

becomes plugged with wax, which mimics a hearing loss because it blocks sound from reaching your eardrum. Use of a cotton swab will pack wax even more. We will check for impacted wax with a video ear camera to see if this is a problem.

The cochlea is a snail-shaped organ containing thousands of living hair cells called stereocilia. A condition known as Sensorineural hearing loss (nerve type hearing loss) occurs when any of the hair cells become damaged. About 90% of hearing loss is this type. A new hearing computer has now been released that is programmed specifically for the frequencies of hair cells that are damaged, resulting in improved speech understanding.

Tinnitus is the phantom sensation of ringing in the ears. It is the result of damaged or misfiring nerves between the cochlea and the brain. A specialist will identify the tone of your tinnitus and demo how the hearing computer may reduce it.

If You Could Unroll The Cochlea's Tube

In a healthy cochlea, all hair cells are alive and standing upright. As sound waves move through the fluid within the cochlea, each hair cell fires and



Damaged hair cells don't fire properly and some sounds (fricatives and high tones) are not transmitted to the brain. Hair cell damage is a natural part of aging. It can be caused by moderate sounds over long periods, loud sounds over short periods, or even by prescriptions







Investing in Your Dog

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I've had a lot of trouble training my Dalmatian, "Damian," to behave around other dogs and people. It has really limited our outdoors time, which is very disappointing because I always envisioned bringing him around to my favorite neighborhood spots, playing in the dog park and having him in the same room with friends. What can I do to fix his bad behavior? — Jeff T., Atlanta

DEAR JEFF: Although I always stress the importance of daily training in basic behavior, and how important it is to socialize puppies to both human and other dogs, sometimes following these basics still isn't enough.

I think of training as an investment

I think of training as an investment in your dog. The more often you invest, the better the returns in terms of behavior and bonding. However, you've got to consider the quality of that training investment, too — as well as each dog's individual temperament and capacity for learning.

Many inexperienced dog owners learn to train as they go. Some breeds of dogs help them along a bit — I remember as a kid, our family's Golden retriever "Saucy" actually kept us to a routine training and walking schedule — but other dogs aren't so easy to train or willing to learn. They're not bad dogs, just different.

So, when your best efforts aren't quite enough, it's time to look for help. A professional trainer can help you figure out what's going on with Damian, find weak spots in his training regime and offer key techniques that training books often don't have or can't adequately describe. Meet with a few trainers in your area to find the right one, and keep building on that investment — and relationship – with Damian. It's well worth it.

Turn Leftover Turkey Into a Tasty Meal

Into a Tasty Meal

Thanksgiving is gone, but the memories linger on — in the form of leftovers. After having all the traditional Thanksgiving fixings, I always crave spicy foods. I've come to enjoy thinking up ways I can transform the mountain of plastic containers full of a few scoops of this and a few cups of that into a new recipe. I've discovered that leftover turkey combined with Mexican spices makes a great meal! I've used leftover turkey to make soft tacos, quesadillas and enchiladas.

I love this enchilada recipe because the combination of cumin, chili powder and cayenne pepper completely changes the flavor of the leftover turkey, and it's easy to prepare. If you don't have time to make the enchilada sauce from scratch, use a good quality, commercially made sauce, and add the spices from the recipe below to give it a homemade tastel: Serve this dish with a side of Spanish rice and a tossed salad, and you'll not only have a great meal, but a great way to use up that leftover turkey!

SPICY TURKEY ENCHILADAS

- cups cooked turkey, shredded cups sour cream cups shredded cheddar cheese, one cup reserved for topping
- teaspoon salt teaspoon cumin teaspoon chili powder
- teaspoon cayenne pepper (10-inch) tortillas, corn or

 2 cans (4 ounces each)

Enchiladas:

Using a large bowl, bine cooked turkey with sour cream, 2 cups cheese, salt, cumin, chili powder and cayenne pepper. Wrap tortillas in a clean dishcloth or food-safe paper towels and

clean dishcloth or food-safe paper towels and sprinkle both sides with a little water. Microwave for 10-15 seconds to warm and soften.

2. Place a tortilla on a flat surface. Spoon 2 to 3 table-spoons of turkey mixture on the end of the tortilla closest to you. Lightly oil a shallow, 13-by-9-inch bak-ing pan so that the enchila-das won't stick. Roll up the

ing pan so that the enchiladas won't stick. Roll up the tortilla. Arrange it, seam side down in the baking pan, placing each stuffed tortilla side by side until the pan is full.

3. Pour the enchilada sauce over the enchiladas and bake, uncovered at 350 F, for about 25 minutes, or until hot and bubbly. Sprinkle with the remaining cup of cheese. Bake another 5 minutes, Remove pan from the oven; let set for 5-10 minutes before serving. Serves 4 to 6.

To Prepare the Enchilada Sauce:

Quick Tip: A good-quality, commer-cially made chili sauce mixed with a teaspoon each of cumin and chili powder and 1/2 teaspoon of brown

sugar makes a canned enchilada sauce taste like homemade!

1. Using a medium-sized pan, saute chili peppers and onions in oil until onions are soft, about 3 to 5 minutes. Add the garlic, salt, cumin and chili powder, and saute for another minute. Add the stewed tomatoes and brown sugar and saute for 3 to 4 minutes. sugar, and saute for 3 to 4 minutes Stir in the water.

