



If you will be burning wood, have your chimney inspected by a qualified chimney professional to make sure it is in good operating condition and free of creosote buildup.

Wreck It Exercise Tests County Preparedness

[Mount Morris, New York] – The Livingston County Department of Health, Emergency Management Office, UR Noyes and other community partners participated in a regional exercise entitled Wreck It. This exercise contained activities that included discussion and operations based activities, which was conducted for five days throughout Western Region of New York State beginning on October 31, 2016. Objectives of the drill included evaluation of the ability of regional partners to gain, maintain, and assess internal and external situational awareness and informational sharing relative to status and resource needs for the first 72 hours of a major weather event, evaluation of regional partner's ability to activate Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in anticipation of a major weather event, identification of the regional mass care capabilities with the first 48 hours of an event, demonstration of the agency/community/region's ability to perform resource management throughout a major weather event, and identification of volunteer resource coordination metrics that would be required during a major weather event.

Livingston County Department of Health developed media and outreach messages to educate the public regarding weather related issues, participated at the Incident Command Center, completed a patient capacity survey, and discussed the Department's Continuity of Operations Plan. Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director stated, "This exercise provided an opportunity to work with key stakeholders in the community and to test our level of preparedness for a similar event".

The Noyes emergency preparedness team assessed the facilities needs for the upcoming 48 hours to provide care for the community and their staff. This included not only medical care but also things like fuel, water, and basic supplies. They also used their mass communication system to alert all employees of the drill and what their expected response would be if this had been a real emergency. On day two of the drill they reviewed the needs of the facility and the community should the disaster go on for more than 48 hours and identified other community and government resources that would be available.






