

#### **Healthy Eating On The Go**

(NAPSA)—Today's families are more on the go than ever, spending many hours each week in the car, making it seem hard to make time for your family to eat healthy, nutritious foods.

•Pack GO foods ahead of time. If you have a busy day with your family planned—including time in the car—pack healthy snacks in a small cooler or tote bag before you leave. Consider water, fresh fruit or veggies, low-fat cheese sticks, whole-grain crackers or a low-sugar cereal portioned into

• Make healthy choices at fast-food restaurants. Sometimes, when you are traveling by car, fast food is the only option. Try making healthier choices such as sandwiches without cheese, sal-

ads with low-fat or fat-free dressing, replacing French fries with sliced fruit, and swapping fried meats for grilled options

• Read the labels. Stopping at convenience stores for a snack can easily lead to unhealthy choices. Looking at the nutrition label can help you and your children make the best choice. Pick snacks or beverages that are low in calories and added sugar—some stores stock fat-free or low-fat yogurt, fruit or individually portioned trail mix. Try to remember that some prepackaged foods may look like a single serving but actually contain multiple servings.

• Screws Directions:

1. Cut two pieces of dowel at 22 inches. These are your upright goalposts.

2. Cut another piece of dowel at 22 inches. This is your horizontal goalpost.

3. Cut another piece of dowel at 12½ inches. This is your upright support beam.

4. Lay the horizontal goal-post on your workbench. Then, use a pencil and make two marks on the post exactly 1 inch in from both ends. 5. Use the drill press with the Forstner bit to drill halfway through the dowel on

your marks. This is where the uprights will be attached. A Forstner bit is used to bore a precise, flat-bottomed hole. 6. Flip the goalpost over

and make a mark in the center of the post, 11 inches from either end. Drill halfway through on your mark.
7. Apply glue and piece the

two upright goalposts into the two side drill-outs.
8. To secure the upright

goalposts, predrill from the



jumbo goalpost uprights for a paper football game the whole family can enjoy.

underside of the horizontal goalpost into the middle of the upright dowels and screw in. 9. Apply glue and place the

upright support beam in the center drill-out. 10. To secure the upright

support beam, predrill and screw in from the top of the horizontal goalpost. 11. Use the 1-inch Forstner

bit to make a hole through a piece of 2 x 6.


12. Apply some glue, place upright in 2 x 6 and let dry. 13. Paint or stain as desired.

A • Your pitcher might be worth that • much if it was authentic. It isn't. What you purchased is a reproduction. Color is often a tipoff for Fiesta fakes and reproductions. One of the better references is "Fiesta: Identification and Price Guide" by Glen Victorey. Four of the original colors for the disc water pitchers are forest green, chartreuse, turquoise and rose.

•I have a secretary desk that my parents purchased at auction in 1943. It is identified as being made by the Hekman Furniture Company. It has become a family heirloom but has been refinished and is not in its original state. Should I take it and have it professionally restored? — Carol, Bloomington, Indiana

. The Hekman Furniture Com-A pany was founded in Grand Rapids, Michigan, in 1922 by three brothers: Henry, Jelle and John Hekman. The first pieces produced were occasional tables. In 1942, the company relocated its main show room

to the Merchandise Mart in Chicago. During World War II, the plant made glider bottoms and ammunition boxes. The 1960s and '70s were a period of great expansion, and the company still exists.

I have examined the picture you sent

me of your desk, and I think it was probably manufactured during the 1930s. Only you can determine if you want to have it professionally restored. Consider the cost of this service against the current value of your desk.

• I have a pair of plastic salt and • pepper shakers that look like Phillips 66 gasoline pumps. Are they worth keeping? — Betty, Buffalo,

A. Your salt and pepper shakers were manufactured during the 1950s and were given away as premiums by Phillips 66 stations. They are valued in the \$25 to \$35 range by the "Salt and Pepper Price Guide," by Mark Moran and published by Krause

#### Highway Bill Could Speed Up Economy

(NAPSA)—The next time you take to the road for a business trip or vacation, you may remember how important it is for Congress to adequately fund transportation—and consider letting them know how you feel about it.

