



ASK THE **ATTORNEY**

I read a comment in the newspaper where a person said they don't like lawyer advertisements on television. They went further to say they would never hire a lawyer that advertised on television. I don't like these commercials either.

The fact is that we advertise as a personal injury firm. We don't offer a full range of services because we believe it is in our clients' best interest for us to focus on a single area of the law and try to be very good in that area of the law.

When I first started practicing law, the idea was that a law firm would take care of the entire needs of an entire family. That would include divorces, adoptions, Wills and Trusts, business formation and routine criminal matters. When someone in that family would get hurt, the lawyer that took care of that family would get that case and make good money off of it. Back then injuries were typically valued at

three times the medical bills and injury cases were a lot easier.

In the infinite wisdom of our Legislature, the law is now that if someone is injured through no fault of their own in a car wreck, the jury cannot learn that the other driver has insurance but the jury does get to learn that the injured party had health insurance to pay their bills. A good defense lawyer wants the jury to know that Blue Cross Blue Shield paid the bills. Some jurors still think that the bills are what you base the value of the case on without consideration of the injury and how it affects the injured person.

In on-the-job injury cases, for example, we all know how hard it would be for a carpenter who lost a hand to earn a living. That's a job that simply requires good use of both hands. Again, the Legislature changed the law. All that carpenter can get now is 200 weeks of two-thirds pay as a "scheduled injury". Before the change, an injured worker could choose between how the injury affected their earning capacity and the schedule of injuries.

The law of personal injury has become so complex that it is better to hire a lawyer that knows the law and has presented similar cases to judges and juries because the presentation of a case requires its own set of skills.

While I don't like lawyer advertising and certainly don't like paying for it, the fact is no one can be good at everything. We are personal injury trial lawyers and if we don't advertise that fact, then how would someone know to meet with us or ask their friends and neighbors about us?

Medicare Minute "Medicare Advantage Plans"

Medicare Annual Enrollment Period (AEP) extends from October 15th through December 7th. This is the time of year you can sign up for or make any changes to your Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) or Prescription Drug Plan (PDP). Over the next few weeks we are going to look at MA and PDP plans and what to look for when choosing these plans.

Medicare Advantage Plans, or Part C Medicare, are offered through private insurance companies that Medicare approves. If you join a Medicare Advantage Plan you still have Medicare but will receive your Medicare Part A and Medicare Part B coverage through the private insurance company offering the MA plan you join. Medicare Advantage Plans are not Medicare supplements.

Here are a couple of rules to remember if considering a Medicare Advantage Plan. To be eligible to join a Medicare Advantage Plan you must be enrolled in Part A and Part B Medicare. You must also live in the service area of the plan. For example, if you live in Lauderdale or Colbert counties you are only eligible for plans that are offered in your county. Just because a plan is offered in Huntsville or Birmingham does not mean it's available in Lauderdale or Colbert counties. Also, you do not have to be 65 to join an Advantage Plan. If you have been on Social Security disability for 24 months and have Medicare you can join a plan.

Over the next few weeks we will begin to look at the six things to consider when choosing a Medicare Advantage Plan. Those six things are premium, copays, coinsurance, deductibles, provider networks and the drug formulary of the plan. We will also discuss the difference between your plan options such as a HMO and a PPO. In the meantime if you have any questions about Medicare Advantage Plans you can contact our office.

ON YOUR DEBT

Can A Chapter 13 Help with My Student Loans?

Many folks who come into our office are carrying mountains of long term student loan debt. The good news is a few people are in the new income based repayment plans that are being offered by various government agencies. The bad news is many are not and student loan debt is currently extremely difficult to discharge in Bankruptcy. The

So much so, that I often refer to this process as a "band-aid". However, if your paycheck is being louid as correlated by your paycheck is being levied or garnished by your student loan creditor or you are in default with your student loans, the chapter 13 plan is probably one of your best options.

