What does it mean when a lawyer says "no recovery, no fee"?

Brad, Tuscumbia, Alabama

Your question addresses a contingency fee contract. This simply means the attorney gets paid only if he recovers money.

Contingency fee contracts provide a percentage of the damages awarded to the injured party as compensation for the lawyer. A standard automobile accident contingency fee is 40%. More difficult cases such as product liability and medical malpractice cases are based on contingency fee of 50% of the damages awarded. This accounts for the risk associated with incurring costs by the lawyer.

One of the last cases I had, our firm incurred over \$140,000.00 in

expenses. That was a risk taken based on the facts of that case and in that case it paid off. Not all of them do.

Defense lawyers are paid by an insurance company and they are paid by the hour. Those lawyers are paid no matter what the outcome. The injured party's lawyer, under a contingency fee contract, is only paid if he wins.

They teach in law school all "tort" cases require a

duty, a breach of that duty, and an injury as a direct result of that breach. What they don't teach in law school, but should, is that it requires a fourth element and that is someone with money to pay the damages in the event you win.

In a state like Alabama where you have mandatory automobile insurance laws you know as a juror that there is insurance on the other side or that lawyer representing the injured party wouldn't be there.

A contingency fee contract is truly the peoples' key to the courthouse. It doesn't require payment up front to hire a lawyer and that lawyer is only paid at the end of the case if there is a recovery.

Buckle up and drive safely.

A FEW WEEKS AGO I WROTE about where 300 million Yahoo accounts were hacked. That means the accounts were taken over by criminals that can scour the victims emails looking for banking information, associated

friends, and other goodies they can take advantage of.

Since that time I've received a couple of calls from clients inquiring about the legitimacy of some emails they've received from Yahoo

members.
So, here is an updated version of an old article that I hope will serve as a reminder to be skeptical of anything out of the normal when it comes to computers.

I received a call from a friend. Let's call her "Mabel" just because I think that name is funny. She excitedly explained that her email account had been hacked. Someone using her name sent the following email to all her friends in her Contacts list telling them that she, Mabel, was stranded in London and needed money. The misspellings and punctuation errors are not mine (this time):

The message from Mabel read, "I'm stuck in London, England right now, I came down here for a short vacation then i was robbed, worse of it

is that bags, cash and cards and my cell phone were stolen at GUN POINT, it's such a crazy experience for me, Please i need you to loan me some money, will refund you as soon as i'm back home, i promise. All i need is (\$900 USD) but dont know how much you would be able to spare...we will be waiting to hear back from you on how you can get the fund to me please."

The recipient of this email is usually asked to go to a CVS pharmacy or convenience store and wire a Moneygram to the hapless "victim." If you ever get scammed by anyone, you

can usually call your credit card company and get the charges reversed. However, that is not the case with this kind of scam. By purchasing a money card, you are essentially withdrawing cash from your credit card account and putting it on a different kind of card to give to someone. If you call your credit card company to report this after you've been scammed, they will probably rudely snicker at you.

So, I'm sure you already know what to do if you happen to receive an email like this: Just ignore it. And maybe call your friend to give them a heads up. However, if you find yourself locked out of your own email account--especially a Yahoo account--you may be a victim of this scam and your friends may be receiving these kinds of messages as we speak. There is

not much you can do besides contact your email provider and beg them to let you back into your account. Otherwise, y'all are just going to have to be skeptical of anyone asking for money over the internet. Besides me, of course.

#### **Medicare Minute**

#### "Prescription Drug Plans"

October 15th through December 7th is a period of time that Medicare has set aside to make changes to your Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) or Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) if you want. Whether you have a Medicare supplement and a stand-alone drug plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan with prescription drug coverage now is the time to review your drug plan for 2017. Like MA plans, drug plans have certain things you want to look at when considering which PDP is best for you. Those things are premium, deductibles, copays, coinsurance and the plan's provider network.

Although the things listed above are most important so are the tiers that drugs are place into. So before we discuss the cost of the plans let's look at drug plan tiers. Normally there are five tiers to a drug plan. Tier 1 and Tier 2 drugs are usually your most common generic drugs. Tier 3 drugs are preferred brand, Tier 4 drugs are non-preferred brand and Tier 5 drugs are specialty drugs. One of the most misunderstood parts of a drug plan is the tier a person's drug is in.

Many people we meet with think that if their drug is listed in a certain tier under their current PDP it's the same on all plans. This is not always true. Sometimes, for example, a drug may be listed a Tier 2 under one plan but may be a Tier 3 under another plan. Why is this important? Because in most drug plans the copays are higher for Tier 3 than Tier 2.

You can check the tiers of your drugs by looking at the plan's formulary. The formulary is a list of the drugs that are covered by the plan. You can get the formulary of the plan you are considering by going to the plan's website, going online to Medicare.gov or you can visit our office and we can help.







In addition to the school's tradition, there's a family tradition to this story. Coach Ieffreys's son, Tyler, was the Indians starting quarterback from 2013-2015. When When the Indians entered this year's playoffs, they were seeking the school's seventh football state championship. Regardless of the outcome, Colbert County High School has one of the state's richest football traditions.
