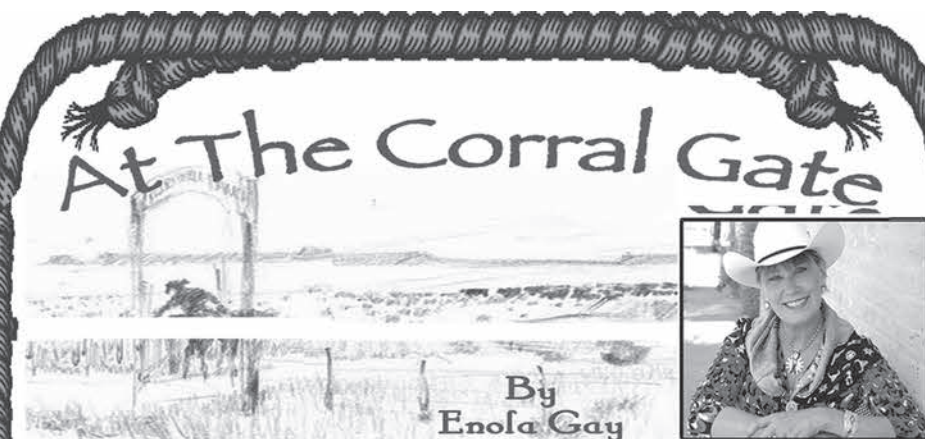

Kay Bailey Hutchinson

Former US Senator Representing Texas



Kay Bailey Hutchinson (born Kathryn Ann Bailey; July 22, 1943) is a former United States Senator from Texas. She is a member of the Republican Party. In 2001, she was named one of the thirty most powerful women in America by Ladies Home Journal. The first woman to represent Texas in the U.S. Senate, Hutchinson also became the first Texas U.S. senator to receive more than four million votes in a single election.



Hutchinson was the most senior female Republican senator by the end of her tenure, and the fifth most senior female senator, having assumed office in June 1993 behind Senators Barbara Mikulski (D-MD, 1987), Dianne Feinstein (D-CA, 1992), Barbara Boxer (D-CA, Jan. 1993), and Patty Murray (D-WA, Jan. 1993).

In 2012, she joined the law firm Bracewell & Giuliani.

Hutchinson was born Kathryn Ann Bailey in Galveston, the daughter of Kathryn Ella (née Sharp) and Allan Abner Bailey, Jr., an insurance agent. She has two brothers, Allan and Frank. Hutchinson grew up in La Marque, Texas.

She married her first husband, John Pierce Parks, a medical student, on April 8, 1967 (age 23); they divorced in 1969. She married her second husband, Ray Hutchinson, in Dallas on March 16, 1978. They have two adopted children: Kathryn Bailey and Houston Taylor, both adopted in 2001. She also has two stepdaughters, Brenda and Julie, from her husband's previous marriage. Ray Hutchinson is a former member of the Texas Legislature, a former state Republican chairman, and ran an unsuccessful bid for the Texas governorship, having lost the Republican nomination in 1978 to Bill Clements, a senior partner with the law firm of Vinson & Elkins, of Dallas.

Hutchinson and her family have their primary residence in Dallas, where her children attend school. She has a second house in Virginia, where she lives when the Senate is in session. In August 2009 she put her Virginia house up for sale, and her campaign stated, "She's no longer going to be in the United States Senate. She's coming home to Texas. That's why it's for sale." She has also purchased a house in Nacogdoches, Texas. She is a supporter of the Multiple Myeloma Research Foundation where she is an honorary board member.

She received her Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Texas at Austin in 1962 (age 19). She was also a sister of the Pi Beta Phi Fraternity. She received her J.D. from the University of Texas School of Law in 1967 (age 24). Following her graduation from law school, she was the legal and political correspondent for KPRC-TV in Houston. Hired by Ray Miller, host of the long-running The Eyes of Texas anthology series, Hutchinson was among the first onscreen newswomen in Texas.

In 1972 (age 29), Hutchinson was elected to the Texas House of Representatives from a district in Houston. She served until 1976. She was vice-chairman of the National Transportation Safety Board from 1976 to 1978. She was a candidate for the United States House of Representatives in 1982 for the Dallas-based 3rd District, but was defeated in the primary by Steve Bartlett. She temporarily left politics and became a bank executive and businesswoman.

Kay Bailey Hutchinson was a bank executive of a failed bank in Texas and met and married her second husband Ray Hutchinson who was the chairman of the Texas Republican Party in 1976 but left in 1977 to pursue his gubernatorial campaign. In 1978, Ray Hutchinson lost the nomination to Bill Clements by a vote of 115,345 (72.8 percent) to 38,268 (24.2 percent). Kay met Ray when they were both Texas legislators, and Kay's interest in politics grew exponentially.

