

JODY NIX KEEPS ON FIDDLIN'

In 1960, the drummer in Hoyle Nix's band got sick and couldn't play for a scheduled gig. So Hoyle recruited his 8-year old son Jody to pick up his sticks and get on the bus. Jody played that night and 55 years later he's still playing. But he's not playing drums anymore. His brother Larry taught Jody to play fiddle. The first time he played it in public was at the Stampede Dance Hall in Big Spring. Jody was 11 at the time and joined his dad on stage to play Faded Love. Hoyle introduced

his son by saying, "he's a left handed boy playing a right handed man's fiddle." Jody has a lot to show for his years playing western swing. He has performed at the Kennedy Center as a guest of the Smithsonian. He played for 6,000 people at George H. Bush's presidential inauguration. He has played with Ray Price and other big names. Bob Wills chose Jody and his dad to play on his album, For The Last Time, produced in 1973. Texas, California and Washington have inducted Jody into their Western Swing Halls of Fame.

Jody took over the band when his dad died and has continued to build a large audience. He plays for dances, clubs, rodeos, festivals, and fairs and is invited back year after year. He has played 28 consecutive years at Stamford's Rodeo. Last April he made his 40th consecutive appearance at the Bob Wills Festival in Turkey, Texas, which Jody calls the Super Bowl of Western Swing. He performs somewhere in the southwest about 115 times a year, sometimes booking events two years in the future.


When Hoyle had the band, he had a schedule: Brownfield on Tuesday night, San Angelo Wednesday, Sweetwater Thursday, Abilene Friday and back at the Stampede on Saturdays. He did a radio program on KPET Lamesa Saturdays at noon. The band would be at the Stampede for the broadcast and sent it to the station by a phone line.

The Stampede has been written about in various publications all over the country. Jody plays there on occasion. He has recorded 14 CD's and plans to do 3 more this year: gospel, Christmas and country. His country CD will have Faded Love on it, his most requested song. He has never recorded it, saying nobody could do it better than Bob Wills. He says his band has devised a unique way to present it.

Jody never boasts about his accomplishments unless he's prodded to do so. He is extremely modest about his fame and considers himself lucky to be a natural born musician with God-given talent. He has written a few songs: When It's All Said And Done, Bob Wills Is The One (that brought us all that good Western Swing); I Can Change The Weather Easier Than I Can Change Your Mind and Play Me Something I Can Swing To.

What you don't hear about are the many appearances Jody makes free of charge at nursing homes and retirement centers in Big Spring. He has sung at dozens of funerals. Jody has many friends and enjoys what he does. He has no plans to quit.

Ours is a land of history, a place of hooves and horns, hats and heart. Like Texas and it's neighbor Mexico, Texas and Oklahoma also form a country with a river running through it, vast and fasci-

nating with a dangerous side. This land of the plains, the "Comancheria", is a broad, risk-ridden avenue that stretches straight up through the middle of this land.

Quanah Parker was a Comanche Indian, son of Peta Nocona and Nadua (Cynthia Ann Parker). Though he was known as a chief of his people, the pride of that title did not come without strife and heartache.



According to Wikipedia, Quanah was a youth in 1860 when he lost his beloved mother and sister near the Pease River, a tributary of the Red River. Along with other squaws, Cynthia was run down on horseback on that cold December morning and, clutching her infant daughter, was spared only when the soldiers saw her blue eyes and heard her scream "Americano!" A distance away in a hunting party, Quanah survived the massacre and claims that his father survived too, although other accounts state that Nocona died that day. Cynthia and the baby were carried off like prizes back to Texas and a relative who had spent 25 years and a fortune seeking her. Her eldest son became more than a massacre survivor...he became a survivor of life, honing his skills of communication so that he could live and move among the whites on behalf of his people. He did not let hate overtake him, but pledged love and blessings



to the people of the town that became known as Quanah, Texas. Today, a museum is housed in the grand Quanah, Acme and Pacific Railroad Depot near the downtown square, built along the "Quanah Route" and it is filled with memorabilia and precious items of the proud era.

Steps away on the square, an inscription eads "Dedicated to the memory of the last great Comanche chief, Quanan Parker, who pronounced this blessing on 'his' town, Quanah, Texas; 'May the Great Spirit smile on your little town, may the rain fall in season, and in the warmth of the sunshine after the rain, may the earth yield bountifully. May peace and contentment be with you and your children forever'.

