1. To make the red cabbage and

apples, heat 1 tablespoon of the oil in

a very large Dutch oven or flameproof

casserole over medium heat. Add the

bacon and cook, stirring occasionally,


until crisp and browned, about 8 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer to paper towels to drain, leaving the fat in the pan.

2. Add the onion and cook, stirring often, until golden, about 10 minutes. Transfer to a bowl.

3. Add remaining 2 tablespoons oil to the Dutch oven and heat until hot but not smoking. Add the apples and cook, stirring often, until lightly browned, about 3 minutes. Add the cabbage, apple juice, vinegar brown sugar, thyme and bay leaf, and stir well to coat the cabbage. (The vinegar helps the cabbage hold its color.) Bring to a boil over high heat. Reduce heat to medium-low and cover. Simmer, stirring occasionally, until the cabbage is tender, about 1 1/2 hours. Season with salt and pep-

per to taste.

4. Bury the sausages in the cabbage and cover. Cook until they are heated through, about 12 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer the cabbage and sausages to a large serving bowl, removing the bay leaf, and tent with aluminum foil. Bring the cooking liquid in the pot to a boil over high heat and cook, stirring often, until reduced to about 1/2 cup, about 5 minutes. Pour over the cabbage and sausages and serve hot. Makes 6 servings.






