





Medicare Minute

"Prescription Drug Plans 3"

Last week we discussed prescription drug plan premiums, deductibles and coinsurance. This week we will continue to look at Medicare prescription drug plans by looking at copays, formularies and provider networks. When choosing a prescription drug plan these six things are very important to consider.

A copay is a fixed amount you pay for each individual prescription. Copays can vary depending on the tier of your prescription. Typically the lower the tier, the lower the copay. A tier 1 drug usually has a lower copay than a tier 2 drug, tier 2 drugs have a lower copay than tier 3, etc. Because different plans may categorize drugs in different tiers it's a good idea to know how your plan treats your prescriptions.

The prescription drug plan's formulary will tell you two important things. First, it will tell you if the prescription you are taking is covered under the plan. Second, it will tell you the tier of the prescription. Knowing the tier of your prescription is important in determining the copay. For example, Plan A may list your prescription as a tier 2 whereas Plan B may have it as a tier 3. This should tell you that Plan A will have a lower copay on your prescription than Plan B. It will also tell you if your drug will fall in the deductible phase of the plan.

The plan's provider network is a list of pharmacies that accepts the plan. All pharmacies do not accept all plans so if you have a particular pharmacy you would like to use check to make sure they accept your plan. You can do this by simply asking your pharmacist. Also, pharmacies are listed as "preferred" and "standard" under some plans. In this case a "preferred" pharmacy may have lower copays than a "standard" pharmacy.

I WROTE AN ARTICLE A FEW weeks ago bemoaning the lack of skepticism regarding social media participants sharing fake news stories without vetting them. Little did I know that Facebook and Google were busily devising a plot to combat those by

developing a list of fake news sites.

There have been many who attacked this move as an attack on free speech. Those people are usually the same ones



unscrupulous website owners



located in faraway places. One such false story claimed

FAKE NEWS

that Pope Francis had endorsed Mr. Trump. Another one cited unnamed FBI sources claiming that Hillary Clinton will be indicted in 2017 for crimes related to her email scandal. You guys were sharing these stories like mad all over Facebook.

Little did you know that many of these news stories originated from teenagers from a tiny little town in the Baltic republic of Macedonia. Yep, a small group of teens found that they could make a pile of money by manufacturing news on their

websites. Their websites included American-sounding domain names such as WorldPoliticus. com, TrumpVision365.com, and USConservativeToday. com. Almost all the stories were aggressively pro-Trump. The reason so many of these sites appeared to support Trump? According to one 16-year old who was interviewed, "People in America prefer to read news about Trump." Translation: Hillary just wasn't as interesting.

As I explained in my last rant on this subject, the way it works is someone will develop a website then publish outlandish "news" headlines. Then they post links to these articles on social media such as Facebook and Twitter. Others share these stories and people then flock back to these websites to get the latest scoop. Those websites have advertisements on them generated by Google. Google pays a few tenths of a penny to website owners whenever an ad is displayed to a website visitor.

So, to combat these websites, both Facebook and Google had to come up with lists of websites that are clearly fake. From now on Google will not publish their ads on those websites. Facebook will soon start removing fake "related stories" that you often see referenced below actual news stories that people share with each other.

These sites are identified using various algorithms including counting the number of times Facebook users comment on a

story using the word "fake." The more people who report these stories as fake, the less these stories will clog your news feed. This, in effect, chokes off the revenue stream of these websites and they simply fade away.

So, no, no one is "censoring" what you are able to view. But Facebook and Google are going to start limiting your accidental" exposure.

That's a good thing.



My Turn, by Major Euell White, U.S. Army, (retired) **Protecting Our Children**One of the issues that must be addressed by the Trump

administration and Congress is the protection of our children

While the majority of Americans believe that homosexual behavior is morally wrong, the homosexual activists have found that indoctrinating impressionable schoolchildren is easier than persuading adults, and is the easiest way to change public attitudes. Often parents of children who are practicing this vile behavior think that to show their children they love them they must affirm them in the behavior.