Most people who file a Chapter 13 Bankruptcy Plan, file a pro rata plan. In this type of plan, most if not all of your unsecured creditors receive a percentage of what you owe and the remaining balances are discharged at the end of your chapter 13 plan term. Your student loan debt is an unsecured claim against your bankruptcy estate and any student loan creditor can file a claim in your chapter 13 to share in the percentage distribution. Including your long term student loan debt in your chapter 13 plan will immediately stop any levy or garnishment of your wages and prevent any student loan creditor from taking money from your pay or tax return refunds for the term of your chapter 13 plan. Depending upon your ability to pay, you may be able to opt to subclass your student loan debt and pay all the principal in full throughout the life of your chapter 13 plan. This is advantageous because unlike other general unsecured creditors, the balance of a student loan is not discharged at the end of a chapter 13 plan. This is something we can review with you on a case by case basis. Paying some or all of your student loan debt through a chapter 13 can be a benefit to you in the long run as compared to long term deferments of payment that can result in a mountain of interest accrual on the debts.

he Florence City Council, a committee promoting a tennis complex at Veterans Park, Florence hoteliers, and the Shoals Hospitality Committee have their own rally going about the tennis complex proposal. It's pretty hard to find more

than a few people in favor of adding 31 tennis courts to the ensemble of empty courts in the city to be financed with an increase in the lodging tax from 11%-16%.

Finding an attraction for Veterans Park is a remaining part of the obligation this community has as part of the Robert Trent Jones / Marriott Shoals development a decade ago. A tennis complex in Veterans Park was bandied about back then, but it never gained any traction.

Granted, there were few members of the community in favor of the Robert Trent Jones/Marriott Shoals proposal

through a proposed 2¢ gas tax a decade ago, and we can see how successful that project is.

However, there are some differences. Neither sport is favorable in the winter months, but golf *can* be played in a 46° drizzle with a 20 mph wind. This is not possible with tennis even though proponents will claim a potential window from February-November.

Claims that the proposed tennis complex will compete for tournaments now located in Dothan, Mobile, and other warmer climates that have many more recreational options are presumptuous.

Lauderdale County High School boasts of 15 total State Championships in three different sports. The Tigers first State Championship came in 1974 when coach Earl Grisham led the Tigers to a state football championship.

The Lauderdale County High School Tigers girls basketball program ranks among the best in the state of Alabama. Coach Larry Sinyard's girls basketball teams won five State Championships and finished runner-up two other times. Current girls head basketball coach, Brant Llewellyn, has led the Tigers to eight State Championships including a state record five in a row. In 18 years at the school, his record is an astounding 521-86: an average record of 29-4 each season.

Coach Ted Talley led the Tigers girls track team to the Class 2A State Championship in 1978. Fifteen State Titles in three different sports for the school—an amazing accomplishment. The legends part of the school's athletic history reads like a Who's Who in the sports world. Perhaps no one has risen as much as Harlon Hill. His awards in the National Football League as a member of the Chicago Bears include NFL Rookie of the Year in 1954 and the Jim Thorpe Award winner as Most Valuable Player in the league in 1955.

Lots of dogs love chocolate, but it doesn't love them. Signs of a toxic dose include vomiting, diarrhea, seizures and cardiac arrhythmias

Tho doesn t love chocolate? It s the stuff of celebrations, holidays and romance. It s filled with feel-good chemicals, and there s even evidence that it s good for our health.

Dogs love chocolate as much as we do, based on the number of stories I ve heard about canines who crave the sweet stuff. Just about every week, I see or hear from clients whose dogs have gotten into a box of designer chocolates or a bag of Snickers bars or M&Ms. I even remember one Christmas when my brother Bobby s late Yorkie, Buddy, ate an entire 1-pound box of Godiva chocolates.

But while dogs who OD on chocolate might

emergency and criticalcare medicine. White and milk chocolate have less theobromine, the poisonous chemical, compared to baking chocolate.

That doesn t mean that milk chocolate is necessarily safe. One ounce of milk chocolate per pound of body weight is a potentially lethal dose in dogs. Usually, when

4 Q&A How to help kids treat pets right

Q: I have a young niece and nephew, and they ll be visiting frequently. What are the best ways to teach them to pet my dog and cat without anybody getting hurt? via Facebook

A: That s a great question! Starting while they re young will help them to become loving and careful toward animals throughout their lives.

Begin with the adage Show, don t tell. Demonstrate how to softly pet a dog or cat. Hold the child s hand as he or she strokes it across the body. Teach the three-finger rule, too: Touch the pet with only three fingers, not the whole hand. Let very young children pet animals only when you re there to help.

