



ASK THE **ATTORNEY**

WHAT DOES YOUR LAWYER OWE YOU?

From time to time I have discussed lawyers are paid, either through an hourly basis or a contingency fee contract which is what we do and appropriate in personal injury cases where the lawyer risks his time and money in exchange for the privilege of representing injured

people for a percentage of the recovery.

One of my favorite lawyer jokes is where a lady asks a lawyer, "How much do you charge? The lawyer said, "\$50 for three questions." The lady replied, "Isn't that a lot?" The lawyer said, "Yes it is; what's your last question?

So, what does your lawyer owe you? The first thing is an absolute duty of confidentiality. There is certainly an obligation to know or research the area of the law that the client is concerned with. Lawyers have to work hard to understand all of the aspects of a case, including evidence issues, time and money concerns and the impression that the client or their witnesses will make on a judge and jury.

I think lawyers owe their clients the duty to be absolutely straight forward when talking about their case. I have had countless people come in and tell me that another lawyer had said that they didn't have time to take their case. What that means is that there is no money in the case or the lawyer perceives that the client cannot afford his services. Occasionally, people just come in with motives that are just incompatible with the values that the lawyer feels comfortable working with. Tell the client why you will or will not take the case. Tell the client what value your service adds to the client's issue at hand. Make the client feel comfortable with the issues in his or her case and if a deposition will be involved, talk with them about what a deposition is and let them read a deposition. Talk with them about what they will be asked and what they are afraid they will be asked. It's the lawyer's job to help the client be as effective as possible in presenting their case.

Your lawyer owes you the duty to be competent in the area of law where you need help and owes you the duty to put your interests first every time.







My Turn, by Major Euell White, U.S. Army, (retired) WE WON! NOW WHAT?

I was both surprised and elated by the results of the election. However, the election of a Republican President and Congress does not guarantee that the serious problems we face will be fixed. We, the voters, must hold the Trump Administration and both houses of Congress responsible to follow through with the promises they made in the party platform. Here are some of the problems that must be addressed.

For national security we must return the armed forces to the mission of being ready to defend our nation rather than social engineering. This will require a housecleaning in the departments of Defense, Army, Navy, and Air Force. All of the regulations giving preference to homosexuals, lesbians, bisexuals, and transsexuals must be rescinded. Removing the department secretaries is a good start but the bureaucrats at all levels that are in league with them must also be removed. The article in the manual for courts-martial that made sodomy a punishable offense should be restored. At the very least the "don't ask don't tell" should be restored.

The constitutional freedom of religion must be restored for the military. Currently Christian chaplains are very restricted in their ministry to the service members. Service members have been punished for having Bibles, for expressing their beliefs that homosexuality is sin and for not believing in homosexual marriage. Several years ago an Army officer wrote a letter to a military magazine questioning the necessity of ethics and morality is qualifications for military officers. The response was a firestorm of letters from army officers as well as civilians horrified that anyone, especially an army officer, would even pose such a question. The response was unanimous that morality is the basis for integrity without which that institution could not survive as a viable defense force for our nation.

Now the commander-in-chief of our Armed Forces, along with many other politicians are promoting immorality and requiring that it be accepted by our service men and women. The generals and admirals go along and pretend that it is OK so that they can keep their stars. The new administration must completely reverse this.

HEARTWORM HAZARDS

What you don't know about heartworm disease can hurt your dog or cat

ou've probably seen a dusty jar of long, spaghettilike worms in Lyour veterinarian's office. They're heartworms (Dirofilaria immitis), and they are deadly to dogs and cats. The internal parasites make themselves at home in the heart and lungs, causing heart failure and lung disease and potentially migrating to the brain, eye and spinal cord. Here are seven things you might not know about heartworm disease:

1. Heartworms are transmitted by more than 70 species of mosquitoes. Some of these mosquitoes don't need standing bodies of water to reproduce. They thrive in small areas, such as downspouts, gutters and flowerpots and adapt well to cold weather.

