SPEAK OUT

Dear Speak Out,

In November of 1943 over 1000 Marines and Sailors lost their lives in a battle to secure the Tarawa Atoll. One of the Marines who gave his all was 24 year old Pvt. Frank Penna; his family received the dreaded telegram that he was reported Missing In Action; as did all too many other American families throughout the many wars in which our service personal were engaged. How heartbreaking it had to be for the Penna family and for all the families who waited and wondered: was their loved one a prisoner of War? Was he being tortured? Was he hiding in a foreign woods or jungle - running every day for his life - all alone; or safe in the hands of a Resistant movement? Or buried in foreign soil in unmarked graves or worse - left where he fell - never buried? Do you wonder as I do, how many years did these families jump every time there was a knock on the door; or the telephone rang; or foot steps sounded on their front porch? How many of those parents, siblings, relatives and friends died without ever knowing the answer to all their heart breaking questions? Sadly, way, way too many.

This Friday, September 16th, is POW/MIA Remembrance Day. The Boyd Parker VFW post 547, Mt. Morris, NY ask all our citizens to please, PLEASE fly your flag to honor all our heroes who died fighting for the freedoms that our flag represents - heroes who once were, and many who still remain lost. Please say a prayer of thanks for those who never got the Military Burial they so rightfully deserved - one surrounded by loving family and friends; and pray for the families who never got the closure to which every parent and family is entitled. Pray for those who continue to search; and for the researchers who founded the miracle of DNA.

Thanks to the Florida Based group, History Flight, Pvt. Penna's remains were found last year along with 35 other Marines buried in several cemeteries through out the Island where they fought and died. His family was able to provide DNA and his remains were finally identified.

Pvt. Penna will return home to Canastota, N.Y. (20 miles outside of Syracuse) this Saturday, September 17th, 2016, for the first time in over 70 years. Rest in peace Pvt. - you're finally home - you will forever be remembered.

Written in remembrance of the service and sacrifice of the 83,000 American heroes who continue to be listed as missing and unaccounted for from WWII forward. Please fly your flag daily to remember these and all our military heroes.

Dalmations in the Fire Service Part II

In addition to their ability to keep the horses calm, and scare off possible attackers, Dalmations were also valued at guarding against horse theft. It was during the era of horse drawn fire apparatus that Dalmations became forever tied to the Fire Service.

Firehouse horses were required to spend hours at a time either in the fire house waiting for a call or at the fire scene. These were highly spirited, fine horses and the Dalmations would keep them calm and be their "pets". There are many stories of Dalmations running between the horse teams on the way to a call, then once on the scene, the Dalmations took over as guard dogs, making sure nothing was stolen off the apparatus and keeping the horses occupied.

Because of the dog/horse bond, the Dalmation easily adapted to the firehouse, acting as guard to the firehouse and horses and when the alarm came in the Dalmations led the way for the horse drawn pumper. In this way, the Dalmation became the firefighter's companion and a symbol of the fire service.

Today, Dalmations are still found in firehouses in England, Canada and the U.S. In some larger cities, the Dalmation remains the guard dog of the firehouse. In their long history in the fire service, there are many stories of how Dalmations have recued firefighters and victims. Overall, the Dalmation is a brave and valiant dog.
