#### **APPLE SPICE CAKE TRIFLE**

#### Ingredients

1 package spice cake mix (regular size)

- 1-1/4 cups cinnamon applesauce
- 3 eggs

1/3 cup canola oil

1 can (21 ounces) apple pie filling

1 tablespoon butter

7 teaspoons ground cinnamon, divided

3 cups cold milk

1 package (5.1 ounces) instant vanilla pudding mix

1 envelope whipped topping mix (Dream Whip) 1 carton (12 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed 1/2 cup chopped walnuts

1/4 cup English toffee bits or almond brickle chips

#### Directions

1. In a large bowl, combine the cake mix, applesauce, eggs and oil; beat on medium speed for 2 minutes. Pour into a greased 13-in. x 9-in. baking pan.

2. Bake at 350° for 35-40 minutes or until toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack.

3. In a small saucepan, cook pie filling, butter and 1 teaspoon cinnamon until butter is melted; stir until well blended. Cool.

4. In a large bowl, combine the milk, pudding mix, topping mix and remaining cinnamon. Beat on high until thickened, about 5 minutes; set aside. Spread a third of the whipped topping in a 6-qt. trifle bowl.
5. Cut cake into cubes; place half over topping. Top with half of the fruit mixture, walnuts and pudding mixture. Repeat layers. Spread with remaining

whipped topping. Sprinkle with toffee bits. Cover and chill for at least 2 hours. Yield: 20-24 servings.

### APPLE SALAD

#### Ingredients

1 can (20 ounces) unsweetened pineapple chunks

1/4 cup butter, cubed

- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 2 tablespoons cold water
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 8 cups chopped tart apples
- 2 cups green grapes
- 2 teaspoons poppy seeds
- 3/4 cup chopped pecans, toasted

#### Directions



1. Drain pineapple, reserving juice; set the pineapple aside. Place juice in a saucepan; add butter, sugar and lemon juice. Bring to a boil. Combine the cornstarch and cold water until smooth; add to the saucepan, stirring constantly. Return to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes. Chill. Stir in mayonnaise. In a large bowl, combine pineapple, apples, grapes, poppy seeds and cooked dressing. Fold in the pecans just before serving. Yield: 14 servings.

### **PEANUT CAKE BARS**

#### Ingredients

1 package chocolate cake mix (regular size) 1/2 cup water







1/3 cup butter, softened

1 egg

TOPPING:

- 3 cups miniature marshmallows
- 1 package (10 ounces) peanut butter chips
- 2/3 cup light corn syrup
- 1/4 cup butter, cubed
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 cups crisp rice cereal
- 2 cups salted peanuts

#### Directions

1. In a bowl, combine dry cake mix, water, butter and egg until blended. Press into a greased 15-in. x 10-in. x 1-in. baking pan. Bake at 350° for 13-16 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Sprinkle with marshmallows. Bake 2 minutes longer. Cool.

2. In a saucepan, combine peanut butter chips, corn syrup, butter and vanilla. Cook over low heat until melted; stir until smooth. Remove from the heat; stir in cereal and peanuts. Spoon over marshmallows. Cool before cutting. Yield: about 3 dozen.

#### **OVERNIGHT FRUIT SALAD**

#### Ingredients

3 large eggs, beaten 1/4 cup sugar 1/4 cup vinegar 2 tablespoons butter 2 cups green grapes 2 cups miniature marshmallows



1 can (20 ounces) pineapple chunks, drained 1 can (15 ounces) mandarin oranges, drained





2 medium firm bananas, sliced

2 cups heavy whipping cream, whipped

1/2 cup chopped pecans

#### Directions

1. In a double boiler over medium heat, cook and stir eggs, sugar and vinegar until mixture is thickened and reaches 160°. Remove from the heat; stir in butter. Cool.

2. In a large serving bowl, combine grapes, marshmallows, pineapple, oranges and bananas; add cooled dressing and stir to coat. Refrigerate for 4 hours or overnight. Just before serving, fold in whipped cream and pecans. Yield: 12-16 servings.

Choking due to an obstructed airway is a serious situation that can lead to death. If you notice someone who is choking but not coughing or able to speak, call 911 immediately. Then you should perform the Heimlich maneuver.



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### Here's how:

- Have the choking victim stand.
- Place yourself slightly behind the victim and place your arms around his or her waist.
- Make a fist with one hand placing your thumb toward the victim, just above his or her navel.
- Grab your fist with your other hand and deliver five upward thrusts into the victim's abdomen.
- Your thrusts may move air out of the victim's lungs and create an artificial cough.
- Repeat the Heimlich maneuver until the food is dislodged.

It's important to call for emergency assistance BEFORE performing the Heimlich maneuver. Even if you are successful in dislodging the obstruction, the victim should still be checked out by medical personnel.

Hi Readers!

Since we have officially established that flossing IS actually good for your dental health, and health in general, let me wrap up our flossing discussion this month with a few suggestions regarding flossing.

My preferred way to floss is with the Reach flosser. It is a different version of a flosser in that it holds the disposable floss cartridge with the floss perpendicular to the handle instead of being in line with the handle. This flosser is much easier to use in between the hard-to-reach back teeth because you don't have to twist the handle around to the side to use it back there.

If you are a traditionalist, and wind the floss around your fingers, there is a flat, thin floss by Glide that is considerably easier to get between tight teeth. If you don't have that issue, then any standard waxed floss will do. While there is really no perfect alternative to flossing, Using a Waterpik, or HydroFloss is a nice alternative, especially if there is either an aversion to flossing, or if a person has difficulty flossing due to physical limitations. These are also particularly useful if someone has bridgework that is hard to floss under or if a patient has temporary crowns or veneers that may be connected.
