City of Laurel honored by Mississippi Urban Forest Council

The City of Laurel was awarded the Tree City USA certification for 2016 by the Mississippi Urban Forest Council at a recent city council meeting. Laurel is one of the cities in the state qualifying for the recognition. This is the 33rd consecutive year that Laurel has received the title and has been recognized statewide for its outstanding work in urban forestry by the Mississippi Forestry Commission and the Mississippi Urban Forest Council.

This distinction is especially important, as Laurel is the oldest Tree City in the State of Mississippi. Tree City USA is awarded to those sites that fulfill four requirements. These include: a tree board, a tree ordinance, an urban forest management program supported by a minimum budget of

\$2 per capita, and an observance and proclamation of Arbor Day. The Tree City USA program, sponsored by the Arbor Day Foundation in cooperation with the USDA Forest Service and the National Association of State Foresters, provides direction, technical assistance, public attention and national recognition for urban and community forestry programs in thousands of towns and cities that more than 135 million Americans call home.

Trees yield 3–5 times their cost in overall benefits to the city in a number of ways: reducing costs for energy, storm water management, and erosion control. Studies indicate that as few as three additional trees planted around each building cut energy



Travis Mac Haynes enters race for District 89 Representative

For the first time in 25 years, District 89 in Jones County will be sending a new representative to Jackson. In September, Travis Mac Haynes, a conservative, businessminded attorney, decided to enter the race at the urging of many in the local business community. Mr. Haynes is a



native of Ellisville, graduating from both South Jones High School and Jones County Junior College. After leaving Ellisville, Travis continued his education, receiving a Masters in Business Administration and a Law Degree. While in Jackson attending Law School, Mr. Haynes worked at the state Capitol as a clerk for the MS Conservative Coalition. Once finishing his education and gaining some valuable

work experience, Travis moved back to Jones County to start his family. He, his wife, Tracy, and their two children reside in Ellisville.





Counted cross-stitch, pastels, acrylics in new show at OLLI gallery

A show featuring the works of two OLLI artists, Linda Foshee and Dr. Tim Orsi, is currently hanging in the gallery at the Peck House, headquarters for the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI). The gallery is located at 3601 Pearl St., Hattiesburg. The show will remain in OLLI's Gallery through December 30. Daily viewing times are Monday thru Friday, 1:00 until 4:00 p.m., except on holidays. There is no admission charge.

Foshee's presentation in the show consists of two stamped cross-stitch patterns and one counted cross-stitch pattern. She offers a word to anyone who may be thinking of beginning counted cross-stitch: "Begin simply with stamped cross-stitch patterns before moving up to counted patterns. Counted cross-stitch allows for more color variation and finer gradients of color and detail which causes the resemblance to a painting."

Foshee is a native of Laurel, Mississippi. After earning a Bachelor of music education degree from The University of Southern Mississippi (USM), she taught music in the elementary classroom for ten years. In 1975, Linda returned to her alma mater, where she worked for twenty-eight (28) years as administrative secretary to the director of the School of Music. She retired from USM in 2004. Linda is married to Jamie Foshee, a retired band director.

Dr. Orsi's presentation in the OLLI show consists of over 20 pieces in a variety of media including watercolor, graphite, pastel, and acrylics. In his professional career, Dr. Orsi traveled and worked around the world in a number of positions, the last being geology instructor at USM. His more recent interests have been in the fine arts. Having no experience in the arts, he began drawing exclusively in graphite in December 2013 before incorporating color (acrylics and pastels) in 2015. His influences are numerous but some of the more influential include the contemporary abstractionists Katherine Chang Liu and Alexander Nepo-

te and the watercolorist Gerald Brommer. Dr. Orsi is essentially self-taught, although he is an active participant in OL-LI's SIG (Special Interest Group) and has received additional training from Brandi Downs and Tasha Messer at Art Cetera in Hattiesburg. Most recently, he began to study creative photography and is presently being mentored by the international life style and travel photographer Steven Vote from Australia.


AEE Student of the Month from South Jones