2. Turn heat to high and bring mix-ture to a rolling boil. Then turn the heat to low and simmer, uncovered, until thick, about 15 to 20 minutes.

On older forced-air systems, the entire ductwork should be cleaned every couple of years. Inspect flue pipe for blockages, leaks and holes and make sure vent cap is in place on roof.

• Furnaces—Check fan belts, pilot light, humidifier and media pad if needed. On older furnaces, the pilot light may stay on all the time and you can see it; newer models are usually self-igniting and light only when the furnace is running.

• Humidifiers or Dehumidifiers—For freestanding units, change or clean filters. For furnace-mounted humidifiers, check, clean or replace the water media pad, or water level on float-type humidifiers. Check waterline/ waste line for leaks.

• Hot Water Heaters—Drain about 10 to 15 gallons from service valve, located at bottom of water tank, to remove sediment. If water has slight rust color at first, this is OK; if after draining more than 10

gallons the water still has a rust color, it's a sign the tank is rusting and that you should consider replacement. On natural gas heaters, inspect flue pipe to ensure it is secure and has no leaks. Lowering the temperature of water in the water heater to 115° to 120° reduces fuel consumption.

•An Energy-Efficient Hot Water Circulator—such as the Bell & Gossett ecocirc®—can save an average family of four more than 12,000 gallons of water and hundreds of dollars in energy costs a year.

•Thermostat Setting—68° F is recommended for cold months, 65° F at night. The rule of thumb is that you can save about 3 percent on your heating bill for every degree that you set back your thermostat.

• New Equipment—If equipment needs replacement, call a local professional for at least two quotes. Local, state and federal tax credits and rebates can assist in the purchase of an energy-saving product.

Getting Outdoor Equipment Ready For Winter

(NAPSA)-When it comes to prepping outdoor equipment for winter storage, even an optimist knows that a gas tank that's half full is bad news.

That's because today's gasoline is made with a percentage of ethanol, which can increase the chances of moisture buildup, corrosion and even phase separation in your engine. That can lead to expensive repairs.

Fortunately, there are steps you can take to avoid these and other problems when it's time to start your engines once again.

Don't Drain The Tank

According to small engine expert Tom Bingham, when you leave the fuel level low, it allows water vapor to condense on the walls of your fuel tank. It then runs down the walls and collects in the fuel. This is what causes phase separation. When you start your engine in the spring, this water may run through your fuel system and can cause engine damage or even complete engine failure.

Water in a fuel tank also encourages corrosion. Particularly in today's ethanol-blended fuels, when water and ethanol mix, it can become acidic and very corrosive.

Part of the problem is that when you think your engine is dry, there is still gas in your fuel system in small amounts. These tiny fuel droplets are surrounded by oxygen that can attack unprotected fuel and cause gum and varnish buildup.

Even the smallest amounts of either gum or varnish can cause a lot of damage inside a fuel system. For example, gum can settle on a

seal surface, causing a leak or preventing fuel from flowing into the engine.

A dry fuel system can also damage seals and gaskets. They're designed to be continuously soaked in fuel and play an important role in keeping fuel flowing to the right places in your engine and out of the wrong places. When they are exposed to air for long periods, they can dry out and crack. That can cause leaks and lead to costly repairs.

That's why it's important to stabilize your fuel and practice proper fuel management techniques with any equipment with a gasoline engine.

- On Dec. 4, 1991, Islamic militants in Lebanon release kidnapped American journalist Terry Anderson after 2,454 days in captivity. He was kidnapped on a west Beirut street and held prisoner in an underground dungeon for the next six-and-a-half years.

(NAPSA)—Holiday retail sales are expected to increase anywhere between 3 and 4 percent during the 2015 shopping season, according to estimates by various experts in the industry. That's down slightly from 2014 but higher than the National Retail Federation's 10-year average of 2.5 percent.

But before you pull out the plastic credit cards this year, you should take stock of your financial situa-tion. That means getting a copy of your credit report to gauge your credit payment obligations before the holidays. Consumers can get an annual free copy of their credit report from each of the three nationwide credit bureaus: Equifax,

Experian and TransUnion. Go to annualereditreport.com.

"Better to review what you owe currently before taking on additional debt that might be a strain on your budget," said Stuart K. Pratt, president and CEO of the Consumer Data Industry Association. "Many consumers get caught up in the holiday spirit and focus on the many gifts and presents they want to purchase for family and friends. Then the bills start arriving in January and along with them realization that the payments are due. Budgeting for expenses based on an overview of current credit obligations is a much more responsible way to go

before you hit the shopping mall. If you see something in your report that is wrong, then you will have plenty of time to clear it up. Notify the credit bureau if there is an issue. They will send all the information provided to them to the appropriate lender and then let you know what the resolution is.

Pratt noted that encouraging consumers to get a copy of their free credit report is part of a much larger consumer initiative called the National Consumer Assistance Plan that the nationwide credit bureaus have implemented. "With only about a third of consumers getting their free annual credit report, our goal is to engage with consumers and increase that percentage. Getting your credit report is key to better understanding your personal finances," said Pratt. Studies show that managing credit and debt obligations is a key factor in long-term financial security, he noted. The campaign will roll out over the next several years




