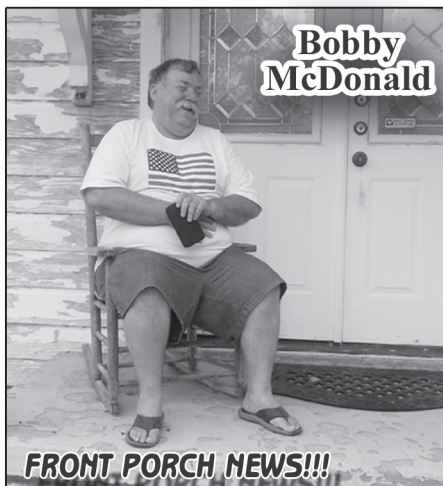

# THE IDLE AMERICAN Aggies to the Rescue?...

There's never been a justifiable basis for Aggie jokes--then or now. Most Texas A&M University students and former students have always known such jokes are that, and nothing more. And a majority of the rest of us agree.

In truth, Texas A&M is, was--and no doubt always will be--one of the nation's most distinguished institutions. Its growth and many successes are evident, and recent years have marked additions of schools.

And amounts of monies to fund research projects are mind-boggling. One recently announced initiative seems critical if Americans can afford to continue their love affair with the beverage that kick-starts their mornings. Texas A&M researchers face a serious challenge....

Not until learning about coffee leaf rust did I realize coffee shortages seem unavoidable, what with climate changes that are responsible for devastating coffee crops in Central America and Brazil.

Adding to the sense of urgency is the 2015 study predicting that 50% of the land used to grow Arabica coffee will be unsuitable for use beyond 2050.

With Americans' taste growing for multiple coffee flavors, we are prone to expect robust coffee crops without interruption. The masses of us are counting on the Aggie researchers to solve the looming problem. If they don't come through, "bottomless coffee cups" featured at some restaurants may go the way of the wild goose.

Hopefully, researchers are hanging "do not dis-

turb" signs at the work place. This is serious business. We are, in fact, "hooked" on coffee, and that's no joke....

Of more concern should be recently announced findings of the Surgeon General. (My 104-year-old Uncle Mort says he remembers the Surgeon "Lieutenant.")

It reveals several additional health problems heaped on findings of the 1964 report that tied cigarette smoking to lung cancer. It is now believed that smoking can cause diabetes, rheumatoid arthritis and immune system weakness. Add to these fears the likelihood that second-hand smoke can cause strokes for non-smokers.

Since initial findings in 1964, cigarette smoking among adults has declined from 42% to 18%. More than 20 million Americans have died because of smoking....

The 1964 report significantly limited cigarette advertising. It also mandated health warnings for packaging.

Remembrances of earlier ads flashed to mind during a recent cruise. On Freedom, a Carnival Cruise Line vessel, I opted to disembark when we reached Cozumel.

In the first shop, I noticed a large display of cigarettes. A huge sign with headline-size type--proclaimed: "SMOKING KILLS."...

Perhaps the shop owner took seriously governmental laws introduced there in 2010. Warnings and images must be changed every six months. So far, images have included a dead rat, a partial mastectomy and a laryngec-

tomy with backdrops of cigarette butts.

In Mexico, it is required for sellers to identify smoking-related diseases and statistics, toxins found in cigarettes and other stark claims, including warnings such as: Your baby can die. You will have a slow and painful death. You are hurting your family. Smoking damages your arteries. Another challenges, "Go ahead; shorten your life." It occurred to me that the SMOKING KILLS banner so prominently displayed the day I visited was no starker than others mandated in Mexico, and the warnings are more stringent than in the USA....

Movie scenes showing stars smoking have lessened, and there are no more billboards featuring smokers puffing real smoke skyward. Gone also are other performers specializing in creatively exhaling smoke rings.

References to smoking in song also are relegated to memories. We of a certain age can remember the late Phil Harris rendition about cigarettes. The chorus instructs, "Tell St. Peter at the golden gate that I hate to make him wait, but I just gotta have another cigarette."

In today's world, I'll settle for another cup of coffee. Black. And remember my Uncle Mort's contention: "It don't take much water to make good coffee." Please pardon his grammar....