Hutchinson's husband, Ray Hutchinson died on March 30, 2014. He was 81. Ray Hutchinson was the chairman of the Texas Republican Party from 1976 to 1977 and ran in the following year's GOP primary for governor but lost to Bill Clements. He served as a state representative for Dallas' district 33-Q from 1973 to 1977. While serving in the state Legislature, he met wife Kay Bailey, then a representative from Houston. They married in 1978 and had two children. He already had two children from a previous marriage. Ray Hutchinson was senior counsel with the law firm Bracewell & Giuliani LLP. His principal area of practice is public finance, making slightly less than a half million dollars a year in combined salary and deferred compensation.

In addition to her husband's compensation as an attorney, records provided by her campaign show that the couple has a large financial stake in ExxonMobil, valued at between \$250,000 and \$500,000, along with other stock holdings and equity investments, which have also provided them with a yearly dividend income of about \$60,000 a year since 2001. The Hutchinson family reported assets of between \$2.8 million and \$6.7 million in 2008, not including homes used for residential purposes, Senate records show. The Senate records give ranges of asset value, making an exact calculation impossible.

Hutchinson served on the following Senate committees: Appropriations; Commerce, Science and Transportation; Rules and Administration; Veterans' Affairs. During her time in the Senate, Hutchinson has been a strong supporter of NASA.

In June 2000, Hutchinson and her Senate colleagues coauthored *Nine and Counting: The Women of the Senate*. In 2004, her book, *American Heroines: The Spirited Women Who Shaped Our Country*, was published.

From 2001 to 2007, Hutchinson served as Chairwoman of the Senate Republican Conference (caucus), making her the fifth-ranking Republican in the Senate behind Majority Leader Bill Frist, Majority Whip Mitch McConnell and conference chairman Rick Santorum, and Policy Chairman Jon Kyl. In 2007, Hutchinson succeeded Jon Kyl as the Policy Chair for Senate Republicans, the fourth ranking leadership position in the Republican caucus behind Minority Leader McConnell, Minority Whip, and conference chairman Kyl.

The National Journal ranked Hutchinson as follows in its 2004 rankings, which are based on various key votes relating to economic policy, social policy, and foreign policy: "Economic: 26% Liberal, 73% Conservative; Social: 38% Liberal, 60% Conservative; Foreign: 0% Liberal, 67% Conservative. Although a loyal conservative Republican, she has been known to cross over to the other side on a few issues. She is more likely to do this than either Phil Gramm or his successor John Cornyn." A poll that was released on June 19, 2007, showed that Hutchinson had an approval rating of 58%, with 34% disapproving.

The National Journal's opinion is disputed by many Texas Republicans and Tea Party members, however. Konni Burton, a member of the Northeast Tarrant Tea Party steering committee, said "She personifies everything that the Tea Party is fighting. She is a Republican, but when you check her votes on many issues, they are not ones that conservatives are happy with." "On fiscal issues, she is more loyal to her friends and special interests than to the people of Texas," according to Adrian Murray, president of the grassroots 912 Project Fort Worth.

Hutchinson broke ranks with her Republican colleagues and opposed an attempt to stall the Democrats' health-care bill in the Senate.

Hutchinson announced her intention to resign her Senate post in the autumn of 2009 in order to challenge Texas Governor Perry for the Republican Party nomination. State Republican Chairman Cathie Adams later called upon Hutchinson to clarify when she would vacate the Senate so that other Republican candidates can make preparation for their races.

On November 13, 2009, Hutchinson announced that she would not resign from the Senate seat until after the March 2, 2010 primary. On March 31, 2010, she announced her intention to serve out her third term.

On January 13, 2011, after some discussion about whether she would change her mind, Hutchinson announced she would not seek re-election in 2012.

In 2008, she was cited by The New York Times to be among the women most likely to become the first female President of the United States. On June 22, 2011, Hutchinson told Chris Matthews on *Hardball with Chris Matthews* that she had pondered running for president, but said she could not run in the 2012 election because of the needs of her two 10-year-old adopted children.