2. The incidence of heartworm disease is rising. Between 2013 and 2015, the Companion Animal Parasite Council saw a 166 percent increase in reported positive heartworm cases. That's because nationwide, only about 35 percent of dogs are on preventive medication, says C. Thomas Nelson, DVM, who practices in Anniston, Alabama, and is a spokesperson for the American Heartworm Society. On the West Coast, it's only 16 to 18 percent. In the Southeast, where heartworms are especially prevalent, it's about 26 percent.

3. Heartworm disease has been found in pets in all 50 states. "Owners carry their dogs with them a lot," says parasitologist John W. McCall, Ph.D., professor emeritus in the department of infectious diseases at the University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine. "They go from the north to the south, and they just don't really think that they're going into an area where there's mosquitoes. Many owners don't even know heartworm is transmitted by mosquitoes."

4. Cats can get heartworm disease. They are not as susceptible as dogs, but the worms can cause more serious problems in cats. Larvae in the lungs lead to what's called heartwormassociated respiratory disease (HARD), which has signs similar to feline asthma. It's worse if worms manage to develop to the adult stage.


"The clinical signs associated with the presence of a couple of adult worms in the cat's pulmonary artery are usually very severe, ranging from acute respiratory distress to sudden death as a result of severe inflammation and pulmonary embolism," says Romain Pariaut, DVM, an internal medicine specialist and associate professor of cardiology at Cornell University College of Veterinary Medicine in Ithaca, New York.

5. Preventive medication is recommended year-round for dogs and cats in all areas. One reason is because mosquitoes are more widespread. Another is that longer bouts of warm weather and shorter bouts of cold weather mean mosquitoes are seen year-round in most areas.

6. Heartworms are becoming resistant to preventive products. Bacteria, viruses and parasites such as heartworms eventually become resistant to drugs used against them, McCall says. The current drugs have been used for almost 30 years.

'We don't really know how much of a problem it is," he says, "but the longer we use the products, the more likely it is to occur."

7. Experts recommend combining preventive with a dog-safe mosquito repellent. Even though preventive medication is highly effective, it's not failproof, especially in areas where heartworms have become resistant. Based on a study McCall did using Vectra 3D, which repels and kills mosquitoes, combining heartworm preventive with the topical parasiticide was 100 percent effective



Due to heartworm resistance, even pets who are on year-round preventive have been diagnosed with heartworm disease, but using preventive in tandem with mosquito repellent reduces that risk, a study shows.

in blocking transmission of microfilariae (immature heartworms) from dogs to mosquitoes — a necessary part of the heartworm lifecycle — and more than 95 percent effective in repelling and killing mosquitoes for 28 days after treatment.

"If the dog is treated, the mosquito can't bite the dog and it can't transmit the infective larvae to the dog," McCall says. "It will pretty much keep the dog protected, even when there's a high degree of resistance." The product is not safe for use on cats, but cats who live with dogs who are protected share the benefit.

More retirement homes permit pets

· TigerPlace, a retirement community in Columbia, MO, is a pet lover's dream. Residents can keep their pets with them and benefit from an pet care staff that helps walk, feed and care for the pets as needed. Allowing pets and providing pet-care services is a growing trend at retirement communities. TigerPlace, with 90 residents, is operated in collaboration with the Sinclair School of Nursing at the University of Missouri. Rebecca Johnson, director of the Research Center for Human-Animal Interaction at MU's College of Veterinary Medicine, says pets encourage people to walk, decrease loneliness and promote social interactions with other people.

 Prehistoric best friend? Scientists in Siberia are studying the mummified remains including skin, hair, internal organs and stomach contents — of two unusually well-preserved puppies thought to have died in a landslide more than 12,000 years ago. Amazingly, the brain of one is intact, the first-ever completely preserved brain of a Pleistocene canid. DNA tests on the first puppy, found five years ago, confirm dog rather than wolf ancestry, but the genetic makeup of ancient dogs and wolves is similar. The pups' genomes will be further evaluated in the hope of learning more about canine domestication and evolution.

