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
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BREAKING NEWS FROM CANADA

Have you ever seen a moth that looks like a dead leaf? I found this one under the mosquito netting I covered my rose bush with at night (to keep the deer from eating the buds). According to my research these moths are a type of hawk or sphinx moth.





Usually nocturnal, these moths often resemble hummingbirds in flight when sipping nectar from flowers.

To grow healthy winter vegetables, make sure your soil is neither too acid or too alkaline, which is what pH level

measures. In our area, winter veggies will do best at a pH level between 6.0 and 6.5. Soil test kits are available from your local extension office, which they will send to the Auburn test lab with results in a week or two.

There will be workshops in the coming weeks around the Wiregrass area on how to prune your trees and shrubs. Check at www.aces.edu and look on their calendar for upcoming workshops. The website is also a great resource for tips on lawn and gardening and related topics.

The wife comes home and tells her husband, "My dentist says I need a crown". He replies, " I know, you've been telling me that for years!" Told you it was corny!