"It's a pivotal time to remind our federal elected officials of the importance and urgency of finding solutions to the dire situation the construction industry and our highways are facing," says Gerald F. Voigt, P.E., president and CEO of the American Concrete Pavement Association.

Congress needs to do the right thing by making highways and other elements of the surface transportation system a top priority, said Voigt.

This year marks the sixth anniversary of the signing of the most recent highway bill, which, since its expiration, has been extended seven times.

Extensions make it difficult for businesses to invest in the future, and not having a clear timeline for the next transportation bill will continue to jeopardize the economic vitality of companies—and the nation.

The ability to move people and goods is critical to the nation's economy.

When the federal government underinvests in transportation infrastructure, it's easier for the nation to fall behind in the global marketplace.

"China, India and other developing nations understand the value of infrastructure development and the critical link between infrastructure, commerce, personal mobility and safety," said Voigt. "Why are those issues any

less important in the U.S. than in other nations?" Fuel prices are rising at an

alarming rate, and with widespread speculation that motorists might pay \$5 per gallon for gasoline, motorists can scarcely afford to waste fuel because of the inefficiency and disrepair of the nation's highways.

As the nation's economy continues to falter, said Voigt, unemployment remains high in the construction industry. Passage of a new highway bill would create and sustain well-paying, longterm jobs for people who want to work and need to work.

"Talk to your neighbors, your colleagues, your employees and everyone you know who has the power of the vote and urge them to take a stand; to tell their elected officials to find and invest the funds to repair and preserve the nation's highways," said Voigt.

### **Healthy Tip: Try Meatless Mondays**

(NAPSA)—There's a new initiative, called Meatless Mondays, to help you improve your health. By eating plant-based foods in place of meat just one day a week, you can help reduce your risk of heart disease, cancer, diabetes and obesity.

In fact, a recent Harvard University study found that by replacing saturated fat, found in animal foods, with foods rich in polyunsaturated fats (such as canola oil), the risk of heart disease was reduced by 19 percent. Here are some tips to help you eat meatless on Mondays or any day of the week:

- Build your meal around whole grains and vegetables, which will fill you up with their fiber and texture. Follow the USDA's guidelines—divide your plate so that half of it contains vegetables, one-quarter is whole grains and one-quarter is protein of some kind.
- Use inexpensive canola oil in place of butter and other saturated fats. Canola oil is cholesterol free, trans fat free, low in saturated fat as well as high in unsaturated fat and omega-3 fat.
- Try new recipes such as this flavorful umami-filled Mushroom Loaf.

Mushroom Loaf

Canola cooking spray ½ cup canola oil



Adding mushrooms to your meal can help replace the savory taste of meat.

- 16 ounces portobello mushrooms, chopped
- 1 small red onion, finely
- diced
- 1 red bell pepper, seeded and finely diced
- 2 tablespoons ground sage
- 1½ cups cooked brown rice ½ cup walnuts, finely
- chopped 1 envelope onion soup mix
- 1 cup oat bran
- 1 cup wheat germ 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 2 teaspoons mustard

Preheat oven to 350° F. Spray 9x5-inch loaf pan with canola cooking spray.

1 teaspoon Worcestershire

Heat the canola oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Stir in the mushrooms, onions and bell peppers. Once the onions are transparent, add ground sage and cook for another 5 minutes. Transfer to a large bowl. Add the remaining ingredients to the mushroom mixture until thoroughly blended. Spoon into prepared pan, pressing down mixture to flatten top. Bake for 50-60 minutes. Let rest 10 minutes before slicing. Top with fresh sage leaves, if desired.

#### Classic Hamburger Is All-American

A contest is held in California's Napa Valley every year about this time to "Build a Better Burger." Contestants creatively cook a wide variety of containing everything from pickled saffron pears and green curry to Spanish chorizo, pork, lamb and

even Spam. While I enjoy sampling all the unusual toppings, oddly shaped burger buns and mind-boggling flavor combinations, sometimes I just want a classic, allbeef hamburger.

Ground chuck is the meat of choice for most hamburger purists. The preferred combination is 80 percent lean meat to 20 percent

fat. The fat makes the

burgers moist and flavorful. If the fat content is too low, your hamburger patty will dry out during the cooking process.