· A veterinarian at the University of Wisconsin School of Veterinary Medicine is working with physicians to test a new delivery method for a canine melanoma vaccine. according to an article by David Wahlberg in the Wisconsin State Journal. David Vail, DVM, is testing a modified tattoo gun with multiple punctures, which may induce a stronger immune reaction than a single injection. The canine melanoma vaccine, an immunotherapy approach that works to prevent the skin cancer from spreading, was approved in 2010 and is currently injected intramuscularly. If the new approach works in pet dogs, it could also benefit humans.

Medicare Minute

"Prescription Drug Plans 2"

When looking at a prescription drug plan the first thing that most people look at is how much the plan cost. There are drug plans that cost less than \$20. There are also plans that cost more than \$100. Conventional wisdom tells us that something that cost \$100 has to be better than something that cost \$20, but when talking about Medicare prescription drug plans this isn't necessarily true. You have to look deeper than the premium of the plan to see if it's the right fit for you.

One important part of a drug plan is the deductible phase of the plan. A deductible is the amount of money you must pay out of your pocket before your plan will begin to pay. For example, if your plan has a \$400 deductible you may have to pay the first \$400 before the plan will pay. The good news is plans treat deductibles differently. Some plans have deductibles on all tiers of drugs. On some plans the deductible only pertains to tier 3, 4 or 5 drugs but not tier 1 or 2 drugs. Other plans have no deductible at all. The way to know if your plan has a deductible on the prescriptions you are taking is to look at the plan's Formulary to find your drug's tier and the Summary of Benefits to see if you have a deductible.

You will also want to know if the plan requires you to pay a coinsurance on any of your prescriptions. A coinsurance is a percentage you will pay on your prescription. A lot of plans have a coinsurance on tier 4 and tier 5 prescriptions. This means if you have a coinsurance of 20% on your prescription, and the prescription retails for \$500, you would pay 20% or \$100. Next week we will look at copays, formularies and provider networks.



You might want to check into an HŠA (Health Savings Account) type of plan within the exchanges. Another thing you could look at is one of the medical sharing programs through a Christian organization such as Christian Healthcare Ministries.



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that oven temperatures should be no lower than 325° and turkeys should be completely thawed before cooking. A food thermometer must register a safe minimum temperature of 165° inside a turkey before it is served.

People with food allergies who have not prepared their own meals at home should ask about the ingredients and how food was prepared to prevent exposure to allergens.

COMMON INJURIES

One of the most common injuries during the Thanksgiving holiday is cuts with knives – specifically carving knives that cut fingers or hands. Be careful when slicing food, and more specifically, do not rush. If possible, allow someone who is experienced in handling sharp knives to do the carving.

Burns are another common injury during Thanksgiving. The kitchen can be a dangerous place, especially around the oven and grill.

A special note of caution is given for anyone who deep fries a turkey. This can be very dangerous and cause serious burns and fires, especially if you have never attempted this before. Make sure to carefully research the proper way to "deep fry"

home or any flammable structure. Never attempt to deep fry a frozen turkey.

EATING SAFELY

The key is to approach the Thanksgiving meal with moderation. Food is usually abundant and for some it is too much and consumed too quickly. For those with medical conditions such as congestive heart failure, kidney disease and high blood pressure, excess salt is dangerous. Monitor your sodium intake and make sure you take any necessary prescription medications as you would any other day. Consult your doctor if necessary. Eat food slowly and when satisfied take a break and allow your body to process it. Eating too quickly can cause heartburn, indigestion, create chest and may pain, which could require medical assessment.

INJURY PREVENTION

Before or after the meal, it's common for many to head outside and play sports (football, basketball, etc.). Weekend warriors beware! Injuries can occur for those not used to routine Emergency recommend physicians having fun and going easy - not overdoing it. It's important to pace yourself after a big meal. For those not used to regular physical activity, you might want to reconsider and participate in a different activity. Emergency physicians see many sprains, strains, and fractures in those who try to do too much too quickly. We also treat patients who develop shortness of breath and chest pain from overextension.






