MMFD Greetings



Late one night, when we were all in bed, Mrs. O'Leary lit a lantern in the shed. Her cow kicked it over, then winked her eye and said, "There'll be a hot time in the old town tonight!" Chicago folksong

The summer of 1871 in Chicago was historically hot and dry, leaving the ground parched and the wooden city vulnerable. Patrick and Catherine O'Leary were Irish immigrants who lived with their 5 children at 137 DeKoven Street. Pat-

rick was a laborer and Catherine sold milk door-to door from her 5 cows she kept in the barn next to their cottage. Prior to the fire, no one ever took notice of the O'Learys.

The streets, the sidewalks and the building in Chicago were made of wood. On the night of October 8th, Catherine testified she went to bed at around 8 or 8:30 and was roused by her husband at around 9 with the words: "Cate, the barn is on fire!!" The flames traveled through shanties and sheds, leaping across Taylor Street and consuming houses, commercial and industrial buildings, and private mansions. Some reports describe "fire devils" - winds that "drove the flames before it with force and fierceness which could never be described or imagined." The conflagration continued on for 2 days until October 10, when it finally rained and assisted firefighters with suppressing this fire. The city was ravaged: \$200 million worth of property destroyed, 300 lives lost, 100,000 people - one-third of the city's population left homeless.

Even before the fire died down the Chicago press implicated Mrs. O'Leary and her cow, reporting that the fire began at the corner of DeKoven and Twelfth Streets and was caused by her cow kicking over "a lamp in a stable where a woman was milking" - a story that originated with the children in the neighborhood. Many other stories emerged from the ruthless Chicago press depicting Catherine as an old Irish woman seeking revenge for not being welcomed to America. Reporters came to her door calling her "shiftless

and worthless", and an "old drunken hag with dirty hands". PT Barnum came to her door and asked her to come join his circus. Her husband sicced dogs at their ankles and threw bricks at their heads. Her dubious role in one of the greatest disasters in American history brought her fame she never wanted and could not deflect. When she died, 24 years later of acute pneumonia, neighbors insisted her true cause of death was a broken heart.

There is no known photograph of Catherine O'Leary, she is only depicted in caricature either as an old



hag or sometimes as a young Irish immigrant. Testimony and reports have NEVER determined a cause of the Great Chicago Fire. Today the Chicago Fire Department Training Academy is located on the site of the O'Leary cottage on DeKoven Street. The original cottage survived the fire. The O'Leary's eventually moved to the south side of Chicago. She was 44 at the time of the fire. In 1997 the Chicago City Council passed a resolution exonerating Catherine O'Leary, who died in 1895, and her cow.