Twelve miles east of Quanah is "Medicine Mounds" which are four sizeable elevations, once Comanche camps and ceremonial sites. A white settlement grew up there, and when the Kansas City, Mexico and Orient Railway was constructed a couple of miles north, the town of Medicine Mounds moved with it, and at one time boasted 500 residents and 22 businesses including a newspaper, The Citizen. In 1940, there was only half the population, in 1955 it's school consolidated with Quanah, and in 2000 there were just 50 people still living there.

Earlier this summer when I visited Quanah, a sign announcing a his torical marker caught my eye, and I stopped at the Medicine Mounds Restaurant which was on the site. The business is unique in that it's dining room and kitchen are made up of two railroad depotst he Medicine Mounds depot and the Quitequay depot. I found out the two

wooden structures were moved, joined and placed alongside Hwy 287 in Quanah as commercial property. A local restaurant family bought it and is making a good living there. When I asked where the historical marker was, I was told it had been stolen! I was also told that Quanah Parker was at one time employed at the Medicine Mounds depot, watching the telegrapher at his work and greeting passengers as they arrived. The Handbook of Texas Online relates that he enjoyed financial success as a cattle rancher and from investments in the Quanah, Acme and Pacific Railroad in the later years of his life. For his 66 years, Quanah Parker was indeed a "man later years of his life. For his 66 years, Quanah Parker was indeed a "man of two worlds", a renowned war chief who also led his people in the tribal adjustment to reservation life and the white man's life.

FAMOUS EXANS



George Walker Bush (born July 6, 1946) is an American politician and businessman who served as the 43rd President of the United States from 2001 to 2009, and the 46th Governor of Texas from 1995 to 2000. The eldest son of Barbara and George H. W. Bush, he was born in New Haven, Connecticut. After graduating from Yale University in 1968 and Harvard Business School in 1975, he worked in oil businesses. He married Laura Welch in 1977 and ran unsuccessfully for the House of Representatives shortly thereafter. He later co-owned the Texas Rangers baseball team before defeating Ann Richards in the 1994 Texas gubernatorial election. He was elected president in 2000 after a close and controversial election, becoming the fourth president to be elected while receiving fewer popular votes nationwide than his opponent. He is the second president to have been the son of a former president, the first having been John Quincy Adams. He is also the brother of Jeb Bush, former Governor of Florida.

Eight months into Bush's first term as president, the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks occurred. In response, Bush launched the War on Terror, an international military campaign which included the war in Afghanistan, launched in 2001 and the war in Iraq, launched in 2003.

In addition to national security issues, Bush also promoted policies on the economy, health care, education, social security reform, and amending the Constitution to prohibit same-sex marriage. He signed into law broad tax cuts, the Patriot Act, the No Child Left Behind Act, the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act, Medicare prescription drug benefits for seniors, and funding for the AIDS relief program known as PEPFAR. His tenure saw national debates on immigration, Social Security, electronic surveillance, and torture.

Bush successfully ran for re-election against Democratic Senator John Kerry in 2004, in another relatively close election. After his re-election, Bush received increasingly heated criticism from across the political spectrum for his handling of the Iraq War, Hurricane Katrina, and numerous other challenges. Amid this criticism, the Democratic Party regained control of Congress in the 2006 elections. In December 2007, the United States entered its longest post-World War II recession, often referred to as the "Great Recession," prompting the Bush Administration to obtain congressional passage of multiple economic programs intended to preserve the country's financial system. Nationally, Bush was both one of the most popular and unpopular presidents in history, having received the highest recorded presidential approval ratings in the wake of the September 11 attacks, as well as one of the lowest approval ratings during the 2008 financial crisis. He was met with public protests even occurring during visits to the United Kingdom.

Bush left office in 2009 and since then, he has returned to Texas and purchased a home in a suburban area of Dallas. He is currently a public speaker, has written a memoir titled Decision Points, and his presidential library was opened in 2013. His presidency has been ranked among the worst in recent surveys of presidential scholars. Although, as with most former presidents, Bush has been viewed more favorably by the public since leaving office.

