

WINNSBORO – In recognition of his service to the Autumn Trails Association and his community, The Winnsboro News dedicates the 2015 Autumn Trails Edition to the late Henry Whitley

Prior to coming on board with Autumn Trails, Whitley was heavily involved in the Trail Riders Association and the rodeo association.

"He was president of the Trail Riders Association for years," remembered his son, Stephen, now a professor of English at Collin College in Plano. "He was also president of the rodeo association."

His contacts in the rodeo world were helpful when the AT Associa-

"When the Autumn Trails Association decided to have a rodeo associated with the October festivities, they called on Henry to head it up, and asked him to be on the board," remembered his widow, Linda Whitley.

Whitley had three other children, Patricia Teague, Class of 1967, David Mike Whitley, Class of 1969 and Melissa Lenhardt, Class of 1988, along with four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

He and Linda were married 45 years at the time of his death in 2008.

He was also a member of the Lions Club, Wood County Crime Stoppers, president of the Smyrna Cemetery board, chaplain of the American Legion and was a member of the First Baptist Church of Winnsboro.

He retired from a 27-year career as a service manager for Pilgrim Industries. Records reflect that Whitley was on the Autumn Trails Board of Directors from 1991-1995, serving as vice president the final two years.

Whitley hired men who worked on his farm to help get the arena ready for the October

event, but that doesn't mean he – and his family – weren't busy. 'As far as he was concerned, all other activities, family and otherwise, stopped," Linda

ecalled. "He spent many hours coordinating everything and enlisting help from his Stephen, who earned a Ph.D. in composition and rhetoric in 2014, said his dad's connec-

tions with rodeo producers helped get the ball rolling, too.

Linda remembered working the concession stand and "putting our social life on hold" until the October event was over.

The Whitleys, like most of those in Winnsboro and the surrounding area, made the trail ride a family affair.

"We had a lot of traditions surrounding the trail ride," Stephen remembered. "Most of them centered around food. Mom made sausage balls and we had steaming cups of coffee

Linda says she loved "getting together with friends and family and riding horses."

Stephen, who was a member of the WHS Class of 1985, said for years his dad hired Joe Stokes to drive the tractor for their hay trailer.

"Joe drove so Daddy could ride," Štephen recalled. "Now that I think about it, he was a good rider. He was calm, and even if his horse started acting

up, it never seemed to bother him.

The News' copy/arts editor Terry Hamilton Mathews has fond memories of Whitley from the early days.

"One of the first years of the ride, my little horse and I played out at the turnoff to Latta's Park," Mathews recalled. 'Henry asked Taft Tinney to load us up in his trailer and make sure we got safely home

When told of the dedication, Linda said, "Thank you so much for remembering Henry in such a wonderful way. He loved this town.'

DRIVING TO THE PACIFIC AND BACK

Tumbleweed Smith



We drove to Carlsbad, California to meet our two sons and their families for a long weekend visit. It was a leisurely drive westward, with stops in Las Cruces, New Mexico and Yuma, Arizona. It's about a thousand-mile trip and the most we drove in one day was about 400 miles. We played in the surf, walked along the beach and some of

our group went to LEGOLAND. It was a relaxing trip, with all Tumbleweed Smith nine of us sharing meals together. In the evenings we played games and visited. I don't think we even turned on the television.

We journeyed down to San Diego to visit a wild game park and tour the famous movie star hangout, the Hotel del Coronado (known as THE DEL). When everybody departed for home and went their separate ways, they did so with a good feeling about our time together. With everybody's busy schedules (especially those for the 9 and 12-year olds) it's difficult to get together. But we make time for reunions.


On our return trip we stayed in Tucson and El Paso. I was smitten by Tucson, with its location and architecture. Homes are of the old adobe style, and blend perfectly with the desert landscape. They are one story, low and long, and reflect the area's Native American and Spanish histories. Saguaro cactus and other desert flowers and plants surround the structures.

We had a few hours before time to leave for El Paso, so we picked up a brochure that indicated a scenic drive around Mount Lemmon, a little over 9,000 feet high located in the Coronado National Forest. We followed directions on the brochure, which led us to a place called Oracle. We stopped for coffee at a small café and talked to some folks there about the scenic drive. One man who seemed to be the local historian said, "I hope you have a 4-wheel drive vehicle. That road is not paved." He said he had driven over it recently in a jeep and was glad to finally reach the highway. "It's just 26 miles long but took hours," he said. I told him I was driving a crossover SUV and he said, "You might be all right." So we ven-

The road is dirt and gravel and is just a series of twists and turns that go all the way to the top of the mountain. We never traveled more than ten miles an hour and when we did, it felt like we were flying. We were always going uphill on the narrow road that skirted the edge of some sheer drop-offs that led to deep canyons below. As we climbed up the dangerous road, I considered all the things that might happen to us. We had no phone service. What if he car got hot (it was 117 degrees down below) or we blew a tire? We were in the wilderness. Nobody around for miles. Just beautiful mountain scenery and 70 degree temperatures which tended to lose their fascination. We were ready for pavement. After about 5 hours on that road we finally reached a highway. We went back to Tucson on what is called the Catalina Highway, which offered spectacular views. Why didn't we just take that road to begin with? We wrote the tourist office and suggested a change in the brochure's map showing the scenic highway.


