Loblolly Festival this weekend in Downtown Laurel

This Saturday, October 1, the streets of Downtown Laurel will be lined with local vendors and vendors from all over the state of Mississippi and neighboring states for the annual Laurel Main Street Loblolly Festival.
“Loblolly is a way for us to celebrate our hometown. This year we will have over 125 vendors set up throughout the downtown area,” exclaimed Laurel Main Street Executive Director Judi Holifield at a recent downtown merchant meeting.
For many folks around Laurel and Jones County, with just the mention of the Loblolly Festival mouths began to water in anticipation of the taste of that first corn dog of the fall festival season. In addition to a variety of food vendors, there will be a number of artists, crafters, and craftsmen set up throughout the downtown area.
Live music will be heard throughout the day from artists such as The Old Memphis Kings, Phat Alley, Pine Belt Pickers, Molly Thomas & the Rare Birds featuring Cary

Hudson, and Johnny Sansone. The Birds of Prey from Freedom Farm will be returning this year, providing an opportunity to see Hawks, Owls and Buzzards up close.
The Pumpkin Patch at the First United Methodist Church will be open and filled with pumpkins of all sizes. Laurel’s lovable lumberjack, Ben Napier, Mr. Loblolly, will be meandering through the streets visiting with the crowd and stopping occasionally for a photo op. Ben and his wife, Erin, are the creators of the soon to be released HGTV series “Home Town.” According to the Napiers, filming of season one concluded last Thursday, September 22, and the new series should air around the first of 2017.
The Laurel Arts League will sponsor an art contest for middle school and high school artists. Students paint a door skin section supplied by Masonite Corporation to depict this year’s theme – “Loblolly Pine Tree – A Closer Look.” The art is judged by a blind panel of visual art experts. The art will be on display at the festival. The win-

Firefighters and deputies talk with local Boy Scouts about fire and police safety

Firefighters from Sharon Volunteer Fire Department and the Laurel Fire Department, as well as Jones County sheriff's deputies took time out of their busy schedules Monday evening to talk with local Boy Scouts about fire and police safety. As the evening began, Jones County deputy Priscilla Breland introduced herself and provided a little background to her duties as a deputy with the Jones County Sheriff's Department. After her introduction, she invited members of the Boy Scouts to ask questions.

The questions from the kids contained some complexity and outright intelligence. Multiple hands shot toward the sky as soon as Breland opened the room for questions. A faint yet courageous voice belted out the first question: "Have you shot anyone?" The deputy quickly answered "no." Even though the boys clearly had a desire to ask questions, the initial inquiry got the ball rolling. The next question: "How many people have you arrested?" followed by another: "What kind of guns do you carry" and "how strong is a Taser?" But the most shocking question of all, given the age of these boys, was "where did you go to school to get your degree?"

After Breland finished her Q&A with the kids, Laurel Fire Department Station 1 Captain Tim Tisdale stepped up