The Apostle Paul warned that drunkards, thieves, and extortioners will not enter the kingdom of heaven. In 2013 The US centers for disease control CDC released a report placing the total number of sexually transmitted infections (STIs) in the United States at 110 million, or approximately one third of the entire US population. Some 20 million new cases are diagnosed each year costing taxpayers approximately \$16 billion. Young people between the ages of 15 and 24 are disproportionately affected by the epidemic. They account for only a quarter of the sexually active population, but half of all infections. Human papillomavirus (HPV) is the most common infection, followed by chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, herpes, hepatitis B, HIV and trichomoniasis. The Obama administration's emphasis on legitimizing such a perversion contributed to this problem.

While the world was in the midst of an epidemic caused by HIV, our government was legalizing and promoting the very lifestyles and practices most responsible for spreading the disease. HIV infections are acquired mostly by those who engage in a limited and identified number of behaviors. The risk for people who avoid these behaviors is almost non-existent. These behaviors include intravenous drug use, transfusion or needle stick with contaminated blood, and various sexual practices. Men who have sex with men are at extremely high risk because of infection.

Even before the first case of AIDS was diagnosed, men who had sex with men were in the midst of an epidemic of sexually transmitted diseases. Homosexual men are more likely to be diagnosed with sexually transmitted gonorrhea, syphilis, dysentery, hepatitis, and viral infections. It is now considered hate speech to say that homosexuality is sin. Obama aided by Congress has ruled that homosexuality is not to be criticized. The cost in tax dollars for the treatment and support of this epidemic will be tremendous. But even more important is the cost in physical and moral destruction of human lives. 



The 'Nina' was built ompletely by hand completely and without the use of power tools. Archaeology magazine called the ship historically the most correct Columbus replica ever built. In 2005 the 'Pinta', also a caravel,

early Monday morning was launched in Brazil. It was the first ship to site land in the New World. Historians consider the caravel the Space Shuttle of the fifteenth century.

Both ships tour together as a new and enhanced 'sailing museum' for the purpose of educating the public and school children on the 'caravel', a Portuguese ship used by Columbus and many early explorers to discover the world. Before him, the Old World and the New remained separate distinct confinents and ever since their fates have been bound together for better or for worse.



What happens when you file your Bankruptcy Petition?

When you file your Bankruptcy petition, the Bankruptcy Court will send all your creditors a Notice of Bankruptcy Case (Form 309). This Notice among other things will tell



The automatic stay means that a creditor cannot call you, send you any collection letters, file a lawsuit, or otherwise attempt to collect its debt from

Additionally, the Notice of Bankruptcy Case tells your creditors the time and location of your "Meeting of Creditors" also known as the 341 Hearing. As the Debtor in the case you are of course required to attend this mandatory meeting. The ultimate reason for this meeting is to give the Bankruptcy Trustee and your creditors an opportunity to ask you questions under oath about your assets and financial affairs.

Again, do not fret, because despite its name, creditors rarely attend the meeting of creditors. They will usually review your Bankruptcy petition that you file with the Court and this typically answers all their potential questions. Unless a creditor believes that you are hiding assets or lying on your bankruptcy petition, they do not have much to gain from attending the 341 meeting.

Dear Dave,

We're completely debt-free with a fully funded emergency fund, and we have \$350,000 sitting in the bank from a land sale a couple of months ago. My wife and I would like to buy a chicken farm with two houses and upgrade it to contract standards. This — plus the stock — would cost around \$290,000. I would keep my regular job, and my wife would run the farm. An investor friend of mine said I should finance the entire business purchase. What do you think about this scenario? Darryl

Dear Darryl,

Either do the deal with cash, or don't do it at all. Your investor friend is full of crap, and there's a good chance he doesn't have nearly as much money as you do. He's probably got more bad opinions than dollars.

Now, the pro formas on the kind of thing you're talking about are incredible. They can make a ton of money, but they're a lot of work — I mean real, hard work. Some are more high-tech than others, and that can mean a little less work, but someone's got to be out there every day with their hands on this thing or you're going to be in trouble. I don't know the ideas you have for divvying up the work, but I'm afraid it would just be too much for one and a half people.

I don't mind you doing the deal, as long as you pay cash for it. But if you're looking to invest, there's always real estate — it seems like you've done pretty good there — or maybe another small business idea. Whatever you do, you need to stop listening to your friend about borrowing money. You're liable to turn what was a blessing into a curse if the two of you go borrow money on a chicken farm.
