lovely iron gates were added, and a new section of the cemetery has sites available.





Next stop was the Reilly Springs Baptist Church, where Pastor Lester Harper showed a historic bell mounted beside the front porch entrance. The bell has a manufacturer's mark of 1848. It first hung in the belltower of the original Baptist Church. Later, when the current structure was built, the bell was mounted there. It is about two and a half feet tall and wide and probably weighs a lot! Pastor Larry Baxley led the Baptist congregation for 43 years, retiring in 2015.

All the outdoor filming was completed around noon, about the time the threatening skies released a deluge of rain. Lucky for us the Reilly Springs Jamboree/Community Center (former schoolhouse) has a good metal roof! And that's when I got my turn to talk. As Jamboree organizer, I was interviewed about the founder (Joe Shelton) and orgin of the show, the country music stars who appeared there in the 50's and 60's, and the newer talent we've hosted, like Kacey Musgraves and Hannah Kirby. (Kacey has a Christmas album coming out in October

2016!) During all this, I observed firsthand how filming for TV works to make

viewers think they are watching unbroken footage of a scene. Not so, actually! I'd say, for a 3-4 minute "tour" of the Jamboree hall and that you will see in the episode, there were at least half a dozen different "scenes" filmed of Bob and I chatting and walking together, plus the re-takes! Bob assured me, however, that it all comes together seamlessly in the finished product!

That night, Bob Mauldin put on an hour-long acoustic concert that included "stories from the road" of his four years as host and producer of "Expedition Texas" with about 70 people in the audience. How much fun it must be for Bob to get to do what you like best (discovering lost history) and making a name and fame for yourself while living out a dream! Local dish and satellite viewers can watch his program on Dallas KTXD TV 47 (Channel 47) every Saturday night at 7pm, Sundays at 2:30pm, and Tuesday mornings at 9am. And, you can watch all the episodes archived at expeditiontexas.com. Plan to watch the Reilly Springs episode sometime this fall...keep reading here for dates when the show will air.

KLONDIKE ISD: SMALL, CLEAN, WHOLESOME

Klondike is a small place fifteen miles south of Lamesa. It has a church and a school. It used to have a gin, but it closed. The closest house is half a mile from the school. Klondike got to prospectors during the Klondike gold rush.

its name because some strong water wells were in the area and around 1900, water was as valuable to the settlers as gold was "The school is the hub of the community," says Teresa

Roberts, business manager of the Klondike Independent School District. "Parents come to our sporting events not just to cheer the team, but to visit and get some of our homemade Frito pie and homemade ice cream. We have the best concession stand in the state, bar none."

Klondike ISD is a National Blue Ribbon school. It has ranked exemplary fifteen of the last twenty years. 258 students attend pre-K through twelfth grade. 145 are from Lamesa. The remaining students are from surrounding communities within the district. Many of the twenty-four teachers reside in teacherages next to the school.

Steve McLaren is superintendent and says the main disciplinary problems are getting the boys to shave and getting girls to wear jeans that don't have any holes in them. "Our sheriff comes by every once in a while with his drug-sniffing dog, but it has never sniffed any drugs in the school," says Steve.

Teresa grew up in Klondike and went through all twelve grades at the school, as did her three children, her father, husband and mother in law. She gave me a tour of the school, which covers a large area and has three gyms. The newest one, built three years ago, looks like the Dallas Mavericks could play there. The auditorium reminds me of the Bass Hall in Fort Worth. The hallways and classrooms are spotless and Rosalinda Padilla prepares lunches like she was cooking for royalty. Display cases are bulging with trophies won by students in athletics, agriculture, the arts and academics. Many of them are from national competitions.

"Our kids take speech classes and become accomplished public speakers," says Teresa. "It teaches them confidence and that shows up when they go to college." Steve says some eighty percent of Klondike graduates begin college, many of them on scholarships. "We get terrific support from parents. Some say this is like a private school. These students are like our own kids." I noticed them to be courteous and respectful as well as industrious.

The Klondike Cougars excel in basketball, volleyball, six-man football and Their opponents are from schools in Ackerly, Borden County, O'Donnell, Dawson, Loop, Grady and Wellman.

At all-class homecomings, as many as 750 alumni come back to walk the halls and see the gleaming improvements. Pictures on the walls show the school from its beginning days in 1904. During an annual bike race from Midland to Lubbock, riders stop in Klondike and get Klondike bars.