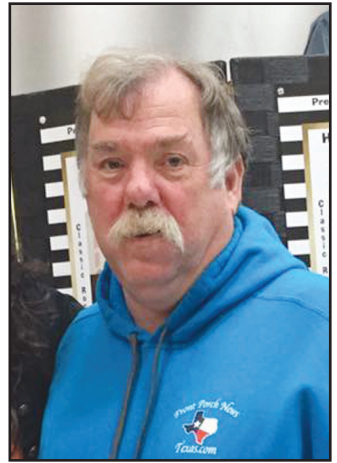

## Bobby McDonald

### Devoted Friend and Servant



Hopkins County mourns the passing of Bobby McDonald, who kept Sulphur Springs, Hopkins County and other parts of the U.S. up to date on news, sports and entertainment on Front Porch News Texas, his internet “newspaper”. McDonald died Monday afternoon, November 21, 2016, following complications from emergency surgery to remove his appendix on Tuesday, November 8.

He loved and promoted Hopkins County. He grew up in rural Hopkins County where his father, Pete McDonald owned and operated a store on State Highway 154 in the southern part of the county.

He attended Texas A & M University on an academic scholarship. He wrote more than one book on Hopkins County life--one of his books, Black History of Hopkins County, was well received. A Saturday prayer time on Celebration Plaza led by

members of the county identified McDonald as one who united the communities of the county as one.

His work ethic was untiring. On Monday, November 7, his morning blog update included the weather for the General Election Day on Tuesday, November 8, and a review of his weekend--“a busy day on Sunday that began with posting stories and photos from a busy Saturday...going to church...returning home for a quick lunch and then working additional football photos and tending to some chores.....an afternoon nap that was badly needed.....then some quality time spent with my dogs.” His church activities, community youth activities, and promotion of various county and school activities along with anything and everything happening in Hopkins County, occupied his time.

Three hours later on Monday, November 7, his health issues began. “Folks.....is there some kind of “stomach bug” going around?.....I’m someone that is never sick and have a “stomach of iron,” but during church yesterday morning my stomach started cramping and it has continued to off and on since then. I don’t know if it’s something that I ate or if it is some virus that is going around!”

On Tuesday, Election Day, he blogged, “Me, I’ve been ‘sick at my stomach’ over this election, and now I’ve literally gotten sick.....I’m headed to the doctor after while....it just doesn’t seem to get much better...” Tests were run just before 10 a.m. Tuesday and at 12:30 p.m. he announced, “It’s my appendix..... emergency surgery this afternoon!!!!” During his surgery, his blood pressure became an issue. He was placed on a ventilator and later dialysis would be tried when his kidneys failed. He remained in the local hospital until being moved to Dallas for various treatments.

**Funeral services will be held on Saturday, November 26, 2016, at 10 a.m. at the Hopkins County Civic Center on Houston Street in Sulphur Springs, Texas. Burial will follow in the Reilly Springs Cemetery. Visitation will be Friday from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Civic Center. Arrangements are through Murray-Orwosky Funeral Home in Sulphur Springs.**

Thanksgiving, or Thanksgiving Day, is a public holiday celebrated on the fourth Thursday in November in the United States. It originated as a harvest festival. Thanksgiving has been celebrated nationally on and off since 1789, after a proclamation by George Washington. It has been celebrated as a federal holiday every year since 1863, when, during the American Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln proclaimed a national day of "Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the Heavens," to be celebrated on the last Thursday in November. Together with Christmas and the New Year, Thanksgiving is a part of the broader holiday season.

The event that Americans commonly call the "First Thanksgiving" was celebrated by the Pilgrims after their first harvest in the New World in 1621. This feast lasted three days, and—as accounted by attendee Edward Winslow—it was attended by 90 Native Americans and 53 Pilgrims. The New England colonists were accustomed to regularly celebrating "thanksgivings"—days of prayer thanking God for blessings such as military victory or the end of a drought.

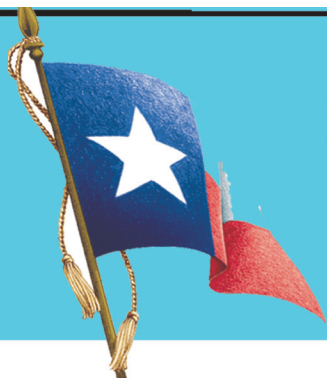

## Lisa Hartman - Black

Film & Television



Lisa Hartman Black (born June 1, 1956) is an American actress and singer.