George Walker Bush was born on July 6, 1946, at Grace-New Haven Hospital (now Yale–New Haven Hospital) in New Haven, Connecticut, as the first child of George Herbert Walker Bush and Barbara Pierce. He was raised in Midland and Houston, Texas, with four siblings, Jeb, Neil, Marvin and Dorothy. Another younger sister, Robin, died from leukemia at the age of three in 1953. His grandfather, Prescott Bush, was a U.S. Senator from Connecticut. His father George H. W. Bush was Ronald Reagan's Vice President from 1981 to 1989 and the 41st U.S. President from 1989 to 1993. Bush has English and some German ancestry, along with more distant Dutch, Welsh, Irish, French, and Scottish roots.

Bush attended public schools in Midland, Texas, until the family moved to Houston after he had completed his 7th grade year. He then went to The Kinkaid School, a prep school in Houston for two years.

Bush finished high school at the Phillips Academy, a boarding school (then all-male) in Andover, Massachusetts, where he played baseball and, during his senior year, was the head cheerleader. He attended Yale University from 1964 to 1968, graduating with a B.A. degree in history. During this time, he was a cheerleader and a member of the Delta Kappa Epsilon, serving as the fraternity's president during his senior year. Bush also became a member of the Skull and Bones society as a senior. Bush was a rugby union player and was on Yale's 1st XV. He characterized himself as an average student. His average during his first three years at Yale was 77 and he had a similar average under a nonnumeric rating system in his final year.

Beginning in the fall of 1973, Bush attended the Harvard Business School, where he earned an M.B.A. degree. As such, he is the only U.S. President to have earned an M.B.A.

In May 1968, Bush was commissioned into the Texas Air National Guard. After two years of active-duty service while training, he was assigned to Houston, flying Convair F-102s with the 147th Reconnaissance Wing out of the Ellington Field Joint Reserve Base. Critics, including former Democratic National Committee Chairman Terry McAuliffe, have alleged that Bush was favorably treated due to his father's political standing as a member of the House of Representatives, citing his selection as a pilot despite his low pilot aptitude test scores and his irregular attendance. In June 2005, the United States Department of Defense released all the records of Bush's Texas Air National Guard service, which remain in its official archives.

In late 1972 and early 1973, he drilled with the 187th Fighter Wing of the Alabama Air National Guard, having moved to Montgomery, Alabama, to work on the unsuccessful U.S. Senate campaign of Republican Winton M. Blount. In 1972, Bush was suspended from flying for failure to take a scheduled physical exam. He was honorably discharged from the Air Force Reserve on November 21, 1974.

At a backyard barbecue in 1977, friends introduced him to Laura Lane Welch, a school teacher and librarian. Bush proposed to her after a three-month courtship, and they married on November 5 of that year. The couple settled in Midland, Texas. Bush left his family's Episcopal Church to join his wife's United Methodist Church. On November 25, 1981, Laura Bush gave birth to fraternal twin daughters, Barbara Pierce Bush and Jenna Welch Bush; they graduated from high school in 2000 and from Yale University and the University of Texas at Austin, respectively, in 2004.

Prior to his marriage, Bush had multiple episodes of alcohol abuse. In one instance, on September 4, 1976, he was arrested near his family's summer home in Kennebunkport, Maine, for driving under the influence of alcohol. He pleaded guilty, was fined \$150 and had his Maine driver's license briefly suspended. Bush says his wife has had a stabilizing effect on his life, and attributes to her influence his 1986 decision to give up alcohol. While Governor of Texas, Bush said of his wife, "I saw an elegant, beautiful woman who turned out not only to be elegant and beautiful, but very smart and willing to put up with my rough edges, and I must confess has smoothed them off over time."

Bush has been an avid reader throughout his adult life, preferring biographies and histories. During his time as president, Bush read the Bible daily. He so read 14 Lincoln biographies and, during the last three years of his presidency, he reportedly read 186 books. A reporter recalls seeing "books by John Fowles, F. Scott Fitzgerald, James Joyce, and Gore Vidal lying about, as well as biographies of Willa Cather and Queen Victoria" in his home when Bush was a Texas oilman. Other hobbies include eigar smoking and golf. Since leaving the White House, Bush has also taken up oil painting. Courtesy of Wickapedia