Appeal to a young child s sense of empathy. Point out to your niece and nephew that nobody likes to be hit or kicked or have their hair pulled and that includes dogs and cats. This helps to emphasize the importance etting animals quietly and calmly. With very young children, you ll probably need to repeat this discussion frequently and keep an eye on interactions to make sure your dog and cat never feel the need to defend themselves. Remind kids to use their inside voice when they re around pets. They ll be fascinated to learn that dogs and cats can hear better than they can, even from far away. Kids love to pick up animals and carry them around, but dogs and cats usually don t think it s much fun. Set the rule that pets can be held only when kids are sitting on the floor or on the sofa and only for as long as the pet allows it. No hanging onto him if he wants to get down. Teach older children (and some adults) to always support a pet s rear when picking him up. You re doing an important job: creating new animal lovers. Mikkel Becker

get the same flavor enjoyment from it that we do, it s not so good for their health. Chocolate contains both caffeine and a substance called theobromine. Both are plant alkaloids, mildly stimulating to humans, but toxic to dogs, who aren t able to process theobromine as efficiently as humans.

Now. I hear stories all the time about dogs who suffer no ill effects after eating a whole batch of homemade fudge, a bag of Hershey s kisses, a chocolate muffin or cookies dipped in dark chocolate. That s because chocolate s toxic effects known as chocolate toxicosis

vary depending on the size of the dog, the amount and type of chocolate eaten, and individual sensitivity.

Small dogs, like 6-pound Buddy, are at greater risk than the typical 100-pound Labrador retriever. And dogs who eat chocolate candy adulterated with lots of sugar are usually less at risk than those sophisticated canines who ingest high-quality dark chocolate.

The darker and more bitter the chocolate, the more toxic it is, says Justine Lee, DVM, who s double board-certified in toxicology and evidence comes out the other end. Barbara Davis

of Corona, California, had an English springer spaniel with a chocolate fetish.

One time she consumed an entire sack of Kraft Fudgies, including the little gold plastic wrappers, Davis says. At that time I was living in Manhattan, and it raised quite a few eyebrows as people observed my dog pooping gold in the curb on 52nd Street.

If they re going to have a problem, most dogs start to vomit, have diarrhea or become unusually thirsty within six to 12 hours of ingesting chocolate. Restlessness and a distended abdomen are also signs. More severe side effects such as seizures, a racing heart (tachycardia) and high or low blood pressure can also occur.

Death by chocolate isn t just the name of a dessert. Dogs who are highly sensitive to

> theobromine or who ingest the more toxic dark forms of chocolate, such as cocoa powder or unsweetened baking chocolate, can die from cardiac arrhythmias, hyperthermia or respiratory failure.

Another factor is the possible presence of xylitol, a sugar alcohol, in some chocolate products. It s highly toxic to dogs and may be of more concern than the chocolate itself.

My brother s dog Buddy indeed needed a trip to the veterinary clinic, but I m happy to report that he survived the incident.

When in doubt, Dr. Lee advises, contact the ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center (888-426-4435) or other pet poison hotline for life-saving advice. They can advise whether or not it s a poisoning concern.





Ten or twelve years ago Tiger Woods pushed golf to the peak of its popularity and the rounds of golf exploded at the new RTJ course in Ford City. Promoters of the \$9 million tennis complex insist that the popularity of tennis is up and that a tennis complex is one of the few projects that TVA is likely to approve.

There are few studs in the U.S. to emulate now. Gone are the storied days of Conner, McEnroe, Sampras, King and Evert. No man from the United States is even in the Top 20 World rankings.

If it weren't for the Williams sisters - who are on the cusp of retirement, the US would have only two women in the Top 40 world rankings.

Those statistics border on embarrassing and depict a much different tennis environment than we had 20 or 30 years ago.

Tennis courts in the Shoals are far from overflowing as it is. Closing convenientlylocated courts in an effort to consolidate play in a new complex may work for a while. Then inconvenience may soon create more apathy than excitement.

Advocates insist we

will be able to finance the project with 3% of a lodging tax increase 5% Florencein Florence. Lauderdale Tourism will claim the other 2% of that increase to market the area and lure/create some significant tennis tournaments for Florence. However, the majority of Florence hoteliers strongly object to shouldering the burden.

The lack of a feasibility study with no one eager to fund one is another concern primarily voiced by mayorelect Steve Holt and three newly- elected council members.

Yes, the Tennis Channel has been on cable since 2001 with various providers in both tiered packages and as an option. The channel was sold in March of this year to Sinclair Broadcast Group for \$350 million. One source shows the channel at the point of sale boasting \$200 million in net losses for tax purposes. It will be interesting

It will be interesting to see how this impasse is resolved. Regardless, let's hope more people are playing tennis than are watching it.


