# Code Corner by John Polito, Village of Mount Morris Code Enforcement Officer

Hello folks, I am the new code enforcement official for the Village. This month's code corner is "When do you need a permit and when do you not need a permit." This is just a partial list, when in doubt you can call me.

### You Do Not Need a permit to:

- Replace materials with like materials such as: A toilet, a sink, windows or doors of the same size, siding, bathtub, refrigerator, stove, dishwasher, or sump pumps. Exceptions to this rule are Hot Water Heaters, Furnaces and Roofs - these items need a permit even if you are just replacing the old one.

### You Do Need a permit to:

- Build a fence, build a deck or porch, put up swimming pools over 24" high, add or subtract any square footage to your home, demolish a building or extending your electrical circuits.

We only charge a modest fee for permits. It is very important to have a permit on file for insurance purposes or when a real estate transaction occurs. Plus you have an extra set of eyes watching what a contractor is doing or even to watch what homeowners are doing. There are additional fees/fines if you are caught starting a project without a permit. Please save yourself some money and call ahead.