**CAREER:**

After some minor television appearances, Hartman starred in the short-lived Bewitched spin-off, Tabitha during 1977-78. She subsequently appeared frequently on television in guest roles, and appeared in the 1981 CBS TV remake of Jacqueline Susann's Valley of the Dolls, as Neely O'Hara.

She then played a major role in the primetime soap Knots Landing, as rock singer Ciji Dunne, during 1982 and 1983. Ciji was murdered, but the reaction from fans prompted the producers to create a new "look-alike" character for her. She returned as Ciji's lookalike Cathy Geary. She remained with the show as Cathy until 1986. She then continued to appear in television guest roles, and played the lead in the feature film Where the Boys Are in '84.

Hartman recorded four solo albums between 1976 and 1987 – two for Kirshner Records, one for RCA Records and one for Atlantic Records. Her most notable song is If Love Must Go, which she performed on various television shows like Solid Gold and Merv Griffin. Despite additional contributions from successful songwriters and producers including Jeff Barry, Dobie Gray, Bryan Adams, Rick Springfield, Will Jennings, and Holly Knight, the albums were not commercially successful. She achieved her most notable success with a duet with her husband entitled "When I Said I Do". It reached Number 1 on the Billboard Hot Country Singles & Tracks charts on December 18, 1999 and was nominated for a Grammy Award. The duet was ranked #11 on CMT's 100 Greatest Duets in Country Music in 2005. They recorded a second duet titled "Easy For Me to Say", which peaked at #27 on the country music charts in 2002.

In summer of 1994, Hartman co-hosted Universal Studios Summer Blast, a TV special celebrating the 30th anniversary of Universal Studios.

In April 2011, her albums Lisa Hartman, Hold On, and Letterock were officially released on CD with bonus tracks by Wounded Bird Records under license from Sony (who holds the rights to them now). Her last album 'Til My Heart Stops has already been reissued on CD on Wounded Bird Records.

In May 2012, Hartman starred in Flicka: Country Pride a movie from Twentieth Century Fox Home Entertainment. She plays the mother of a budding equestrian rider (Kacey Rohl).

**PERSONAL LIFE:**

In 1991, she married musician Clint Black, with whom she has a daughter, Lily Pearl Black, born in 2001. They have lived in Nashville, Tennessee since 2002 after living in Laurel Canyon, Los Angeles, California.

**SEMINOLE HAS A NEW WATERING HOLE**

**Tumbleweed Smith**

If you drive along Seminole's Main Street you notice a building with an upstairs open-air patio. It's a place to drink and dine called Perica's Terrace. Perica in Spanish means parakeet or small parrot.

"Perica is my wife," says Mike Diaz, who built the place. "Her name is Anna, but she got the nickname Perica because as a young child she was always talking loud. Her parents jokingly called her Perica."

Perica's Terrace serves food and alcohol.

"Anna and I have always wanted to own a place like this. We thought about buying one or building one. We thought about locating further east, but since we were raised here, our kids and parents are here, we have good friends here, so we decided that it would be a good thing for Seminole."

Perica's Terrace has a dining room downstairs and a covered patio in back, which has a colorful plastic parrot on a stand. A stairway takes customers to the upstairs area that has a comfortable atmosphere with cushioned chairs and couches. Waitresses don't seem to mind the climb when they're delivering orders of food or drink. From the upstairs terrace, patrons get a view of the town.

"We pretty much established it as a wine bar," says Mike. "You know, try to serve a good variety of wines. We also wanted to offer a good variety of cocktails and beer. We serve food, but it's not a full service restaurant. We try to make something different every day for lunch. We have a salad bar. In the evenings we have an entrée for every different day."

Seminole is not completely wet when it comes to serving liquor in restaurants, so if customers want a drink, they have to buy temporary memberships. Mike says when he opened this past summer, customers filled the place.

"It was a very popular response. We had a certain amount of yearly memberships which sold out the first week."

The structure housing the establishment was originally built around 1940 and was home to an eating-place called Master's Café. Mike has a construction company and he got a crew together to re-do the building. He and Anna had no experience whatsoever in running a restaurant or bar.

"It's very exciting and we enjoy it. We traveled around the country visiting places like this. We saw one in San Francisco that had a unique entrance and we sort of copied it."

Mike is a musician.

"My five brothers and I had a band and did some recordings. Sometimes we'll play some of our stuff over the speakers in the restaurant."