Combining ground chuck with other ground meats adds a delicious combination of juiciness and flavor to your burger. The top choice for making the ultimate hamburger patty is to combine ground chuck with ground

sirloin. Try this great recipe to make a classic American burger!

#### CLASSIC HAMBURGERS

- pound ground chuck (80/20 blend) or a combination of chuck and sirloin
- tablespoons Worcestershire
- teaspoon salt
- teaspoon freshly ground
- black pepper
- teaspoon onion powder teaspoon garlic powder
- 1. Heat a large skillet to medium hot. The pan is at the proper temperature when a drop of water dances on its surface.
- 2. Place the Worcestershire sauce in a medium-size bowl. Gently press the ground meat into the liquid and turn and fold it over once or twice to com-



bine. (Remember, the more you handle the meat, the softer it will become and the more likely it will be to fall apart when you cook it.) Wet your

hands to keep the meat from sticking. 3. Divide the meat into 4 equal portions. Hold one portion of the ground meat in the palm of your hand, gently turning and shaping the meat into a patty that is tightly compact and uniform in size. The patty should be a little larger or about the same size as your hamburger bun.

4. Lightly press three fingers into the center of the patty, making a slight, dimple indention in the center and pushing the meat to the outer edges. (Making it thinner in the middle and thicker around the edges will allow the patty to cook evenly. As hamburger patties cook, they shrink in size. As they shrink, the edges tend to break apart, causing deep cracks to form. To combat this, you want the burger patty to be thinner in the middle than around the edges.) Season the patties on both sides with salt, pepper, onion and garlic powder.

5. Place the hamburger patties into the hot skillet. For a rare 4 to 5 minutes on the first side, turn the patties and cook for an additional 4 to 5 minutes; for a medium burger, cook 7 to 8 minutes per side; for well-done burger, cook 8 to 10 minutes per side.

6. If desired, place a slice of cheese on each burger during the final minute of cooking. When the cheese has melted, remove the burgers to a plate.

7. Rub the skillet with a folded paper towel to clean it. Place the hamburger buns, cut side down, in the skillet for about 1 minute to toast them. Serve the hamburger patties in the buns with your favorite condiments and vegetables.





#### Lampshade Makeover Brightens Up Room

"Who turned out the lights so soon?" I overheard a 5-year-old boy ask his mom as they returned from a toobrief evening bike ride. I find myself pondering the same question. It's as though long, bright summer evenings vanished before our eyes.

Ready or not, fall is taking hold, and lamps are back in service. But if you're like me, you might be noticing that the lampshades in your kids' rooms are looking outdated or dingy. The good news is that with just a few inexpensive supplies and your kids' creativity, you can do a lampshade makeover in no time. Using colorful tissue paper and basic glue, you'll see a successful transformation right before your eyes.

Here's what you'll need:

-Inexpensive, standard white lamp-

shade without pleats. —Sheets of tissue paper in several

-Household white glue diluted with

a few drops of water to create a milkshakelike consistency

—Paintbrush

1. Tear tissue paper into 1-inch by 1-inch size pieces. This is a perfect job for preschoolers. Older children might prefer cutting straight-sided squares or rectangles with scissors. Either way, your lampshade will look great.

2. Set the lampshade on a newspaper-covered work surface. Paint an outside section with the glue-and-water mixture and attach the tissue paper pieces, overlapping them as you go. Paint a little of the glue mixture over the top of the tissue paper and smooth each piece out with your fingers. When the shade is covered, finish it off

with a final coating of glue and water.

Here are some creative add-on ideas:

Baby's Room

Attach a piece of self-sticking Velcro near the base of the lamp. Place a matching piece on a toy, doll or stuffed animal and attach to the lamp.

#### **Barnyard-Themed Room**

Cut out more tissue paper in recognizable barnyard-animal shapes for a young child's room. Cookie cutters make good patterns. Glue them to the tissue-covered shade parading around the shade near the bottom rim. When dry, an adult may outline the shapes with acrylic paint in squeeze bottles.



#### **Outer-Space-Themed Room**

Glue glow-in-the dark stars on a shade that has been covered with navy or other dark-colored tissue squares.