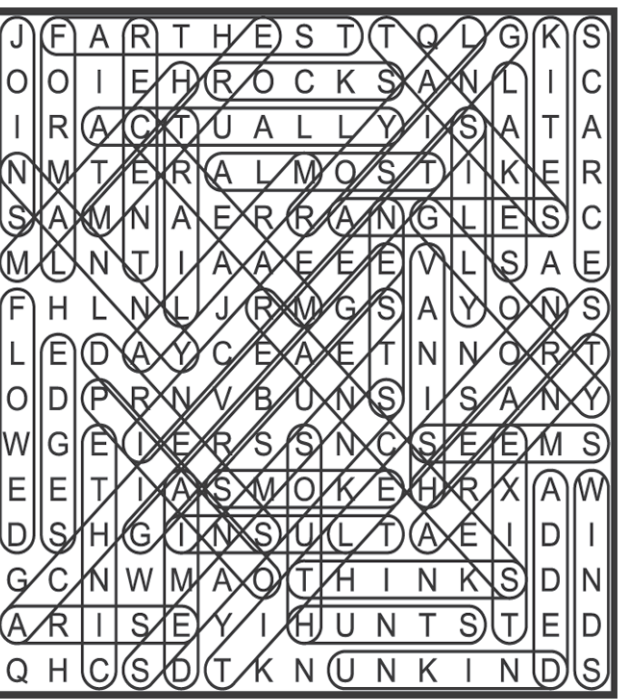

A Summer Without Doldrums....

George Gershwin's 1934 lyrics about summertime "bein' easy" don't fit Texas this year, and Nat King Cole's hit tune of the 1960s about the "lazy/hazy/crazy days" of summer is only one-third fulfilled. The "crazy" reference is a pretty close fit, with or without a wide-angle lens.

For my purposes, I'll soften the word to mean unlikely, unexpected or unusual. Oh, it's anything but "business as usual" for the entire nation, but there's much additional "hub-bub" in the Lone Star State. In Texas, flooding seems unending, civil war statues may be endangered and Confederate money--previously "mattressed"--understandably is being converted from currency to Old South silver. Obviously, throwing the biggest coins at adversaries should be more effective than hurling currency that's likely to be gone with the wind.

And at Aunt Dinah's quilting party, Nellie--the club's only social media practitioner--has issued a request: "Please, no more Confederate flags. We've run out of storage room, and there's a long waiting list for quilters."... *****

New vignettes in cities across America: Wedding officiants--some jubilant, others flummoxed--seem unsure how to conclude ceremonies. Some are saying, "One of you may kiss the bride." Others are simply changing the last word to "groom." In one ceremony, the officiant played it safe, instructing, "You may kiss each other."

Professional wedding planners are writing addendums, such as: "Should your rights to marry be disputed, you

may need a firearm. In that case, we'll rent you one."

There's also considerable quaking at Six Flags Over Texas. Officials are wondering which--if any--of their flags will be favored by majorities big enough to justify flying them at full staff. (It may turn out that no significant doldrums will surface this summer.)... *****

MAHJONGG MANIA IN MILES

I've always considered Mahjongg to be a sophisticated game played mostly in the northeastern states. To my surprise I have learned that the game is gaining in popularity in west and central Texas. And not just in the big cities. Miles is a town of about 800 people. About a dozen women have formed a club and play every Tuesday afternoon in Cherry and Bobby Kasberg's margarita shop (a story by itself). Cherry and Bobby have margarita machines they use in their catering business. Some weddings in places the size of Miles attract a thousand guests, so Cherry and Bobby have to take loads of equipment to satisfy the thirsty guests. They also serve pina colodas, keg beer and other alcoholic delights.

Some 200 people play Mahjongg in San Angelo. They are divided into the Monday group, the Tuesday group and so on and play once a week at a restaurant, church, country club or senior center. The median age is fifty and 99 percent of them are women. They eat and then play three hours or twelve games. Usually one or two people host a month of meetings.

In May of this year, The Tuesday group met in Miles, about a twenty-minute drive from San Angelo. Cherry says the first Tuesday drew just a few people, but the ones who made the trip had so much fun the following Tuesdays saw an increase in the numbers attending. Each night had a theme. One night was Hawaiian and they had a luau. The hostesses actually roasted a pig and wore flowers around their necks. They don't do things halfway in Miles. Cherry has a Mahjongg table that makes all kinds of mechanical moves to line up the tiles and roll the dice.

The last Tuesday of May the entire town went out for the 32 Mahjongg players who came to visit. They arrived around 3 PM and were given a card with the names of ten shops on them. Most of the shops had signs welcoming the visitors. The players were given the opportunity to shop and have their cards stamped at each store. The cards with all the stores stamped were entered into a drawing for \$25. After the shopping spree (the stores stayed open late), the Mahjonggers were treated to a catered meal by Pit Stop Bar-b-que.

The games took place in the historic Miles Opera House. The eight tables had four players each and the games lasted the usual three hours. It was a dark and stormy night. Two bouts of hailstorms came during the evening, but they didn't disturb the players, even though some of the hailstones were the size of baseballs. Some cars were damaged, which gave the women even more to talk about with their friends and neighbors.

Betty Sue Minor is the Mahjongg Queen in San Angelo. She taught the game at Angelo State. She is a self-admitted Mahjongg addict and travels all over the state and beyond convincing others they should play the game. She has a fancy Mahjongg table, too.
